MAY 8th WORCESTER (16-17) at BUFFALO (19-14) 5:05 pm Doubleheader

G1 Worcester Red Sox RHP **Brian Van Belle (0-1, 6.15)** vs. Buffalo Bisons RHP **Chad Dallas (0-2, 7.81)**

G2 Worcester Red Sox RHP **Chase Shugart (0-1, 6.94)** vs. Buffalo Bisons RHP **Troy Watson (2-0, 6.61)**

Double Duty in Buffalo – The Worcester Red Sox – who are 1-5 vs. Buffalo this season and 15-12 vs. the rest of the league – have two chances to turn around their fortunes vs. Buffalo when they play a make-up doubleheader against the Buffalo Bisons (AAA-Toronto) today at 5:05 pm at Sahlen Field in downtown Buffalo. The twin bill was necessitated by an April 4th snow-out at Polar Park in Worcester. As such the WooSox will bat last as the “home” team in Game 2. The Bisons take their rightful spot as the home team in Game 1. Both games are 7-innings and both can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

This Series – Buffalo won the opener of this extended 7-game set last night, 7-5 to improve to 5-1 vs. the WooSox this season. The Bisons took 4 of 5 from the Sox at Polar Park from April 2-7. During that series the clubs were postponed on consecutive days back on April 3 (rainout) & April 4 (snowout) at Polar Park in Worcester. So, since the Bisons do not come back to Worcester during the first half of the International League schedule (that ends on June 23), the make-up of the April 4th postponement will be played today as part of a doubleheader in Buffalo.

The Rest of This Series – The rest of this series after tonight’s twin bill breaks down this way... tomorrow & Friday both at 6:05 pm and then Saturday & Sunday both at 1:05 pm. The WooSox will return to Worcester after the series finale on Sunday.

In the not too Distant Future - After this week/weekend, these two rivals will be back in Buffalo to face each other in just over a month for a 6-game series from June 11-16. The Bisons make their next (and last visit) to Polar Park for a 6-game set from July 30 – August 4.

What’s Ahead - The Sox take Monday off - except for those players and coaches who are playing in the 4th annual “Rich Gedman Golf Tournament,” presented by the Hanover Insurance Group, benefiting the WooSox Foundation, on Monday at the Haven Country Club in Boylston, MA. The WooSox will eventually begin their longest homestand of the season on Tuesday night at 6:05 pm when they open a 12-game homestand that includes 6-games vs. 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (AAA-Yankees) followed by 6 more games against the defending International League Champion Norfolk (AAA-Baltimore) and top prospect INF Jackson Holliday. The 12-game WooSox homestand runs from May 14-26.

Double Trouble - The WooSox are 0-2-2 in their four doubleheaders already this season (no sweeps, twice swept, and two splits). Worcester has been swept in each of their last two doubleheader...on April 24 at Toledo (5-3 & 3-2) and April 20 at home vs. Durham (12-2 & 4-3). That sweep at the hands of the Bulls marked the first time the Sox were swept in a twin bill since April 23 of last year at Lehigh Valley. The Sox had split their first two doubleheaders this season...on April 5 at home vs. Buffalo (9-7 win & 5-0 loss) and on April 14 at Syracuse (10-5 loss & 8-4 win). Worcester went 5-2-4 in their 11 doubleheaders last season...five sweeps, swept twice, and four splits. The WooSox played seven doubleheaders during each of the 2021 and 2022 seasons going 1-2-4 both those years. The last WooSox doubleheader sweep came in Buffalo last June 29 by scores of 5-2 and 4-2.

Still Winners – Despite the 7-5 setback last night, Worcester has still won 3 of 4 and 6 of their last 8 games since April 28. During those 8 games the Sox have out-scored their opponents by a combined, 50-29 count. In this 8-game stretch the WooSox are batting .287 as a team (76-for-265) with 20 doubles & 10 HR to raise their team batting average from .230 on April 27 to their current .245. Sox pitchers meanwhile are 6-2 with a 3.68 ERA (29 ER in 71 IP) to lower their team ERA from 5.36 on April 27 to 4.92.

