NOTES AND NUGGETS

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

After an 0-4 start to the season, the Storm Chasers have won 11 of their last 16 games.

- Last season, the Storm Chasers won just 6 of 27 series played ... Omaha has won consecutive series over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis.
- Last week's series win was the Storm Chasers' 3rd straight ... Omaha never won back-to-back series last year ... the last time the Chasers won 3 series in a row was a stretch from April 23 to June 2, 2024 with 6 straight series wins.

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Omaha Storm Chasers are tied for the 2nd-best fielding percentage in the International League at .986, committing just 10 errors in 20 games, trailing Rochester (.991) and tied 4th among the 120 full season Minor League teams.

- The clean play extends throughout the roster - of Omaha's 13 qualified fielders (min. 50.0 inn), 8 have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, led by **Kevin Newman** (127.0 innings) in the infield and **Kameron Misner** (143.1 innings) in the outfield.
- 26 double plays turned by the Storm Chasers are tied with the Gwinnett Strippers (Braves Triple-A) for the most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10+ double plays, led by 15 from Toro.

DON'T GET CAUGHT

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the International League's best baserunners.

- Omaha's 92.3% stolen base rate (24-for-26) leads the Triple-A level and ranks 8th of all 120 full-season Minor League teams ... the Chasers are the only team in Triple-A who has been caught stealing 2 times or fewer with at least 10 steals.
- John Rave** leads Omaha and is tied 4th in the International League in steals (9) ... Rave is one of 9 Storm Chasers who has stolen a base without being caught.

CHALLENGING THE SYSTEM

The Omaha Storm Chasers have one of the better Triple-A teams at converting ABB challenges in their favor in 2026.

- Omaha's 61% win rate on challenges ranks tied 2nd at the Triple-A level ... 61 total challenges are the most of any Triple-A team, while 37 successful challenges are 2nd-most converted challenges (1st: Louisville, 38).
- The Chasers' success is driven largely by how aggressive their catchers have been ... **Elias Diaz**, **Eli Marrero** and **Luca Tresh** have challenged at a 3.4% rate, tied for the highest among all 30 Triple-A clubs, yet have won 23 of 37 defensive challenges (62%), with a level-leading 6 strikeout flips while 2nd with 4 walk flips.
- At the plate, Omaha hitters have challenged at a 5.1% rate and converted 14 of 24 (58%) ... 7 strikeouts flips from the hitters ranked tied for 1st.

MISNER ON A MISSION

Outfielder **Kameron Misner** has been the heart of Omaha's offense to open 2026.

- Misner has reached base safely in 16 of 18 games this season, with hits in 15 of 18 ... he produced a league-best 11-game hitting streak from March 28 to April 10, going 13-for-37 (.351) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 14 RBI.
- Misner has driven in a run in 13 of 18 games ... his 21 RBI over 18 games are tied for the International League lead and tied 3rd in the Minor Leagues.

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the team's strengths this season, with a handful of arms standing out.

- Eric Cerantola** has been Omaha's most reliable relief arm to open the year, with 9.1 scoreless innings over 8 games with a Minor League-leading 5 saves ... 9.1 scoreless innings are the 3rd-most scoreless innings in the International League.
- Chazz Martinez** has opened his season with 6.0 scoreless innings over 5 outings, with 10 strikeouts (15.00 K/9) ... **Beck Way** is on a 7.2-inning scoreless streak (since April 7) while **Jose Cuas** has worked 6.0 scoreless frames (since April 4).

HOLY TOLEDO

Since the Chasers joined the International League in 2021, they have won 8 of 15 series with the Mud Hens, but won just 2 of 6 series played in Toledo.

- The Storm Chasers have won 4 of their last 6 series with Toledo across the last 2 years ... since 2024, Omaha is 21-15 (.583) against the Mud Hens.
- On the other side this week is former Storm Chasers outfielder **Tyler Gentry**, who signed a Minor League contract with the Tigers on April 11 ... Gentry's 364 games with Omaha between 2023 and 2025 rank 4th-most in the club's Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... since 2011, he ranks 3rd for Omaha in walks (162), 5th in plate appearances (1393), 6th in doubles (69), 6th in homers (41), 7th in RBI (164).

TODAY'S START

- Luinder Avila is making his **3rd start** this season with the Storm Chasers, his **3rd Triple-A start** this year and his **5th overall appearance**.
- Playing his **8th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- Avila has previously made 1 start against the Mud Hens ... on April 23, 2025, he threw 3.0 innings and allowed 4 runs (3 earned) while striking out 4 at Fifth Third Field

VIVA AVILA

- SLOW AND STEADY WINS THE RACE:** Expect Avila to be working 3-4 innings at a time rather than a full starter's workload ... he missed a portion of spring training while with Team Venezuela at the World Baseball Classic and the Royals want him ready to come up to the Majors as a starter or reliever.
- NO FLY ZONE:** Since his professional debut in 2018, Avila has allowed just 30 home runs in 504.0 innings (between the Majors and Minors) ... his 0.54 HR/9 is the lowest mark among 448 professional pitchers with at least 500.0 innings pitched since 2018.

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, APRIL 15 vs. INDIANAPOLIS

- In his first outing back since being optioned, pitched into a 4th inning for the first time this year ... opened the game with 3.0 scoreless innings ... double plays erased baserunners in the 2nd and 3rd innings ... walked the leadoff batter in the 4th and allowed a 2-run homer to *Esmerlyn Valdez* ... was removed from the game after getting the first 2 outs of the 4th inning.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 2 World Baseball Classic appearances for eventual champion Venezuela and did not allow an earned run over 4.1 innings, striking out 3 while allowing just 1 unearned run on 3 hits.
- Optioned to Omaha on March 20 to open the season in Triple-A ... made 1 start before being recalled for a 2-game, 6-day stint in the big leagues, from April 3 to 8 ... he was originally scheduled to start for Omaha on April 2, but was scratched from his start and instead recalled by Kansas City the next day to make his first MLB start on April 4 ... he worked 3.0 innings of relief on April 8 but was optioned April 9.

- Began the year with Omaha and pitched to a 4.97 ERA (23 ER in 41.2 IP) with 49 strikeouts across 9 appearances (8 starts) before an injury shut him down for two months ... activated on August 5 after a 3-game rehab with Quad Cities (A+) and made 1 start in Omaha before the Royals recalled.
 - Retired all 3 batters he faced in his MLB debut on August 13 vs. Washington ... returned to the Majors on September 1 and posted a 1.29 ERA (2 ER in 14.0 IP) with 16 strikeouts in 13 MLB relief appearances.
- MINOR LEAGUE CAREER**
- Made his Double-A debut and spent most of 2024 with NW Arkansas (AA), posting a 3.81 ERA (35 ER in 82.2 IP) with 82 strikeouts across 19 starts at Double-A ... had a stint on the Injured List from July 10 to August 27 and put up a 2.70 ERA (3 ER in 10.0 IP) in his final 3 starts with the Naturals
 - Made his Triple-A debut on September 21, 2024 @ Louisville (CIN), allowing 5 earned runs in 4.1 innings for the Chasers ... also started the 2024 Triple-A National Championship game vs. Sugar Land (HOU).
 - Spent all of 2023 at Quad Cities (A+) pitching to a 4.39 ERA (53 ER in 108.2 IP) across 22 games (20 starts) ... had two scoreless starts, including 6.0 innings July 22 @ Beloit (MIA), retiring 18 of 20 batters.
 - Pitched with Columbia (A) in both 2021 and 2022, spending all of 2022 with the Fireflies.
