SIX DOUBLES, GARCIA LEAD FRISCO TO VICTORY IN MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the Midland RockHounds 6-2 on Wednesday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (44-21) found the scoreboard first on Wednesday night, with a Geisel Cepeda RBI double in the top of the second inning against Midland (36-29) starter Ryan Cusick (1-1). They then increased their lead in the fourth with a **Maximo Acosta** sacrifice fly and another run scoring on an error to push the lead to 3-0. Midland made it a 3-2 game in the sixth with a two-run single from Jeisson Rosario on the final pitch that Frisco starter **Ryan Garcia** (5-3) threw. Garcia poured in his first quality start of the year, yielding two runs on four hits over six innings while striking out seven and walking two. The Riders struck right back in the top of the seventh on a **Cody Freeman** RBI double and plated two more runs in the top of the eighth on RBI doubles from **Cooper Johnson** and **Kellen Strahm**. Overall, the Riders collected six doubles on the night. Both Strahm and Cepeda doubled twice. **Steven Jennings** whiffed four batters over his two innings on the mound for the Riders and Tyler Owens threw a 1-2-3 ninth in his lone inning as well.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

After a Midland loss on Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. They have the best record in all of Double-A at 44-21 and they have a season-best 8.0-game lead on the Midland RockHounds in the Texas League South. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022. Frisco has not finished the first half with the best record in Double-A since 2008. Triple-A Omaha (Royals, 710) are the only team with a better winning percentage in all of Minor League Baseball than Frisco's .677. The Riders are on pace for 93 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007).

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

With an error on Tuesday, it snapped a streak of seven-straight games without an error for the RoughRiders. The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (37) while also owning the best fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 63 double plays are second among non-Triple-A teams. Frisco has also allowed the second-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (43), throwing out 28 percent of total base runners against them.

MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

Keyber Rodriguez has been tearing up the baseball over the last couple of weeks. On top of his walk-off single on Saturday night, in his last 25 games, Rodriguez is hitting .309 (29-for-94) with nine multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, two triples, two home runs, 21 RBIs, seven walks, 11 runs scored and two steals. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .265 and OPS from .371 to .737 over the last 25 games.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

Josh Hatcher has crushed the baseball this season for the RoughRiders. He is third in the league, hitting .299, while also tied for second in the league with 40 RBIs. Over his last 19 games, he is slashing .284 (21-for-74)/.329/.446/.775 with four doubles, a triple, two home runs, 14 RBIs and nine runs. In his last eight games, he has driven in eight runs with four extra-base hits.

In their last 12 games, the Riders have allowed just 16 earned runs over 107.0 IP (1.35 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.17 through the first 16 games. Having won 19 of their last 23 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.07) during that stretch while also being tied for first in saves (eight) and wins (19) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Kannapolis) has a 2.84 ERA. In those last 23 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just four times and once in the last 11 games. On Tuesday, their 2-1 loss marked their first loss when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-1 in those games.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 29 games, batting .343 (34-for-99)/.451/.485/.936 with five doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 16 walks, 11 strikeouts and 20 runs. In his last 17 games, he is hitting .355 (22-for-62)/.459/.565/1.024. Last Friday in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

CHAVEZ RACKING UP THE HITS:

OFF DAY

In his first two seasons with the RoughRiders combined, Frainyer Chavez just played 44 games with Frisco, but having played his 53rd game of the season with the Riders on Sunday, he is on fire at the plate. Over his last 14 games, he is hitting .360 (18-for-50)/.418/.500/.918 with two doubles, a triple, a home run, five walks, five steals and 12 runs scored. In his last 27 games, he is slashing .308 (28-for-91)/.376/.440/.816.

RISP-ECT THIS:

June 24th

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 30 games, they are 21-9, but are hitting .251 (63-for-251) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .276 with RISP.

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22
