### MCINTOSH HOMERS IN 6-2 WIN OVER MEMPHIS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp plated five runs in the final two innings to take a 6-2 win over the Memphis Redbirds Friday night at AutoZone Park. Entering the eighth inning tied at one, the Jacksonville (48-57, 16-15) offense came alive. With one out, **Dane Myers** walked and scored on a double from **Jacob Amaya** to give the Jumbo Shrimp the 2-1 lead. After a flyout, **Paul McIntosh** (4) blasted a two-run homer off Memphis (54-52, 15-16) reliever **Dalton Roach** (L, 1-2), to make it a 4-1 game. Following a homer by **Luken Baker**, Jacksonville added two runs in the ninth to take a four-run lead, 6-2.

### X MARKS THE SPOT

**Xavier Edwards** was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 46 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 76-for-200 at the plate, slashing .380/.432/.485/.917 with seven doubles, one triple, four home runs, 31 RBIs and 39 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.359) and fifth in OBP (.432). Among the 307 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards is tied for first in swinging-strike rate (3.7 percent).

### AUSTIN POWERS

**Austin Allen** entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 50 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

### FOUR SCORE AND 16 SERIES AGO

After their loss to Gwinnett Sunday, which split the series, Jacksonville is still without a series win at 121 Financial Ballpark since winning 3-of-5 against Nashville (April 18-23). The Jumbo Shrimp have only won two series since May (May 2-7 at Memphis & July 4-9 at Charlotte). During that five-game set, Jacksonville was outscored 23-17 and outduelled on the mound. The Sounds tallied a 2.68 ERA in 43.2 IP while the Jumbo Shrimp posted a 3.72 ERA in 46.0 IP.

### MAYOR MANGUM

**Jake Mangum** went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 38 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 52-for-152, hitting .342/.398/.461/.859 with 10 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 14 RBIs and 29 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 14 multi-hit games in his last 24 games, batting 40-for-108 (.370/.419/.491/.910) with seven doubles, two homers, 10 RBIs and 21 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 237 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the third-highest opposite field rate (44.2 percent). His 29.6 percent line drive rate is 13th.

### ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 25 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 11-14, with all but three of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 14 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 77 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -41 against their other second-half opponents (DUR, WOR, NAS, GWN & MEM).

### SYSTEM OVERLOAD

Thursday's 17-6 loss to Memphis was the third time this season the Jumbo Shrimp allowed 17 runs in a game. Since July 18, Jacksonville is being outscored by their opponents (Nashville, Gwinnett and Memphis), 117-83. Despite owning a top 10 batting average in that span (.278, 7th), the pitching staff has posted the league's worst ERA over this 16-game stretch (6.94) while also issuing the most walks in the IL (98). In 2022 the club allowed 13 runs on two different occasions.

### SHRIMP BITES

**Chi Chi González's** eight innings on Wednesday was the longest outing for a Jacksonville pitcher since **Matthew Kent** tossed eight innings of relief on September 8, 2022 vs. IOW. **Jake Mangum's** 12-game hitting streak (7/21-present) is the second-longest this season (Burdick, 16 games).

-De Jesus was originally signed by the Boston Red Sox as a free agent on a minor league contract.

-De Jesus led High-A Salem in strikeouts (122) and wins (T-1st, 9) and threw at least 6.0 innings in 11 of his 24 starts.
