PAPILLION, NEB. - The Omaha Storm Chasers scored in five of nine innings on Thursday,

- but fell to the Toledo Mud Hens for the third straight game, 8-5 at Werner Park.

 After Toledo scored a 1st inning run, **Nick Loftin** responded in the 2nd inning with his second homer of the year, a solo shot to left-center that tied the score at 1-1.
- The Mud Hens took back the lead in the 3rd inning with a grand slam, but Omaha chipped away at the deficit ... **Tyler Gentry** added a run with a sacrifice fly in the 3rd inning, then **CJ Alexander** hit his first Triple-A homer in the 4th, a solo shot to center. **Tucker Bradley** singled in **Dairon Blanco** in the 7th inning to bring the score back within one, 6-5. However, in the 8th, a two-run homer from Toledo's **Zack Short** that
- put the Mud Hens back ahead by three runs, the 8-5 score that held to be final
- Gentry and Bradley each recorded two hits in the loss, with Bradley recording his first triple of the season in the third inning.
- Jackson Kowar and Austin Cox covered the first five innings of the game on the mound, combining to allow six runs on five hits and six walks. Kowar was removed in the third inning, after walking the bases loaded with two outs but Cox surrendered the go-ahead grand slam, allowing another homer in the fourth.
- Andrés Núñez provided momentary relief behind Cox, as he threw 2.0 scoreless frames, working his way out of a bases-loaded jam in the sixth inning, then retiring Toledo 1-2-3 in the seventh.
- Josh Taylor allowed the eighth inning home run and Josh Staumont fired a scoreless ninth with a pair of strikeouts but Omaha went quietly in the bottom of the ninth to fall for the third straight game.

NOTES AND NUGGETS MONEY MAIKEL

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has opened the season 9-for-21 (.429) at the plate, with an International-League best 10 runs batted in over his first five games.

7 10 runs batted in ranks 1st in the International League and 4th in all of Triple-A,

- behind three players in the Pacific Coast League that have 11 RBI this year ... his .429 average ranks tied 8th in the league, while his .567 on-base percentage places 4th
- Garcia has drawn 8 walks, including in four of the six games he's played in this season, with three multi-walk games including a three-walk game yesterday against Toledo ... last season with NW Arkansas, he drew 10 walks in the first five games of the season.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Logan Porter has had a productive start to the season, with hits in all three games he's played in and a .385 batting average (5-for-13) and team-best three home runs.

- Porter's first hit of the season on Saturday, April 1st was a home run, in his second at-bat of the year ... in his second game , on Wednesday, April 5th, he hit back-to-back home runs with **Tyler Gentry**, then hit another home run in the eighth inning, his team-best third.
- Three home runs in tied for 2nd in the International League, behind the 4 Norfolk's Josh Lester has hit.

DON'T GO STEALING MY BASE

Four games into the season, the Storm Chasers lead all of Minor League Baseball) with 15 stolen bases, 15-for-17 in steal attempts ... Omaha was caught stealing for the first time this year on Wednesday, after beginning the year 12-for-12.

- Six players have stolen bases this season, including four that have swiped multiple bags: **Dairon Blanco** (5), **Samad Taylor** (3), **Tucker Bradley** (3) and **Maikel Garcia** (2). The Storm Chasers have executed a double-steal twice: most recently in the 3rd
- inning last night (Garcia 2nd Base ... Taylor 3rd Base). Five steals in last Friday's season opener was a feat Omaha accomplished six times last season, but just once prior to the start of July ... twice last season, the Storm Chasers stole eight bases: 7/1 @ St. Paul and 7/28 @ Syracuse.

IT TAKES TWO

After managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 to 2013, Mike Jirschele returns in 2023 to manage the Storm Chasers, his 15th season at the helm in Omaha and is quickly approaching an incredible milestone.

Over his now 15 seasons in Omaha, "Jirsch" has managed 2,019 games ... with

- Sunday's win, he has a 998-1,021 record (.494 winning %). The team's fifth win this season will mark his 1,000th all-time with Omaha, so he currently sits **TWO** away.
- When factoring in three seasons managing lower-level Royals affiliates between 1992 and 1994, Jirsch has managed 2,348 games with a 1,211-1,137 all-time managerial record (.516 winning %).

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- 🗸 He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.


