LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones matched their longest winning streak of 2023 with a 2-1 triumph over Hudson Valley on Sunday afternoon...RF Omar De Los Santos reached on a bunt single to start the 9th...The 23-year-old stole second and third before scoring the winning run on a 2-out wild pitch... Hudson Valley's only run came on a 2B Ben Cowles solo home run in the 4th...LHP José Quintana tossed 4.0 innings of 1-run ball as part of a Major League rehab assignment for Brooklyn...RHP Elieser Hernández whiffed 2 in a scoreless frame on MLB rehab...Renegades RHP Drew Thorpe struck out 7 and permitted 3 hits over 7.2 innings.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: RF Omar De Los Santos provided Brooklyn their 6th walk-off win of 2023, scoring on a wild pitch in Sunday's victory vs. Hudson Valley...DH Kevin Parada delivered a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep provided a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 1th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramírez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 1th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos garnered a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 6 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after June 16's loss at Aberdeen...22.1% (15-of-68) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 24.3% (9-of-37) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...38.2% (26-of-68) have been determined by just 1 run.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn matched their longest winning streak of the season on Sunday, earning their 4th-straight W with a 2-1 win vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones first 4-game win streak of 2023 also came during a series against the Renegades...Brooklyn won 4 in-a-row from May 17 until Game 1 of May 21's doubleheader at Hudson Valley...The Cyclones have captured 4-straight since June 22...A win on Wednesday would provide the 'Clones their longest winning streak since they won 6-consecutive games from September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem.

CROWN PRINCE OF CONEY ISLAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards prior to being transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...After Sunday's victory, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (200), at-bats (656), plate appearances (784), runs scored (100), walks (107), stolen bases (48), and hit-by-pitches (17)...Additionally, the Holy Cross High School alum is second all-time in total bases (203) and extra-base hits (46), third in hits (125) and RBI (68), and tied for fourth in home runs (17).

CONEY BOARDWALK SHUFFLE: In addition to Palmer joining Double-A Binghamton, Brooklyn made a series of other roster moves on Wednesday...OF Rhylan Thomas — INF D'Andre Smith's college teammate at Southern California — has joined the roster from Single-A St. Lucie...Additionally, INF César Berbesi and OF Stanley Consuegra were reinstated from the 7-day injured list, OF Scott Ota was placed on the development list, and OF Eduardo Salazar was transferred back to Single-A St. Lucie...In 35 games in the Florida State League, Thomas slashed .308/.375/.442 with an .817 OPS, adding a home run and 9 RBI with more walks (14) than strikeouts (12)...Consuegra appeared in 4 rehab games with the Florida Complex League Mets and St. Lucie...He was 2-for-12 (167) at the plate with a double.

OH YEAH, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has added 28 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 98 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in Mil.B...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (103), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Nūñez (103), and D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (99) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 41...Omar is already 4 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

HAPPY BIRTHDAYI: On Tuesday, OF Abraham Almonte celebrated his 34th birthday...On Sunday, INF Kevin Kendall turned 24...Almonte is 2-for-6 with 7 walks in 4 minor league rehab contests for Brooklyn...Kendall has been on the 7-day injured list since June 1 and is slashing .214/.308/.311 in 28

DINKY DONUTS: RHP Joshua Cornielly (3.0 IP), RHP Dylan Tebrake (2.1), LHP Eli Ankeney (1.2), and RHP Wilkin Ramos (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 2-0 win vs. Hudson Valley on Saturday evening...That marked the Cyclones' 1st donut of an opponent since a 5-0 victory at Aberdeen last Saturday...RHP Blade Tidwell (7.0 IP) and Tebrake (2.0) united on a 4-hit blanking of the IronBirds... It was also the Cyclones second shutout of Hudson Valley this season...RHP Tyler Stuart (6.1 IP) and RHP Jace Beck (0.2) picked up a 4-hitter in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The Clones have accumulated 6 shutouts through the first 67 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: LHP José Quintana and RHP Elieser Hernández both joined the Cyclones on Major League rehab assignments on Sunday..Quintana tossed 4.0 innings of 1-run, 5-strikeout ball, while Hernández whiffed 2 in a spotless frame...Quintana has made 315 Major League appearances (289 starts) over an 11-year career with the Chicago White Sox., Chicago Cubs, Los Angeles Angels, San Francisco Giants, Pittsburgh Pirates, and St. Louis Cardinals...The left-hander was named a 2016 American League All-Star with the White Sox...Quintana signed a 2-year contract with New York back on December 9...He was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 30 (retro 3/27) with a left rib fracture...Quintana was transferred to the 60-day IL on April 11...Hernández was placed on the 15-day IL on March 30 (retro 3/27) with a right shoulder strain...He was transferred to the 60-day IL on May 10...The 28-year-old has pitched in 90 MLB games (48 starts) over 5 seasons with the Miami Marlins...Hernández was acquired by New York with RHP Jeff Brigham for minor league RHP Franklin Sánchez and OF Jake Mangum on November 18, 2022.

