NOTES AND NUGGETS

SEASON 56

Omaha began the 56th season in franchise history Friday against the I-Cubs at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa ... this is the 14th season in the Storm Chasers era.

- Omaha is coming off a 2024 campaign in which they went 89-59 (.601 winning percentage) to finish 1st in the 20-team International League during the regular season, before going on to win the International League Championship Series.
- The 2024 Chasers set a franchise wins record for wins in a season, passing the 86-win 1990 Omaha Royals that won the Triple-A Classic (national championship).

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS

Omaha enters 2024 as the defending champions of the International League.

- Winners of the 1st half (49-24 record), Omaha hosted the 2nd-half Champion Columbus Clippers (Cleveland Triple-A affiliate) in the International League Championship Series ... after dropping Game 1 to Columbus 3-2, Omaha came back to win Game 2 in 11 innings, 5-4, before winning Game 3 by a score of 7-3.
- 2024 marked Omaha's 8th league championship as a Triple-A Club, having won 4 American Association titles (1969, 1970, 1978, 1990), 3 Pacific Coast League championships (2011, 2013, 2014) and now an International League title ... Omaha is the first club to win a league championship in 3 different Triple-A leagues.

OPENING DAY OPTICS

Dating back to 1985, the Triple-A Omaha franchise is now 14-26 on Opening Day, with last night's loss snapping a franchise record streak of 4 straight Opening Day wins ... this is the 7th time Omaha has opened against Iowa in 56 seasons.

- When opening the season on the road since 1985, Omaha is now 5-18 ... Omaha has opened the in Des Moines three times previously: a 8-7 loss on April 6, 1971, a 6-1 loss on April 9, 1974 and a 5-3 loss on April 4, 1996.

ROSTER RUNDOWN

The Storm Chasers and Kansas City Royals jointly announced Omaha's roster yesterday, ahead of today's Opening Day game in Iowa, with 20 returning players from the 2024 league championship season on the 28-man roster.

- Returning pitchers include **Luinder Avila**, **Jonathan Bowlan**, **Noah Cameron**, **Chandler Champlain**, **Austin Cox**, **Steven Cruz**, **Tyson Guerrero**, **Andrew Hoffmann**, **Anthony Simonelli**, **Evan Sisk** and **Jacob Wallace** ... returning hitters are catcher **Brian O'Keefe**, infielders **Cam Devanney**, **Nick Loftin**, **Nick Pratto** and **Tyler Tolbert**, plus outfielders **Tyler Gentry**, **John Rave**, **Nelson Velázquez** and **Drew Waters**.
- Pitcher **Cruz Noriega** and catcher **Luca Tresh** are both on their first Triple-A roster ... their first appearances with Omaha will mark their Triple-A debuts.
- New to the Royals organization this season are pitchers **Junior Fernandez** and **Thomas Hatch**, catcher **Luke Maile**, infielder **Harold Castro** and outfielder **Joey Wiemer** ... pitcher **Taylor Clarke** returns to Kansas City on a Minor League deal after working out of the Royals' bullpen from 2022-23.

BE LIKE MIKE

Manager **Mike Jirschele** returns in 2025 for his 17th season managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise, in the 3rd year of his 3rd stint with the club, with an all-time record of 1152-1155 in Omaha ... this is his 34th season in the Royals organization.

- In 2024, "Jirsch" was named the International League Manager of the Year, his first such award with Omaha, leading the IL Champs to a league-best 89-59 record in the regular season, setting a franchise record with 89 wins.
- Jirschele previously led the Triple-A Omaha club from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 through 2013, winning the PCL league title in 2011 and a Triple-A National Championship in 2013 ... he was Kansas City's 3rd Base Coach from 2014 to 2019.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

Across the first two games of the season, the Storm Chasers have stolen 9 bases, the most steals of any Triple-A team.

- Friday night, Omaha stole 5 bases, before adding three more in yesterday's win ... there was only one time last year the Chasers stole more than 4 bases in a game, when the team swiped 7 on September 15 vs. Toledo.
- That game against Toledo was also part of the only 2-game stretch all year where they combined to steal more than 7 bases in any consecutive games.

