Team W/L in Starts:

LAST OUTING: Ashby was recalled by Milwaukee on June 5 and made his second start with the Brewers that afternoon at Philadelphia. He allowed two runs (both earned) on two hits with five walks and three strikeouts in five inning. Ashby took the loss as the Brewers failed to score against the team with the best record in the National League. He was optioned back to Triple-A on June 7.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is the first time Ashby is facing Gwinnett since pitching against the Stripers a whopping six times in 2021. He is 3-0 with a 4.50 ERA (18.0 IP/9 ER) and made three starts against the Braves' affiliate. He allowed just one hit across five scoreless innings on May 23, 2021. He also picked up wins in relief on June 17 and July 7 of that season.
