ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wilson Warbirds used a pair of home runs, including a grand slam home run from Handelfry Encarnacion as they routed the Salem RidgeYaks 11-2 on Friday night at Wilson Ballpark. The other big blow, came as part of a three-run fifth inning when Frederi Montero crushed a two-run home run to give the Warbirds the lead for good. Thomas Conrad worked 3.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen to earn the victory.

STARTING STRONG: Wilson has gotten tremendous starting pitching over the last three games of the series against Salem. Jarrette Bonet, Andrew Healy and Tyler Renz have combined for a pitching line of: 13.1 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 2 BB and 13 strikeouts which equates to a 1.37 ERA over the last three starts. The three starters have all gone at least 4.0 innings in all of their starts.

BRADY BUNCHING HITS: Wilson infielder Brady Ebel got off to a slow start in 2026. Over his first 10 games, Ebel hit .057 (2-for-35) with no extra base hits, 3 RBI, 7 BB and 11 K. Since that tough stretch, over his last 12 games Ebel is batting .274 (14-for-51) with a triple, three doubles, 8 RBI, 11 BB and 13 K. The Brewers first round selection in 2025 has also posted four multi-hit games over the last 10 games.

DIGGIN' THE LONGBALL: The Warbirds have hit 14 home runs this season and five of them have come in the last three games against Salem. In total, 9 of the Warbirds 14 home runs (64%) have been hit at Wilson Ballpark. Those totals include the first grand slam in Warbirds history hit by Handelfry Encarnacion on May 1st. The grand slam was the first for the franchise since July 23, 2025 when Filippo Di Turi hit one against Kannapolis.

STRIKEOUTS ARE NOT BORING: The Wilson Warbirds pitching staff has been one of the best in the Carolina League when it comes to striking out opposing batters. Entering Saturday's game, the Warbirds have posted 257 strikeouts which ranks sixth in the Carolina League.

BULLPEN BATTLES: Not surprisingly, the Wilson bullpen has logged a lot of innings to open the 2026 season. Warbird relievers have tossed 121.2 innings so far this season with a 5.70 ERA (77 ER) with 71 walks and 152 strikeouts. The bullpen has also posted a record of 7-7 compared to the starters who have gone 3-8 with a 4.15 ERA (43 ER, 93.1 IP).

HIGHLIGHTING JOSE: Jose Anderson has been a bright-spot in the Warbirds line-up to start 2026. Entering Friday, Anderson ranks in the top-10 in the Carolina League in: T-2nd RBI (21), T-3rd Home Runs (5) and T-9th 2B (6). In early April, Anderson put together a team-best 10-game on base streak in which he posted a line of .237 (9-38), 2 HR, 3 2B, 15 RBI, 6 BB, 18 K

APRIL SUCCESS: Early season success is nothing new for the Brewers Carolina League affiliate, especially to start the season. Over the last 2+ seasons, the franchise has posted a record of 41-25 in the month of April.

MAY BALL: Dating back to the 2021 season, the organization has posted a record of 77-49 in the month of May and has not posted a losing record in the month during that span. Over the last five seasons, the club has won 16 games in the month, twice.

WELCOME HOME: The Wilson Warbirds 2026 season marks the first time the City of Wilson has hosted a professional baseball team in more than 50 years. The last professional baseball team to call Wilson home was the Wilson Pennants in 1973 part of the CO-OP League, the team finished 52-88. The Minnesota Twins have had the longest affiliation with city, with a Twins farm team calling Wilson home for eight seasons.

WHAT IS A WARBIROD: The Wilson Warbirds are set to take the field for the first time this season. The Warbirds #TakeFlight after the franchise played the previous 35 seasons as the Carolina Mudcats in Zebulon. The Warbirds narrative connects to Wilson native Vollis Simpson, a WWII pilot-turned-artist whose Whirligig sculptures – several stories tall and powered by the wind-tower in Whirligig Park, located directly behind left field in the new Wilson downtown stadium.

Designed to symbolize historical significance and unmatched speed, the logo celebrates community passions for baseball, aviation, and Americana. Warbird restoration is a reverential process that parallels the active revitalization of Historic Downtown Wilson and echoes a commitment to preserving cultural legacy while embracing innovation.