THAT'S A RELIEF

Yesterday, four Omaha relievers combined for 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing just 3 hits and 1 walk in the process.

- Last year, Omaha had three games where the bullpen combined for 6.0 innings or more of scoreless relief ... ironically, one of those games was exactly a year ago, on Opening Night ... on March 29 vs. Iowa, Omaha relievers combined for 6.0 scoreless innings, with 2 hits and 2 walks.

LUINDER AVILA SCOUTING REPORT

The Royals signed a 16-year-old Avila out of Venezuela during the 2018 international signing period. Ever since, it's been steady progress for the now-23-year-old who spent most of the 2024 season at Double-A before making one Triple-A start. Avila posted a 1.37 WHIP over 19 starts for Northwest Arkansas. It was the first time since 2022 that he didn't throw over 100 innings, as he missed about six weeks with a minor oblique injury. In five games (three starts) in the Arizona Fall League, Avila posted a 3.07 ERA with 17 strikeouts and eight walks in 14 2/3 innings. The Royals added him to their 40-man roster to protect him from the Rule 5 Draft in November.

Last year marked the first time Avila missed significant time; he's been a durable young pitcher for the Royals, and those innings don't go unnoticed. Avila's comfort zone with his fastball is 94-95 mph with flashes of the upper 90s, and the pitch has natural cut and ride. To help him command the arm'side of the plate, Avila introduced a two-seamer that is about the same velo as his four-seamer. He throws both a slider and curveball, and both can miss bats. They can sometimes morph into each other, so the separation is a work in progress. A fringe-average changeup rounds out Avila's arsenal, a pitch he's still developing with a focus on backing off the 89-91 mph velocity. Avila has near-average command but hides the ball well in his delivery, and as he's grown, his presence on the mound has gotten stronger.

Now that he's on the 40-man, Avila could make his big league debut at some point in 2025. He needs more development time in Omaha, particularly with his secondary pitches and command, but will be part of the Triple-A depth to begin the season. Avila will continue to start but might be someone whom the Royals can rely on in different roles depending on need for a long reliever or a swingman.

Baseball America

Scouting Grades: Fastball: 55 | Curveball: 60 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 45.

Track Record: It's been a slow trek through the Royals system for Avila since first signing in 2018, but he's proven enough value to get a spot on the 40-man roster. The Venezuelan righthander was on the way to a strong season until a rib cage injury in early July put him on the sidelines for seven weeks. He returned in time to get three more starts at Double-A Northwest Arkansas and one with Triple-A Omaha. His 3.81 ERA and .229 opponent batting average in Double-A were among the best numbers of his career. Avila finished his year in the Arizona Fall League, where he pitched in the annual Fall Stars Game as well as throwing two scoreless innings in the championship game.

Scouting Report: Avila's four-seam fastball has glove-side cutting action and sits 93-95 mph, touching 98, with ride. A development goal will be to improve the location and consistency of the pitch. His best pitch is a high-spin two-plane curveball at 79-83 mph and he uses it to get swings and misses with its downward movement that's tough to barrel. His 87-91 mph hard changeup is still in development, a pitch with natural sink that gets whiffs, and could be an average offering with more consistency. He repeats his delivery and has been called a sneaky competitor.

The Future: The Royals added Avila to the 40-man roster in November. He projects as a valuable innings-eater at the back of the rotation but could thrive in a bullpen role.

- Avila is making his 1st start with Omaha this season ... made Omaha's 2025 Breaking Roster, after ending the 2024 season in Triple-A with the Storm Chasers ... was added to Kansas City's 40-Man roster this offseason.
- Playing his 7th professional season this year, all have come in the Royals organization.
- Most of Avila's career has been spent as a starting pitcher, with 80 of his 103 professional outings as a starter ... 76 of his 82 outings since the start of the 2021 season have been starts.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are 58 results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. 34 of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
