JUMBO SHRIMP SPLIT TWIN BILL WITH STRIPERS

Jacksonville won Saturday's doubleheader 8-4 before falling 4-1 in a rain-shortened five-inning finale. **Graham Pauley's** RBI double in the first of the opener put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead. **Kemp Alderman** blasted a two-run home run during a four-run third to blow it open. Alderman added an RBI double in the fifth as Jacksonville cruised from there to an 8-4 win. **Bradley Blalock** ceded three unearned runs in 5.0 innings. In the finale, Gwinnett opened up the scoring with three in the first before **Sandy León** led off the second with a homer. The lone Shrimp run scored on a third-inning error.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen has worked seven games in a row yielding no more than two runs. During this span, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have ceded only six runs, five earned, in 25.0 innings for a 1.80 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined to yield only 25 hits and eight walks while striking out 31 during this span. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has registered the fourth-fewest innings of any Triple-A relief corps (461.0) while ranking fourth at the level in ERA (4.30).

ROAD KILL

Following a hard-fought 5-4 victory on July 2 at Nashville, Jacksonville improved their road record to an impressive 24-15 (.615). The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up with 13 consecutive road losses before finally winning 6-3 on Wednesday at Gwinnett. However, Jacksonville has now suffered losses in 15 of its last 17 road games. The club has been outscored by a whopping 105-60 (-45) margin during this span.

DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS

In 24 games from May 10-June 10, **Deyvison De Los Santos** went just 21-for-94 at the plate, batting .223/.247/.330/.577 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs, three walks and eight runs scored. In the 39 games since, however, the Santo Domingo, D.R., native is 41-for-135 at the plate, slashing .304/.379/.519/.898 (8 2B, 7 HR, 25 RBIs, 14 BB, 16 R). In 2026, De Los Santos has shaved his strikeout rate down to 18.5 percent from a peak of 26.3 percent in both the 2022 and 2023 seasons (24.7 percent in 2024, 22.4 percent in 2025).

NEED FOR SPEED

Heading into play on July 1, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked second in Triple-A in stolen bases with 141, but the club's 79.7 percent success rate placed only 14th at the level. Since that point, Jacksonville has swiped 57 bases in 30 games (1.90 per game) on an 86.4 percent success rate. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have piled up 198 stolen bases, good enough for second in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are averaging 1.78 steals per game, just shy of their team-record pace of 2.03 last season, when they swiped 305 bags in 150 games.

RISP-Y BUSINESS

The Jumbo Shrimp have dropped 21 of their last 28 contests, with 12 of those defeats coming by just one run. A big culprit in these losses has been their lack of success hitting with runners in scoring position. Over the last 26 games, Jacksonville is just 56-for-255 (.220) at the plate with runners in scoring position. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .247/.342/.407/.749 with runners in scoring position, significantly better than their .227/.330/.366/.696 line with the bases empty.

OH GREAT STARTING PITCHING, WHERE ART THOU

Jacksonville ranks sixth in Triple-A in innings pitched by starting pitchers at 491.0. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled to get length from their starting pitching of late. Just seven times has the club seen its lid-lifter toss at least 5.0 innings in the 29 games since July 2. Jacksonville starters have mustered only 105.1 innings pitched over the last 29 games (3.6 per game) with an ugly 8.29 ERA (97 ER in 105.1 IP). The club is just 8-21 in these contests.

12-GAGE

Jacksonville infielder **Gage Miller** has gotten off to a blistering start to his time in Triple-A since a May 26 promotion from Double-A Pensacola. The Palmyra, Pa., native has reached base in 26 of his 33 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, slashing .320/.457/.580/1.037 with eight doubles, six home runs, 21 RBIs, 21 walks and 22 runs scored. In fact, Miller has either scored and/or driven in a run in 21 of those 33 contests. After posting a 12.9 percent walk rate and a .102 ISO in 2025, Miller has increased those numbers to 14.6 percent and .215, respectively, in 2026.

ABOUT JACE

-Beck was originally drafted by the New York Mets in the 22nd round of the 2019 draft. He bypassed a commitment to Cowley County Community College (Arkansas City, Kan.) to sign with the Mets for \$125,000 and turn pro.

-After reaching as high as High-A Brooklyn in the Mets' organization, Beck elected free agency following the 2025 season. He signed a minor league deal with the Chicago Cubs on November 18, 2025. Beck began the season with Double-A Knoxville and was promoted to Triple-A Iowa, making five appearances before being included along with infielder Jonathon Long as the package traded to the Miami Marlins in exchange for left-handed pitcher Braxton Garrett.

-Beck missed the entire 2024 season recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

-Beck did not learn to pitch until he was in seventh grade. He began his high school career at Tuttle High School (Okla.) before transferring to rival Blanchard High School. During his senior season, he helped the Blanchard Lions go 39-0 on the season, with Beck posting a personal 13-0 record, 0.99 ERA and 134 strikeouts in 70.2 innings pitched.

-Jace is the son of former Oklahoma State wide receiver Lynn Beck.

2026 SEASON

-Beck made his Marlins organization debut on August 9 at Gwinnett.
