Norfolk Tides LHP Cade Povich (5-1, 2.08) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Jason Alexander (2-4, 4.83)

Turning 50 – The Worcester Red Sox – who have lost three in a row for the first time in nearly six weeks – look to get back on the winning track and avoid matching their longest losing streak of the season when they play Game 5 of their 6-game series against the Norfolk Tides (AAA-Baltimore) today at 4:05 pm at Polar Park (live on NESN+ as well as on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). The WooSox – who are playing Game #50 today out of their 150 game schedule – have dropped three straight to the Tides and need a win today to avoid equaling their season-long 4-game losing skid from April 10-14 (G1).

This Series – The WooSox won the opener of the series on Tuesday in resounding fashion, 20-4, but the Tides have bounced back to win the last three games. Norfolk scored runs in the top of the 9th inning to break ties during both their wins on Wednesday (4-3) and Thursday (6-3), but last night the Tides held on for a 9-5 victory to take a 3 games to 1 lead in this 6-game set. Worcester is 4-4-0 in their first 8 series of the season and need to win both today and tomorrow to register their first split of the year.

This Homestand – Worcester is also on a 3-game home losing streak that matches their longest of the season from April 15 (G2) – April 17. The WooSox have not lost 4 in a row at home since last August 29 – September 2 when these Norfolk Tides (or a reasonable facsimile) won the first 5 games of a 6-game series at Polar Park. The Sox are now 5-5 on this season-high 12-game homestand that continues today at 4:05 pm and concludes tomorrow at 1:05 pm. The Sox began the homestand by taking 4 of 6 games from the 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders last week/weekend.

What Have You Done for me Lately – Despite three consecutive setbacks, Worcester is still 6-6 in their last dozen game and they have won 13 of their last 24 games since April 28. The Sox have also won 11 of their last 17 home games at Polar Park and have won 14 of their last 21 home games dating back to April 16.

Three Below – The WooSox (now 23-26 on the year) had returned to the .500 level after Tuesday's rout for the first time since May 5th (at 16-16). They have not been 4-games under since April 28 when they were 11-15. The Sox have not been over .500 since they were 2-1 on March 31.

Tides Pulling Away - As a result of their wins the past three days, Norfolk has broken Tuesday's deadlock with the WooSox for 5th-place in the IL East. The Tides are now 26-23 on the season while the WooSox are 23-26. Norfolk is tied for 3rd-place in the IL East and 6- games behind Scranton/Wilkes-Barre while the WooSox are in 6th-place and 9-games out.

Taking on the Champs – The WooSox are hosting Norfolk this week/weekend for the only time this season. The Tides are led by top prospects INF Jackson Holliday, OF Heston Kierstad, and INF Colby Mayo (who is currently on the injured list). Old friends reliever Kaleb Ort and former WooSox assistant hitting coach and current Norfolk hitting coach also come back to Worcester as members of the Tides. Last season, Norfolk won the first half of the International League schedule with their 48-26 record and took on Durham (second half champs) in the International League Playoffs last September 26-28. The Tides lost the opener but then won the final two games to capture the Governors' Cup Championship. Two nights later in Las Vegas, Norfolk defeated Pacific Coast League Champion Oklahoma City (AAA-Dodgers), 7-6 to win the Triple-A National Championship Game.

Worcester vs. Norfolk – The WooSox – 1-3 here thus far this week - were 5-7 vs. Norfolk last season, but went just 1-5 at Polar Park compared to 4-2 in Norfolk. The clubs met last June 13-18 in Virginia with the Sox taking 4 of 6 including the final three games in a row to become the first team in 2023 to win a series vs. Norfolk. Norfolk came to Worcester a little more than two months later from August 29 – September 3 and the Tides won 5 of 6 although the WooSox did win the finale, 5-4. Worcester also played in Norfolk, VA during the 2022 season splitting a 6-game set from July 12-17, 2022. So, Worcester is now 9-13 all-time vs. the Tides.

Two for Ones — Worcester was the only team without a 1-run victory this season — until May 16 (and then May 17 as well). The WooSox were 0-7 in 1-run games this year until their dramatic, 13-12 win on May 16 followed by May 17th's 9-8 triumph. They are now 2-8 in 1-run affairs. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 4-5 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

Daydream Believers - Worcester has had more success this season in day games (14-12) than at night (9-14).

Four of a Kind – The WooSox had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a season-long 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – Sox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 37 times this season.

Rankings – Worcester is 14^{th} in the IL in team batting with a .248 average while Norfolk is 5^{th} at .262. On the pitching side, the Sox are 12^{th} in team ERA (5.12) while the Tides are 10^{th} with a 4.89 ERA.

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 13 CFB victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off.

Series Math – Worcester is 4-4-0 in their first eight series of 2024 (4 wins, 4 losses, and no splits). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

May So Far – Worcester is 11-11 in May. Sox pitchers have a 4.86 ERA (100 ER in 185 IP) with 20 HRA while Sox batters are hitting .256 this month (178-for-695) with 31 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5th-place and 7 games back. They were in 8th-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made 271 player transactions during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used

79 different players in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (23-20) split a doubleheader at home vs. Hartford last night. The Sea Dogs won the opener, 7-4 behind Zach Penrod who improved to 4-0 – 5.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 9 SO. Matthew Lugo drilled a solo HR (#10) while Roman Anthony (2-run double) and Kyle Teel (RBI double) also had big hits. The Yard Goats took game two, 6-3 as Wyatt Olds (1-2) suffered the loss – 2.1 IP, 4 R.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of this afternoon. Worcester has already used 49 players this season (21 position players and 28 pitchers). The list does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox on May 3 but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on May 12 with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 10 players to Boston in the 8 weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, and RHP Nick Pivetta who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Dalbec, Uwasawa, and Heineman are all back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