BULLS ON PARADA: C Kevin Parada has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks... Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .339/.391/.610 with a 1.001 OPS and 169 wRC+ in 15 games...Parada has accrued 8 runs scored, 2 triples, 4 home runs, 12 RBI, 4 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...Additionally, the Pasadena, Calif. native enters Sunday on a 7-game hitting streak (12-for-28, .429) and a 12-game on-base streak (348/.412/.630)..The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Wednesday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (14), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (24), 8th in total bases (103), and tied for 9th in hits (62)

A-RAM IT: OF Alex Ramírez is 4th in the South Atlantic League in walks (16) and tied for 4th in runs scored (15) during the month of June...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Sunday, the Dominican native is 4th in franchise history in RBI (65) and is 26 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He is also 4th in doubles (26) and tied for 6th in hits (118) and total bases (176).

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn continues their 12-game homestand, finishg with 6 contests against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws possess 5 of new York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHP Orion Kerkering (6), INF Hao Yu Lee (7), OF Gabriel Rincones (10), C Caleb Ricketts (19), and RHP Tommy McCollum (23)... Brooklyn and Jersey Shore are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening series of 2023... Brooklyn captured 2-of-3 games...The Cyclones are 6-8 against the BlueClaws in the first 14 meetings of the campaign... Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn is 41-30 all-time against Jersey Shore (.577).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.07) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...The Brewers' High-A Wisconsin is 2nd (3.29) in the classification, while Hudson Valley (3.35) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 2nd best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.05).

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 11 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 0.95 ERA (2 ER in 19.0 IP) on 7 hits and 9 walks, registering 28 strikeouts (13.26 K/9)...That equates to a 38.4 K% (28/73).

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP Wilkin Ramos has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023...Over his last 4 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 9.1 innings, earning a save and allowing only 3 hits, 4 walks, and striking out 9...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.29 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 28.6% strikeout rate with a 11.4% walk rate.

HOMER HAPPY: On Friday night, the Cyclones set a team season-high with 4 home runs vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn's previous high water mark was 3 on June 13 at Aberdeen...It was the first time the 'Clones had clubbed at least 4 home runs in a single game since July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...RF Alex Ramírez homered twice on a solo shot in the 4th and a 2-run blast in the 6th...C José Mena and 1B Joe Suozzi went back-to-back in the 7th...Brooklyn's 3-home run 3rd inning on Friday was also the first for the franchise since the team smashed a trio in the top of the 5th on July 27, 2021, at Jersey Shore... DH Edgardo Fermín (2-run) and SS Ronny Mauricio went back-to-back before 2B Luis González added a 2-run shot of his own later in the frame...Friday also marked the first time the Cyclones have poked 4+ home runs at Maimonides Park since a 5-homer barrage on September 18, 2021, vs. Jersey Shore... CF Jaylen Palmer, C Oscar Campos, 2B Luke Ritter, DH Francisco Álvarez, and 1B Wilmer Reyes all went deep.

TOUCH 'EM ALL: C Kevin Parada capped his first career multi-home run game with a 2-run inside-thepark home run in the 6th inning of Friday's win vs. Hudson Valley...It was the first inside-the-park home run by a Cyclones player since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in the 2005 season...The first one in franchise history was clubbed by Joe Jiannetti on July 19, 2001.

BLADE RUNNER: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed consecutive quality starts dating back to last Saturday at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in both outings, permitting just 1 run on 7 hits over 13.0 innings...He has walked 4 and struck out 15 in those contests...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 7 starts dating back to May 17 at Hoston Valley, Tidwell is 4-0 with a 1.35 ERA (5 ER in 33.1 IP) with just 17 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 48 (12.96 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 35.0% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .150 batting average (17-113) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (150) and is 3rd in ERA (1.35) and strikeouts (48) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 9th in the SAL in punch outs (75).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 5-straight scoreless outings since that date (9.0 IP)... Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase has the league's lowest ERA (1.17)...Gervase averages 13.79 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.3% strikeout rate.

STU-PENDOUS: RHP Tyler Stuart set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), earning his 2nd win of the year on Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old is the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP Carson Seymour accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro...Stuart is also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP Conner Grey tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum is the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP Kevin Canelon wifed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.44)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (89.5%) and FIP (2.86), 2nd in xFIP (3.17) and strikeout rate (31.0%), 4th in batting average against (2.09), 5th in WHIP (1.09) and strikeouts per 9 innings (11.20), tied for 5th in strikeouts (78), and 6th in innings pitched (62.2).

YO-JOANDER: RHP Joander Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in last Tuesday's defeat and added another scoreless inning in relief, earning the win, on Sunday...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8 on Tuesday...Over his last 3 appearances (2 starts), Suárez has a 1-1 record and a 3.00 EPAR (4 ER in 12.0 IP)...The Cumaná, Venezuela native has punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez holds a rate of 12.0 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 33.3% (16/48) in that span.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last week...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (S), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, Baseball America deemed Colón one of the Mets' "14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30"

JEFE JEFFREY: Colón earned his first win in 2023 on June 1 at Jersey Shore...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem... That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore... In his last 4 appearances (3 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER in 18.2 IP), allowing 10 hits and 5 walks, striking out 17...In his last 3 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 18.2 innings, allowing just 6 runs (4 earned) on 13 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 1.93 ERA and permitted only 6 walks and punched out 20 in that span.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season... Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the righthander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA'S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)... He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
