SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Akron RubberDucks, 5-1, to split the first home series at The Diamond this year. **Hayden Birdsong** started and allowed one run over four innings while tying his Double-A high with eight strikeouts. **Eric Silva**, **Jose Cruz** and **Evan Gates** combined to throw five scoreless relief innings. **Luis Toribio** tied the score, 1-1, with an RBI single in the bottom of the fourth. **Adrián Sugastey** gave Richmond the lead with an RBI single in the bottom of the sixth. Two batters later, **Grant McCray** hit a three-run homer, his first at Double-A. **Andy Thomas** had three hits in the game. The Flying Squirrels welcomed 43,428 fans over the homestand at The Diamond.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the first of three series between the two teams this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from July 9-14. The Flying Squirrels return to Harrisburg for a six-game set from August 13-18. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels went 13-8 against the Senators, including a 3-6 mark at FNB Field and a 10-2 record at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS reached the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2022 and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 3-1 in their last four games.

THE SENATORS went 59-77 last year and finished in last place in the Southwest Division for the third consecutive season. This year, they started the season 1-5 but have won their last two games. They went 2-3 in last week's road series at Altoona. Among the Eastern League leaders, Dylan Crews is tied for second in RBIs (9) and Brady House is tied for fourth in hits (11). The Harrisburg roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Dylan Crews (No. 1), 3B Brady House (No. 3), 3B Yohandy Morales (No. 4), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 8), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 17), RHP Cole Henry (No. 24) and C Israel Pineda (No. 25). Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes seven Harrisburg players, including Crews (No. 1), House (No. 3), Morales (No. 5), Hassell (No. 7), Pinckney (No. 19), Henry (No. 22) and LHP Andrew Alvarez (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Reggie Crawford** makes his Double-A debut and his first appearance of 2024. Crawford was selected by the Giants in the first round (30th overall) of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Connecticut. He was originally signed as a two-way player but will focus exclusively on pitching in 2024. Last season between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, Crawford posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) in 13 starts. It was his first year pitching since undergoing Tommy John surgery prior to his 2022 junior season at UConn. He also played in the Arizona Fall League with Scottsdale last year, working as a hitter. Crawford is rated by MLB.com as the No. 8 Giants prospect and No. 9 by Baseball America. He is also rated by Baseball America as having the best fastball and the best slider in the Giants system.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Kyle Luckham makes his second start of the season. He made his first start of the year last Tuesday and allowed two unearned runs over four innings with five strikeouts in a no-decision at Altoona. Last year, he spent most of the season with High-A Wilmington and went 5-7 with a 4.85 ERA in 25 games (24 starts). He finished the year tied for first in the South Atlantic League in games started (24) and innings pitched (124.1) while ranking third in BAA (.252) and WHIP (1.23) and sixth in ERA (4.85). He was promoted to Double-A Harrisburg for his final start of the season on September 15 and allowed four runs (three earned) over five innings against the Baysox. Luckham was selected in the 15th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of Arizona State University.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: In last week's series, the RubberDucks scored 79 percent (14-of-18) of their runs with two outs. They also scored 67 percent (12-of-18) of their runs with two outs and two strikes. Of Akron's six homers, four came with two outs, five came with two strikes and three were with two outs and two strikes. On Tuesday, Aaron Bracho hit a two-run home in the first with two outs and two strikes, the only Akron runs in a 2-1 win. On Wednesday, Dayan Frias hit a go-ahead grand slam in the eighth with two outs and two strikes and Kahlil Watson added a two-out RBI single in the ninth in a 6-3 win. On Thursday, Akron scored its only run in a 2-1 Richmond win on a two-out, two-strike RBI double by Watson in the third. On Friday, Frias hit an RBI single in the first inning with two outs and two strikes and Kody Huff added a two-out homer in the second, but Richmond rallied for a 3-2 win. On Saturday night, Bracho hit a two-run homer in the first inning with two outs and two strikes, Frias added a two-strike homer in the sixth to tie the game and Petey Halpin hit the game-winning, two-run triple in the ninth with two outs and two strikes.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt hit his first homer of the year on Saturday night, a three-run shot to give the Flying Squirrels a lead in the third inning. Last year, Wyatt combined to hit 17 homers between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond, which was tied for fifth in the Giants organization. He hit nine homers in his 64 games with Richmond last season.

BERICOTO BOMBS: Victor Bericoto hit his first homer of the 2024 season on Wednesday night, a solo shot in the first inning that traveled an estimated 388 feet to left. He has now homered 12 times in his 58 games since joining the Flying Squirrels last July. In 2023, Bericoto led the Giants organization in homers (27) and RBIs (86) while playing the season at age 21.

FAMILIAR FACES: Seventeen players on the current roster return from last year's Flying Squirrels team, including **Brett Auerbach**, **Victor Bericoto**, **John Michael Bertrand**, **Hayden Birdsong**, **Vaun Brown**, **Matt Frisbee**, **Evan Gates**, **Jimmy Glownke**, **José Cruz**, **Wil Jensen**, **Ryan Murphy**, **Tyler Myrick**, **Mat Olsen**, **Nick Swiney**, **Andy Thomas**, **Will Wilson** and **Logan Wyatt**. Of those players, five are in their third season with Richmond, including Auerbach, Brown, Gates, Jensen and Murphy. Two players, Frisbee and Wilson, are with the Flying Squirrels for a fourth season.

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: Dennis Pelfrey returns for a third season, tying **Dave Machemer** for the longest tenure by a Flying Squirrels manager in franchise history. He is 72 wins shy of matching Machemer's record for the most victories by a Flying Squirrels manager in team history. He is already the first manager in franchise history to lead the club to multiple postseason appearances with the team reaching the playoffs in back-to-back years for the time in 2022 and 2023.

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).
