FIVE-RUN SIXTH VAULTS SHRIMP OVER KNIGHTS

A five-run sixth on Saturday propelled Jacksonville by Charlotte. **Kemp Alderman** collected a two-run single in the first to put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead. After a three-run Knights fifth, **Nathan Martorella's** three-run homer highlighted the five-run sixth. **Johnny Olmstead** registered a two-run double in the eighth and **Joe Mack** set the final tally with a two-run shot in the ninth to make it 11-3. **Thomas White** struck out 10 in 4.2 innings in his Triple-A debut. **William Kempner** tossed 2.1 scoreless innings and **Zach McCambley** added 2.0 shutout frames.

AHOY, EIGHTY(-ONE)!

At 81-56 (.591), Jacksonville's 81 wins are tied with Lehigh Valley for the most in Triple-A. Those 81 triumphs are Jacksonville's most in a season since 2014, when they registered an 81-59 (.579) record. The last time a Jacksonville club won more than 81 games in a season was 2009, when the Suns went 82-58 (.586). Jacksonville's .591 winning percentage this season is their best since the 2006 Suns finished the campaign 86-54 (.614).

YOUTH IS SERVED

Among position players on the club's active roster, only three Jumbo Shrimp (**Jacob Berry**, **Deyvison De Los Santos** and **Joe Mack**) have played in more than half of Jacksonville's 137 games thus far in 2025. The other nine players have combined for a total of just 145 games in Triple-A this season. Eight of those nine players have been called up from Double-A Pensacola since August 2, and none of those eight have tallied more than 26 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp.

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 280 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank ninth in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 24 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 277, 10th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 280 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

FORMULA ONE

With a 27-14 (.659) record in one-run games, Jacksonville is one behind Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in Triple-A, and fourth among the 120 MiLB teams. The 27 one-run triumphs are the most for the Jumbo Shrimp since they went 27-18 in one-run games during the 2021 campaign. The last time a Jacksonville club had more than 27 one-run wins in a season was 2014, when the Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp are 51-31 (.622) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 63.0 percent of their 81 victories have come by those slim margins.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

While the club has made 117 errors, the fifth-most in Triple-A, Jacksonville's rangy defense has helped the club yield the fewest hits and second-fewest runs in Triple-A this season. The Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A in defensive efficiency, which simply measures how many batted balls put into play that are turned into outs, at .716. Second-place Durham (.709) closer to fifth-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (.705) than the Bulls are to Jacksonville.

FOR IT'S ONE, TWO, THREE STRIKES, YOU'RE OUT

The Jumbo Shrimp have recorded double-digit strikeouts in 18 of the 30 games the club has played since August 5. During this stretch, Jacksonville has racked up 309 punchouts (10.3 per game), the second-most in Triple-A. Twelve of the club's top 26 strikeout games this season have come in the last 30 games. The Jumbo Shrimp registered 17 strikeouts on September 6 at Charlotte, their most in a game since August 10, 2024, when they compiled 18 punchouts at Toledo.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has earned a series win at Charlotte, snapping a three-set winless drought... **Alex Williams**, who was promoted from Double-A Pensacola on Saturday, is slated to become Jacksonville's club-record 32nd different starting pitcher on Sunday. In eight starts with the Blue Wahoos, Williams was 1-4 with a 6.82 ERA (33.0 IP, 53 H, 2 HR, 14 BB, 37 K, .353 BAA). In 10 relief appearances, he was 3-0 with a 2.48 ERA (29.0 IP, 20 H, HR, 9 BB, 22 K)... **Griffin Conine** is scheduled to begin a rehab assignment on Sunday.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

-Monteverde made his major league debut on April 19 for the Marlins in a game at the Philadelphia Phillies. He pitched 3.2 innings, striking out four.
