### JACKSONVILLE EDGES CHARLOTTE 2-1

The Jumbo Shrimp pitching dominated Wednesday in a 2-1 victory over the Knights. Charlotte scored the game's first run on a third-inning error. Jacksonville finally got a pair of runs on the board in the sixth on an RBI ground out from **Marty Costes** and **Jonathan Davis** RBI single. **Edward Cabrera** struck out nine in 5.2 innings in his third rehab start. **Kyle Tyler**, **Devin Smeltzer** and **Luarbert Arias** combined for 3.1 scoreless innings of relief, striking out four Knights.

### 'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen has excelled of late. Over the club's last three games, Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to yield just one run on six hits in 13.0 innings with 12 strikeouts against two walks. On the season, Jacksonville's bullpen has posted a 3.83 ERA while throwing 44.2 innings - the sixth-fewest of any International League team entering play on Thursday.

### GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City. The Missouri City, Texas native homered in five consecutive games from April 2-6, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since **Peter O'Brien** went yard in six straight games from June 6-11, 2018. Over the last seven games, six of which came against Durham, Gray went a combined 9-for-28 (.321) with a double, five home runs, eight RBIs, two walks and seven runs scored. During his career with the Bulls, Gray batted .233/.300/.474/.774 with 59 doubles, five triples, 71 home runs, 220 RBIs and 179 runs scored.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on March 31 and a 6-2 defeat to Durham on Saturday, all nine of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 7-2 in those affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

### WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won six of their last eight games. All six of those victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville outscoring their opponents 34-28. Relatedly, those 34 runs scored rank in a tie for eighth-fewest in Triple-A during this stretch. However, their 28 runs allowed are tied for the third-fewest at the level since this stretch began on April 2. The Jumbo Shrimp's 3.21 ERA also places third during this stretch.

### SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 11 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 40 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 18-for-100 (.180/.314/.310/.624, ranking 30th, 27th, 29th and 28th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 75 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

### TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

### SHRIMP BITES

Of the 22 innings Jacksonville in which has scored in this season, 12 have been multi-run frames... **José Devers** has hits in eight consecutive games, batting 10-for-29 (.345) with three doubles, a triple, home run, five RBIs, two walks and six runs scored.

### ABOUT DARREN

-McCaughan was originally selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2017 draft out of Long Beach State. McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 by pitching 5.0 innings of one-run ball at Coors Field against the Colorado Rockies.

-On February 9, 2024, two days after being designated for assignment, McCaughan was dealt to the Marlins in exchange for cash considerations.

-A terrific collegiate pitcher, McCaughan earned Big West Pitcher of the Year following both his sophomore (2016) and junior (2017) seasons at Long Beach State. He also became the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to be receive multiple All-American honors in consecutive seasons.

-With 414 strikeouts in 84 starts with Triple-A Tacoma, McCaughan is the "Rainiers" all-time strikeout leader (during Seattle affiliation, since 1995), and has accumulated the third-most strikeouts in franchise history. Ron Herbel (443 K) and Steve Luebber (431 K) from the 1980s and 70s remain the only hurlers who've fanned more batters than McCaughan during Tacoma's Triple-A history (since 1960).

### 2024 SEASON

-Tabbed as Opening Day starter for Jacksonville, tossed six innings and struck out four en route to 5-4 win over Gwinnett.

### 2023 SEASON

-In 12 home starts for Tacoma, McCaughan went 4-1, allowing 31 R, 25 ER on 55 hits in 67.2 innings for a 3.33 ERA.

-Held opponents to a .218 batting average when pitching at home.

-Led all Tacoma pitchers in IP (139.0), starts (25), complete games (T-1st, 1) and strikeouts (130).

### 2022 SEASON
