

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! The Quakes complete a six-game series as they host the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) in the final game of a six-game series. Kids can "Run the Bases" after today's series-finale thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Game time is 2pm. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the ninth of 24 head-to-head games, with 15 of those taking place here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 7-1 against the Storm this year after winning four of five in this current series. Last season, the Quakes went just 10-20 against the Storm, 7-8 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Storm rallied and held on for a 6-5 win over Rancho Cucamonga on Saturday night at LoanMart Field, snapping a number of different streaks. In earning their first win of the second half and first head-to-head win over the Quakes this year (1-7), the Storm ended their own seven-game losing streak. Rancho's season-best ninegame winning streak also came to an end. B.Y. Choi had a go-ahead, three-run double in the third and Kavares Tears smashed his team-high eighth homer for the Storm. Rancho starter Jholbran Herder (3-1) gave up four runs in 2.2 innings in the loss. Storm reliever Adam Conrad (4-1) pitched 2.2 innings of scoreless relief for the win, while Xavier Ruiz worked two scoreless innings to finish off his first save of the year. The Storm out-hit Rancho 9-8, but also committed a season-worst six errors on the night. Rancho's Oswaldo Osorio had two hits and three runs scored.

"ALL GOOD THINGS...: The Quakes saw some long streaks come to an end last night, as they had won a season-high nine straight games overall and four straight here at home. Last night's loss makes them 21-11 at LoanMart Field. Their longest winning streak of 2024 was eight straight games. Their longest winning streak since moving from High-A to Low-A is 10 straight (2023). Their longest winning streak in franchise history was back in their third and most recent championship season of 2018, when they won 15 straight in the second half.

FIRST HALF SOUTH DIVISION CHAMPS: After stumbling a bit over a two-week stretch with an eight-game losing streak while both Visalia and Lake Elsinore were in the middle of seven-game win streaks, respectively, the Quakes put all doubt behind them by wrapping up the First Half South Division with last Friday's win over the 66ers in San Bernardino. The Quakes will now return to the playoffs for the first time since 2023, when they made it to the Championship Series, where they were swept by Modesto. The Quakes will have qualified for the playoffs in nine of the 14 seasons (2011, 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2023 and 2025) of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. Ran cho has won three Championships in franchise history (1994, 2015 and 2018) with the last two coming as a Dodgers' affiliate. This will mark the second time in five seasons they'll make it to the playoffs under Manager John Shoemaker. **DODGER REHABBER:** RHP Luis Garcia of the Dodgers will become the second Dodger rehabber of the year, joining OF Teoscar Hernandez, who appeared in one game for the Quakes back in May. Garcia is scheduled to go one inning today, as he attempts to return from a right adductor strain. This year for the Dodgers, he's 2-0 with an ERA of 4.50 in 26 relief outings. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yamavaa' Resort and Casino at San Manuel. **LUIS GARCIA:** The 38-year-old right-hander is set to start and make his first ever appearance for the Quakes. The Dominican Republic native was signed as a free agent in the off-season and is a veteran of 13 big-league seasons. WILL VARMETTE: The 22-year-old right-hander will make his first start against the Quakes and his 12th appearance and ninth start overall. In six games against the Quakes in 2024, he was 3-1 with a 3.38 ERA over 13.1 innings. His last outing overall, he allowed four runs (one earned) on three hits over 2.2 innings in a no-decision vs Visalia on June 15th. Varmette signed with San Diego in July of 2023, after going undrafted out of Wallace State CC in Alabama. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
