2025 Media Notes – July 13th at Aberdeen (Orioles)

South Atlantic League Champions: 2006, 2009, 2010

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Jersey Shore BlueClaws (8-12/33-50) vs Aberdeen IronBirds (8-12/32-53)

Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium – Aberdeen, Maryland (opened 2002)

RHP Reese Dutton (1-1, 5.73) vs RHP Ty Weatherly (0-2, 7.76)

Series: Game 6 of 6 (season series tied 11-11 of 29)

Last Game Recap...Braydon Tucker threw seven scoreless innings, allowing two hits and retiring 21 of 23 batters faced, and the BlueClaws topped Aberdeen 4-1 on Saturday night at Ripken Stadium...Jersey Shore hit three home runs in the game – solo shots by Kehden Hettiger, Bryson Ware, and Zach Arnold.

The Claws and the Birds...The BlueClaws and IronBirds meet for the fourth time this week (JS leads 3-2)...Aberdeen went 9-8 at Jersey Shore in three first-half visits to Lakewood (the 18th game, on Father's Day, was cancelled by rain)...This week marks their first of two meetings in the second half, both in Aberdeen.

Going, Going Gone...The BlueClaws hit three home runs in the win on Saturday, one each by Kehden Hettiger, Bryson Ware, and Zach Arnold...The BlueClaws had hit seven home runs from June 10th through Friday, and this was only their second multi-home run game in that stretch (they hit two on 7/3 vs Wilmington at ShoreTown Ballpark).

Back on the Board...Kehden Hettiger's home run on Saturday was his first one since June 8th and his seventh of the season with the BlueClaws...Hettiger homered in his first BlueClaws at bat on 4/17 at Greensboro...Hettiger is 13-37 since June 27th, adding a home run and three doubles...He was an 11th round pick in 2023 from Sierra Canyon HS (CA).

Tip Top Tucker...Braydon Tucker threw seven scoreless innings in a game since...Braydon Tucker on 9/7/24 at Aberdeen...He gave up two hits and retired 21 of the 23 batters he faced in the win...Tucker gave up nine runs, against Aberdeen, in 1.2 innings in his second appearance of the year on 4/13 at ShoreTown Ballpark, but since then, has an ERA of just 2.75...He has not allowed a run in three of his four starts.

Ware 'em Out...Bryson Ware hit his 8th home run of the season on 7/12 at Aberdeen, and went 3-4 in the win...Since May 9th, Bryson Ware is 40-135 (.296) with seven of his eight home runs and 10 doubles...Between Opening Day and May 8th, he was hitting .107 with one extra base hit, a triple...Ware has started games this year at 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, and RF...He was an 8th round pick from Auburn in 2023.

AOA on a ROLL...Avery Owusu-Asiedu had three hits in game two of the double-header on Thursday and is now 13-35 with two doubles and a home run in July...Owusu-Asiedu already has five multi-hit games with Jersey Shore...He hit his first BlueClaws home run (16th of his career) on July 3rd in Lakewood...A 9th round pick in 2023 from Southern Illinois, Owusu-Asiedu began the year with Clearwater where he was hitting .268 with five home runs and 16 stolen bases...He hit nine home runs with the Threshers last year.

Hello Aroon...Aroon Escobar (6-20, 2 RBIs), the #6 prospect in the Phillies system per MLB Pipeline, has joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater...Escobar was hitting .285 with 11 home runs, 42 RBIs, and 10 stolen bases with the Threshers...At the time of his promotion, Escobar was 6th in the FSL in average, T1st (with teammate Eduardo Tait) in home runs, 5th in RBIs, 1st in hits (78), and 1st in runs (52). Hit .360 with five home runs and a 1.088 OPS in April, winning Phillies Minor League Player of the Month.

Getting Biddy With It...IF Nick Biddison is 4-14 this week and is 12-44 with the BlueClaws since arriving on June 28th...He hit his first BlueClaws home run on July 3rd...He was acquired from the Dodgers and most recently with AA Tulsa...Biddington was originally a 4th round pick in 2022 from Virginia Tech...He spent last year with Great Lakes in the Midwest League, hitting .220 with seven home runs and 21 stolen bases...He missed the first month of this season with an injury and was with Tulsa at the time of the trade to Philadelphia...Biddison was originally a 4th round pick of the Dodgers from Virginia Tech in 2022...He was a teammate of 2025 BlueClaws OF Dylan Campbell last year with Great Lakes and with 2025 BlueClaws IF Carson DeMartini in 2022 at Virginia Tech.

Shake and Bake...Andrew Baker threw two scoreless innings in game one of the double-header on Thursday to earn his first BlueClaws save and only his second professional save in what was his 162nd career appearance...His other save was on 8/5/23 with Reading at Hartford and came after he walked a batter, hit a batter, and walked another...Since allowing four runs in 2/3 of an inning against Aberdeen on June 13th, Baker has made seven appearances and allowed one run in nine innings with 13 strikeouts.

Alex on Fire...BlueClaws RHP Alex McFarlane has thrown five scoreless innings in each of his last three starts (and did not allow a hit in two of the three...He has lowered his ERA from 7.02 to 5.04 in the three starts (had allowed seven runs in 1.2 innings on June 18th vs Hudson Valley in his start prior to the current stretch)...He fanned six and gave up three hits on Wednesday at Aberdeen...He struck out four against Wilmington on July 2nd and struck out nine against Brooklyn on June 25th...He was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for the week ending June 29th...McFarlane was a 4th round pick in 2022 from the University of Miami.

Welcome Back Saul...Saul Teran (one inning, one unearned run on Saturday) is back with the BlueClaws after spending the weekend with Double-A Somerset...He has allowed three runs in 11.1 innings with Jersey Shore, adding 11 strikeouts and his five saves lead the team...He gave up two earned runs in 18 innings, adding 31 strikeouts and three walks with Clearwater before originally joining the BlueClaws on June 2nd...Teran, 23, signed with the Phillies in 2021.

