Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds welcome the Louisville Bats to First Horizon Park for the first of a six-game series. It's the second meeting between the two teams who split a six-game series in Nashville from June 29-July 4. Tonight, right-hander Alec Bettinger starts for the Sounds against right-hander Michael Mariot for the Bats.

Alec Bettinger: 26-year-old Alec Bettinger makes his ninth appearance (seventh start) for the Sounds tonight. In 29.2 innings with Nashville, Bettinger is 1-2 with a 3.34 ERA. He has yielded 13 runs on 31 hits and 8 walks to go along with 31 strikeouts. He last pitched on July 7 in a start against Gwinnett and allowed 3 runs on 7 hits in 4.2 innings (no decision). The right-hander has made four appearances (one start) with Milwaukee and is 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA (14 ER/9.0 IP). In 2019, he went 5-7 with a 3.44 ERA in 26 games (26 starts) with Double-A Biloxi. He finished among Southern League leaders in starts (T-1st), strikeouts (2nd), innings pitched (2nd), WHIP (2nd, 1.07), opponents' batting average (4th, .223) and ERA (6th). Bettinger was drafted by Milwaukee in the 10th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Michael Mariot: 32-year-old Michael Mariot starts for the Bats in tonight's series opener. The right-hander is 1-2 with a 3.12 ERA in five starts with Louisville. In 26.0 innings, Mariot has yielded 9 runs on 26 hits and 7 walks to go along with 17 strikeouts. Mariot last pitched on July 6 in a start against the Memphis Redbirds. He picked up the win and allowed 1 run on 5 hits in 5.0 innings. He walked 1 and struck out 3. The Reds signed Mariot to a minor league contract on June 9. In 44 career Major League games, he has a 2-0 record with a 5.98 ERA. Mariot pitched in 19 games for the Royals from 2014-15 and 25 games for the Phillies in 2016. He was drafted by Kansas City in the 8th round of the 2010 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Nebraska.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 29, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Bettinger's Birthday: Sounds right-hander Alec Bettinger starts tonight's game on his 26th birthday. Bettinger, who was born in Alexandria, Virginia, has only pitched on his birthday once in professional career. In his first year as a pro, Bettinger was with the Helena Brewers when he pitched at Idaho Falls on July 13, 2017. He worked in relief and allowed 2 runs on 2 hits in 1.2 innings. He walked 1 batter, struck out 2, and did not factor into the decision on Helena's 7-2 loss.

Home is Where the Sounds Are: The Sounds will play 19 home games at First Horizon Park over the next 27 days. They host Louisville for six games from July 13-18, Columbus comes to town for six games July 27-August 1 and Toledo visits Nashville for a seven-game series August 3-8. The Sounds have already played 30 (19-11) home games in 2021 - the second-most in the Triple-A East behind only Iowa's 34 home games at Principal Park.

Vs. Mariot: Nashville faced Michael Mariot at First Horizon Park on June 30 and only pushed across one run in six innings against the right-hander. The following active Sounds have faced Mariot in 2021: Zach Green: 1-3, 2B, RBI, K; Payton Henry: 0-2; Cooper Hummel: 1-2, 2B, BB; Kevin Kramer: 1-2, RBI, K; Matt Lipka: 1-3, K; Tim Lopes: 2-3; Troy Stokes, Jr.: 0-3, K; Weston Wilson: 1-3, K.

Another Shutout: Six Nashville pitchers combined on a four-hit shutout in the series finale at Gwinnett on Sunday. It's the Sounds' fifth shutout of the season, a mark that is tied for second-most in the Triple-A East with Columbus and Gwinnett. Only the Durham Bulls (9) have more shutouts in 2021.

The Reinforcements: Among the several roster moves the Sounds have made over the last few weeks is trading for Matt Lipka and Kevin Kramer. The duo has combined to play 18 games for the Sounds and have combined to hit .339 (19-for-56) with 8 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 8 walks and 3 stolen bases. The two have also made several stellar defensive plays.

Westbrook Finds A Way: Infielder Jamie Westbrook has reached base safely in a team-high 24 consecutive games and has hit safely in 22 of those games. Since June 8 when the streak started, he is hitting .389 (37-for-95) with 19 runs, 9 doubles, 6 home runs, 26 RBI and 5 walks. His on-base percentage during the 23 games is .427.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On July 13, 1994, Nashville's Greer Stadium played host to the Triple-A All-Star Game. Nashville's Rick Renick managed the "American League" while Sounds second baseman Ray Durham won the American Association's Star of Stars Award by going 3-for-3 with a run scored in the 8-5 loss.

Loud Bark: Reliever Luke Barker has been dominant since the early going of the 2021 season. In 22 games since May 14, Barker is 3-0 with a 0.36 ERA (1 ER/25.0 IP). The only earned run Barker has allowed in the two-month period was on June 13 vs. Indianapolis. In the 25.0 innings, Barker has allowed only 9 hits and 2 walks to go along with 28 strikeouts.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,068-1,944. The 2,068 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

LAST OUTING: Bettinger's last outing was on July 7 in a start against the Gwinnett Stripers at Coolray Field. In his first start since June 25, Bettinger went 4.2 innings and allowed 3 runs on 7 hits in the no decision. He walked 2, struck out 4, and threw 62 of 89 pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Bettinger is facing Louisville for the second time in 2021. He pitched in relief against the Bats on July 3 and tossed a scoreless inning in Nashville's 7-3 loss.
