SPRINGDALE, AR – First baseman CJ Alexander drove in six runs, but the Northwest Arkansas Naturals fell to the Tulsa Drillers, 12-9 Friday night at Arvest Ballpark.

- Northwest Arkansas jumped out to an early 7-0 lead, thanks in large part to the efforts of Alexander. He doubled in two runs to open the scoring in the bottom of the first, the Naturals scored twice on wild pitches, the second from Alexander.
- In the second, Alexander connected on a three-run homer, his third straight night with a home run. His final RBI of the night came in a two-run sixth inning, with a sacrifice fly to right field after a run scored moments earlier on a wild pitch, tying a career high in RBI set earlier this season.
- Through 16 games with the Naturals, the left-handed hitter now has four home runs and 17 runs batted in.
- Despite being up 7-0 after the second, the Naturals lead slowly fell apart, as Tulsa scored five runs in the third and twice in the fourth inning to tie the game at seven. The Drillers took the lead in the fifth on a Naturals error, an 8-6 advantage.
- After the Naturals two-run sixth inning, capped by Alexander's sac fly, the Drillers jumped ahead in the eighth inning on a grand slam that was too much for Northwest Arkansas to overcome.
- Despite collecting just five hits, the Naturals drew a season-high 13 walks, led by three from Nick Loftin and two from each Tucker Bradley, Tyler Gentry, Logan Porter and Jake Means. Bradley, Loftin, Gentry and Alexander each scored twice in the three-run loss.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 7-5 all-time when playing on August 6

On August 6, 2009, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Tulsa Drillers, 8-6 at Arvest Ballpark behind a six-run fifth inning. Tulsa jumped out to a 5-0 lead by the middle of the fourth, then the Naturals scored a run on a Corey Smith home run in the bottom half and took the lead in the fifth. David Lough reached on a fielding error that scored two runs, then scored on another fielding error that put Jarrod Dyson on base. Smith doubled Dyson and Jeff Bianchi home to give the Naturals the lead, then Ed Lucas singled Smith home to cap the frame. Bianchi capped the scoring in the sixth with an RBI double that plated Lough.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of the Naturals' 27 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 5 of the Naturals' 27 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi**, **Jonah Dipoto**, **Jake Means**, **Logan Porter** and **John Rave**.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 32-8, while when scoring six runs or less, just 10-49.
- The Naturals are 28-13 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 14-44.
- The Naturals are 39-13 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-44 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 27-20, whereas 15-37 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 5-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 57 losses (29.8%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 20 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 99 games, the Naturals have stolen 129 bases in 159 attempts (average 1.30 steals/game, 81.13% success rate).

- 129 steals is second in the Texas League, sixth in Double-A and tied 28th in the Minors ... 81.13% success rate is 24th among 120 full-season MiLB teams.
- **Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks fourth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 23 (in 26 attempts) ranks tied seventh in the league.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 65 of 99 games this season (65.7%), including 32 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 16 times, meaning 32 of 129 steals this year (24.8%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 14 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.

TUCK(ER) AND ROLL

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 70 of 85 games this season (82.4%) and reached base multiple times on 45 occasions, which ranks third on the Naturals ... he has hits in 60 of 85 games and has 26 multi-hit games, as well as 13 multi-run games and eight multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .302 batting average leagues qualified Naturals hitters, ranks eighth in the Texas League and third among Kansas City's minor league hitters ... his .392 on-base percentage also ranks third in the system, while 91 hits are tied fifth and his .837 OPS is eighth.
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 17 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .303 hitter (20-for-66) with a .439 on-base percentage and .848 OPS ... when leading off innings, he hits .307 (23-for-75) with a .402 on-base percentage.
- Two of his six home runs this season have been grand slams, the first two of his professional career and the Naturals' second and third of the season ... April 23 @ Frisco and May 13 vs. Wichita, both came 5th inning.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals last month.

- *Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks 14th in batting average (.325)* when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.325) and OPS (.973), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.422) and slugging percentage (.551) ... his 59 runs batted in are tied fifth in the system (with Naturals teammate John Rave), while 15 home runs between the River Bandits and Naturals rank sixth.
- Gentry has reached base in 33 of 38 games (86.8%) and has hits in 26 of his 38 games with the Naturals.
- Since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .315 (46-for-146) over 39 games with nine doubles, 10 home runs and 36 runs batted (0.92 RBI per game) and a .994 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 19 of 39 games, with nine multi-RBI games ... he already has 14 multi-hit games and 11 multi-run games as well, including a pair of four-run games.
- Over 22 games in the month of July, Gentry hit .329 (28-for-85) with nine extra-base hits and 21 runs batted in, while he has scored 19 runs as well ... his 21 RBI last month ranked tied fourth among Texas League hitters with teammate Robbie Glendinning.
- Gentry's 18-game on-base streak between June 26 and July 17 is the longest for a Naturals player this season ... in that span, he hit .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman **Robbie Glendinning** has returned to form, with a hot stretch that has carried through July.

- Glendinning's 64 runs batted in this season rank tied ninth among all Double-A hitters and tied sixth in the Texas League ... his 61 runs scored are tied for the ninth-most in the Texas League, 36 extra-base hits are tied 10th.
- He has reached base in 73 of 84 games he's played this season (86.9%), reaching multiple times in 40 games this season ... he has hits in 56 of 84 games, including 26 multi-hit games this season.
- Among Royals minor league hitters, Glendinning ranks as one of the top hitters in nearly every category ... he places third in the system with 64 runs batted in, 61 runs scored, 155 total bases and 19 doubles, while 36 extra-base hits are tied third and 16 home runs are tied fourth.
- In 20 games in July, Glendinning hit .313 (26-for-83) with 11 extra-base hits and 21 runs batted in ... his 21 runs batted were are tied for the fourth-most in the Texas League in the month of July, seven home runs were tied fourth in the league and 51 total bases ranked tied fifth.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- *Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks EIGHTH in on-base percentage (.431)* ... he is fourth among all qualified Texas League AND Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is also seventh in OPS (.911).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter's .431 OBP is the highest on-base percentage in the system, while he ranks third in OPS, fourth in batting average (.294) and seventh in slugging percentage (.480) ... his 57 walks are the most in the system, ahead of River Town's 53.
- Porter has reached base in 65 of 75 games he's played this season (86.7%) and has reached base multiple times on 47 occasions, with hits in 58 of 75 games and 24 multi-hit games.
- Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied for the second-longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 OBP.

#24 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.

- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.



DANNY ACCOLA • CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.