Raylin's Back...Raylin Heredia had two hits and two RBIs on Tuesday at Aberdeen, his first two-hit game since returning from the IL on July 4th (5-23 since returning)...Heredia got off to a hot start, going 16-48 with two HRs and 13 RBIs in 16 games through May 2nd before breaking a pinky finger diving for a fly ball in centerfield...The 21 year old spent last year with Clearwater, hitting .245 with eight home runs.

Extra, Extra...Extra innings? No problem! The BlueClaws are 6-0 in extra innings this season after their win on Friday at Wilmington...They are the only team in the South Atlantic League without an extra innings loss this season...They are one of only three teams in Minor League Baseball without a loss in extra innings this year – Albuquerque (3-0), and Fort Wayne (the only team in MiLB that has not played an extra inning game this season)...Durham was 7-0 but lost in 10 on 7/5 at Norfolk.

New to the Bullpen...RHP Jose Pena Jr. has thrown three innings without allowing an earned run since joining the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he was 4-1 with five saves and a 0.71 ERA (2 ER in 25.1 IP with 23 strikeouts and seven walks)...Pena did not allow an earned run in his last nine games and 12.2 innings with the Threshers (two hits, six strikeouts)...He was drafted by the Phillies in the 6th round of the 2021 draft, spending three years with the FCL Phillies and two with Clearwater.

Balk This Way...The BlueClaws lead the minors with 35 balks (tied with Asheville) and are in balking distance of the 48 set by Lynchburg in 2023, the most in minors since at least 2005...Jersey Shore has balked in nine runs this year, tied with Asheville for the most in the minors (including one last Friday, Saturday, and Sunday in Brooklyn)...The BlueClaws had a club record five balks on 5/9 vs Aberdeen, and four each on 6/27 and 6/29 at Brooklyn...This year, only three teams have issued at least four balks in a game, the BlueClaws three times, and Aberdeen on 5/1 at Brooklyn (4)...The BlueClaws single-season record was 20 (last year).

Save Index...Andrew Baker got his first save of the year and second professional save (August of 2023 with Reading) by getting the last six outs in the game one win on Thursday at Aberdeen...Saul Teran earned his fifth save in game one of the double-header on July 2nd...Teran's five lead the team and he is halfway to becoming the first BlueClaws since Zach Warren and Addison Russ in 2018 to reach double-digits...Paxton Thompson earned the save June 25th at Brooklyn, his third of the season and first since May 25th...Jayden Estanistata (promoted to Reading) picked up his fourth save, and eighth of his career, with a scoreless inning in game one on June 7th at Bowling Green...Tommy McCollum (promoted to Reading on 5/1), has three.

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 29 times this season, the last time on July 5th at Wilmington (Asheville has allowed 31 such innings), in 27 different games over which they are 2-25...Their second win was on 6/7 at Bowling Green (allowed four runs in the seventh and won in 10)...Their other win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5th of the seven inning game)...15 of the 27 innings have included multiple walks.

From the Draft...OF Joel Drago, (7th round, 2024 from Presbyterian) joined the BlueClaws on June 24th and became the only member of the 2024 draft class on the team...Carson DeMartini (4th round, Virginia Tech) was with Jersey Shore from Opening Day through June 9th...Aaron Combs was an 8th round pick last year by the White Sox and traded to the Phillies (for LHP Tyler Gilbert) on New Year's Day...DeMartini was the only 2024 draft class member to open the season with Jersey Shore, marking the third straight season the BlueClaws have only had one member of the preceding year's draft class on the Opening Day roster (Troy Schreffer, 12th round in 2022 in 2023, Zach Arnold, 13th round in 2023 in 2024).

The All-Star Break runs from July 14-17. The BlueClaws return home on July 18 to take on Hudson Valley at ShoreTown Ballpark.

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes four players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Gabriel Barbosa (Minor League Rule-5 Draft from the Yankees), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), RHP Josh Hejka (from the Mets in February for cash considerations), and OF Elio Prado (Minor League Rule-5 from the Orioles)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft.

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10th to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning – they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9th inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in the inning.

Power Index...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell (since promoted) hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have one walk-off win this year – a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 –July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Snapped at Four...The BlueClaws entered 2025 with four straight winning halves (a streak that has been snapped), both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the 2011 season.

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...127 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show*...Otto Kemp made his Phillies debut on 6/7 and Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18, the first two to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerker (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersey.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching coach after spending the last two seasons with Lehigh Valley...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Matt Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization – he was the Assistant Hitting Coordinator for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach since 2020...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws as the Bench Coach...2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.

How Acquired: Non-drafted Free Agent, signed 7/2024 (University of Kansas, KS)

Season Notes: Threw career long six innings on 7/6 at WIL, allowing three runs and taking the loss...Struck out six over five innings (three runs) on 6/26 at BRK...Earned win in BlueClaws debut on 6/7 at BG (3 IP, 2 ER)...Joined the BlueClaws on 6/5 from Clearwater, where he was 0-1, 3.86 in 11 games (four starts) with 39 strikeouts and 11 walks in 39.2 innings...His longest outing with the Threshers was five innings on 5/18 vs LAK, allowing one run with seven strikeouts.

Career Notes: Made pro debut with Clearwater, throwing six scoreless innings with six strikeouts over two appearances...Spent one year at Kansas where he was the Friday night starter and a second team All-Big 12 performer...Prior to Kansas, spent one year at USC-Upstate and three at Heartland CC (IL)...College teammate of 2024 Phillies draftees C Kodey Shojinaga (6th round) and RHP Tegan Cain (13th round) and Kansas.
