2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Last season was cut short for Kyle Brnovich as he made just two short starts in Triple-A Norfolk and after eight innings his season ended as it was discovered he needed Tommy John Surgery and he's now in the recovery process.

ON THE WAY BACK: Kyle Brnovich is in the beginning stages of his rehab assignment as he looks to regain his form he had prior to needing Tommy John Surgery last season. He's only pitched one, full-season in professional baseball and that was in 2021 when he made a combined 23 appearances between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie, striking out a total of 123 batters across 95 innings while maintaining an ERA of 3.32. Brnovich was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Angels in the 8th round of the 2019 draft but never pitched for the organization as the Orioles acquired him just a few months later in a December trade that sent starting pitcher Dylan Bundy to the Angels. Brnovich came to Baltimore along with RHP Kyle Braddish, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek.



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.
