Tonight's Games: The Sounds take on the Tides in a doubleheader after yesterday's rainout. It'll be a prospect battle between Logan Henderson and Chayce McDermott in game one, followed by Taylor Clarke and Adrian Houser in game two.

Logan Henderson: The 22-year-old Texan gets his 19th start in the minors and sixth start for the Sounds in game one. He is 1-3 with a 5.49 ERA (19.2 IP/12 ER) since joining the Sounds on August 8 from Double-A Biloxi. After allowing just one earned run through his first two outings with Nashville (10.0 IP), he has allowed multiple earned runs in his last three, including five runs in a loss to Memphis on September 10. Henderson is trying to find the success he had in the lower levels this season, after posting a 1.35 ERA (6.2 IP/1 ER) in two starts for High-A Wisconsin and 6-2 with a 3.30 ERA (46.1 IP/17 ER) in nine starts for the Shuckers. He's had more success on the road with Nashville than at home, going 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP/2 ER) away from First Horizon Park (compared to 0-3 with a 9.31 ERA at home). The Houston native attended McLennan Community College and was selected in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by Milwaukee.

Chayce McDermott: The 26-year-old returns from the injured list to make his 22nd appearance and 21st start for the Tides. He is 4-5 with a 3.90 ERA (97.0 IP/42 ER) with Norfolk this season. He has faced Nashville twice this season, including throwing 6.2 innings of a combined no hitter on May 3.

Taylor Clarke: The 31-year-old is making his 22nd appearance and 15th start in game two. It's the first time the veteran is facing the Tides in his home state. He last pitched on September 7 vs. Gwinnett, allowing a pair of runs in four inning in a no-decision. Clarke was acquired by Milwaukee in a trade with Kansas City on December 14, 2023.

Adrian Houser: The 31-year-old makes his third start for Norfolk since being signed to a minor league contract by Baltimore on August 31. Houser has spent much of his career in the Brewers organization, being acquired from Houston in 2015 and pitching for Milwaukee from 2015 to 2023. Houser has made seven starts for the Sounds on rehab assignment in 2022 and 2023.

Hicklen a Hero: Brewer Hicklen delivered in the clutch, coming through with an RBI single that scored Vinny Capra and gave Nashville a 2-1 win in 10 innings over Memphis. It was the first time Nashville had back-to-back walk-off wins since April 28 (4-3 vs. Omaha, Skye Bolt scores on throwing error) and April 29 (6-5 vs. Omaha, Keston Hiura single scores Eddy Alvarez) in the 2023 season. The Sounds finish the 2024 campaign with seven walk-off wins at First Horizon Park, six fewer than 13 in 2023. They have a total of 70 walk-off wins since First Horizon Park opened in 2015.

Guitar Heros: On Sunday, the Nashville Sounds presented the 2024 player awards. Brewer Hicklen and Isaac Collins were both awarded the team MVP award. Chad Patrick received the Pitcher of the Year honor. Vinny Capra was voted the Sounds Fan Favorite Player by fans on social media. Kevin Herget was also honored as the Community Player of the Year. Also, the team recognized athletic trainer Jeff Paxson on winning his second straight International League Trainer of the Year award.

Patrick is a Star: Chad Patrick dominated hitters once again last Sunday, striking out a dozen Red-birds across six scoreless innings in a no-decision. Patrick leads Triple-A in ERA (2.95), wins (13), WHIP (1.10) and win percentage (.929) and ranks among Triple-A qualified leaders in opponent batting average (T-2nd, .219), strikeouts (T-2nd, 138) and innings pitched (7th, 131.1). It was his 10th quality start of the season - he is one of seven pitchers in Triple-A with double-digit quality starts. The Sounds are 20-3 with Patrick on the mound. After Robert Gasser's 166 strikeouts last season, the Sounds have had a pitcher reach 135+ strikeouts in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-2003 (Salomon Torres 136 in 2022, Ryan Vogelsong 146 in 2003).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history - he has 396 wins and could reach the 400 mark with four wins in the last six games. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 757-647 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,350-2,167 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Most Wins by Minor League Managers

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

- Faced 91 consecutive batters without allowing a walk before issuing free pass to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. on June 7, ending a nine-pitch plate appearance...was the fourth-longest batters faced streak to begin a season in Royals history
- One of three pitchers to issue no more than eight walks while making at least 45 appearances (also Chris Martin and Joe Mantiply)
- Earned second-career MLB save on April 28 at Chicago-AL with a scoreless ninth...was the first player in MLB history to record each of his first two saves against each Chicago teams

- In his 10th professional season; 1st with Milwaukee
- Earned 3.0-inning save in Major League debut on April 20, 2019 at Chicago-NL...recorded a hit (single off Randy Rosario) to become the first MLB player in history to record a hit and save in MLB debut
- Was the second player (Sammy Stewart w/ Baltimore in 1978) to record a win, loss and save across first three MLB appearances
- Graduated from Broad Run High School (VA) in 2011...played at Towson University in 2012 and transferred to College of Charleston and played from 2013-15
