THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge wrap-up a six game road trip today in Springdale, Arkansas, against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals. The Wind Surge have won nine of their last twelve games, winning the final two games in Little Rock and winning five of six at home against the defending league champion Springfield Cardinals. The Naturals won four of seven this season against the Surge, taking two of three on opening weekend in the ICT.

SURGE x NATURALS - The Wind Surge and Naturals meet for the first of two six game series this season in The Natural State. The Wind Surge won the season series last year, taking 10 of 18 meetings. The all-time record between the teams has the Surge with a narrow lead 58-56. The Naturals relocated to Arkansas from Wichita in 2008 after previously playing as the Wichita Wranglers.

SURGE & NATURALS WASHED OUT - The heavy rains Saturday forced the game to be postponed. The teams will play a doubleheader today.

DH ON TAP- Today's games will be the first twin bills of the season. The Wind Surge all time doubleheader record is four sweeps, five times being swept and six splits. In 2025 the team split one, got swept once and split a pair. Wichita swept a DH vs the Nats in 2024.

GETTING ON BASE - Garrett Spain extended his on-base streak to seven games. Ricardo Olivar extended his on-base streak to ten games and recorded his fourth multi-hit performance, and has five extra-base hits in his last four games. Billy Amick hit his fourth home run of the season last night Ty Langenberg is set to start his fourth start of the season and his fifth game. It will be his second of the season against the Naturals, he pitched four innings, allowed two runs in a loss opening weekend. He is 0-1 with a 2.16 ERA this season. The 24-year-old is his fourth season and last year was 5-6 with a 4.87 ERA in 22 games at Cedar Rapids. and has homered in back-to-back games. Andrew Cossetti has reached base in five consecutive games.

ON THE BUMP- The Surge will start Sam Armstrong today, he will make his third start of the season and appear in fifth game. The 25-year-old Armstrong was acquired last July from the Cubs. He is in his fourth season of professional baseball. Last week he picked up a win in relief vs Springfield and followed with a Sunday start pitching four and two third scoreless innings.

*Ty Langenberg is set to start his fifth start of the season and his sixth game. It will be his third of the season against the Naturals, he pitched four innings, allowed two runs in a loss opening weekend. On Tuesday he three innings, allowed four runs. He is 0-1 with a 3.66 ERA this season. The 24-year-old is his fourth season and last year was 5-6 with a 4.87 ERA in 22 games at Cedar Rapids.

THE LONG BALL - The Wind Surge hammered a season high six home runs Thursday night, franchise high (7). The club has hit 23 home runs over the last nine games and have 32 for the season, lead the league and all of Class AA. 17 of the last 23 home runs have all been solo home runs and 21 of the 32 home runs have been solo shots this season. Nine different Surge players have gone yard, the team has homered in ten straight games and all but four games this season.

*The Wind Surge have had four players this season have multi-home run games. (Mendez, Ross, Olivar and Salas)

KRUSH EM KALA'I - Kala'i Rosario hammered his third home run of the season on Wednesday and moved to tops in Wind Surge franchise with 37 home runs, moving ahead of Aaron Sabato, 36. He is tied for most walks with Jake Rucker, second in RBI, doubles, and runs scored. Rosario is tied for the team lead this season with Ben Ross with four game winning RBI.

OLLIE - Ricardo Olivar three game home run streak ended Friday, he has gone deep four times in the series, the Wind Surge catcher has a five game hit streak, 6x17, 10 runs, four home runs and eight RBI. He has reached base in ten straight games.

STRIKE EM OUT! The Wind Surge are third in the league with 196 strikeouts. The team has 11 games of double digits.