One Below – The WooSox (at 16-17 on the year) had climbed back to the .500 mark after Sunday's victory for the first time in just over a month since they were 3-3 on April 5. The Sox have not been over .500 since they were 2-1 on March 31.

Four of a Kind – The WooSox had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a season-long 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

Buffaloed a Month Ago – Prior to this week, the WooSox and Buffalo last met a little after a month ago from April 2-7 in Worcester when the Bisons took 4 of 5 during the abbreviated series. The Bisons spoiled Worcester's home-opener on April 2 with a 2-0 win in 10-innings. The next two games were postponed due to weather (rain & snow). The teams split a make-up doubleheader on April 5 as the WooSox held on for a 9-7 victory in the opener but Buffalo gained the split with a 5-0 triumph in the nightcap. Buffalo won both games over the weekend on April 6 & 7 by scores of 10-6 and 10-5. And with their 7-5 victory last night in Buffalo, the Bisons are now 5-1 vs. the WooSox this season.

Stats vs. Buffalo – Sox pitchers are 1-5 with a 6.84 ERA vs. the Bisons this season (38 ER in 50 IP) with 6 HRA while WooSox batters are hitting .214 (40-for-187) with 6 HR. Buffalo has out-scored Worcester, 41-25 in the 6 games thus far.

Beating the Bisons – Worcester went 15-8 vs. Buffalo last season – their most wins against any International League foe. The WooSox were 10-3 at home vs. the Bisons compared to 5-5 in Buffalo.

Home Getting Sweeter & Sweeter - Worcester has won 9 of their last 12 home games dating back to April 16. As a result, the WooSox are 10-7 at home and 3-games over the .500 mark at Polar Park for the first time this this season. Worcester went 43-33 at home last year.

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 8 CFB victories this season including 3 wins in their last at-bat of the game.

One Has Been a Lonely Number – Worcester is 0-6 in 1-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 3-4 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

Series Math – Worcester is 3-3-0 in their first six series of 2024 (3 wins, 3 losses, and no splits). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – Sox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 28 times this season.

Rankings – Worcester is 14th in the IL in team batting with a .245 average while Buffalo is 1st at .278. On the pitching side, the Sox are 13th in team ERA (4.92) while the Bisons are 17th with a 5.49 ERA.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5th-place and 7 games back. They were in 8th-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

Month to Month – Worcester went 12-14 last March/April, 13-14 in May, then had three straight winning months going 16-9 in June, 13-10 in July, and 16-11 in August, before finishing 9-10 in September.

Seven Days a Week – The WooSox were 0-1 on Monday last season, went 9-12 on Tuesdays, 11-11 on Wednesdays, 12-13 on Thursdays, 14-12 on Fridays, 20-6 on Saturdays, and 14-13 on Sundays in 2023.

We Interrupt This Program – Worcester had a total of 14 games either postponed (11) or canceled (3) last year due to weather. They have had five postponements thus far this season (three at home and two on the road).

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (16-10) fell at home to Binghamton, 4-1 last night. Red Sox RHP Braynan Bello made a rehab start and took the loss allowing 3 runs (2 earned) on 4 hits in 2.2 innings with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts. Bello, 3-1 with a 3.04 ERA for Boston this season, has been on the Red Sox injured list since April 21 with right lat tightness. Portland scored their only run in the 5th inning as Roman Anthony tripled and scored on a SF by Marcelo Mayer. Kyle Teel and Mickey Gasper both went 2-for-3 on the night while Blaze Jordan had a hit to extend his hitting streak to 12 games.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Boston Red Sox today outrighted INF **Pablo Reyes** to Worcester following his designation for assignment on April 29 when the Red Sox acquired Garrett Cooper. To make room, the WooSox placed catcher **Elih Marrero** on the Development List.

In another move today, the Red Sox also outrighted RHP **Vladimir Gutierrez** to Worcester following his designation for assignment on May 1. To make room, the Red Sox transferred RHP **Robert Kwiakowski** to Double-A Portland.

The Red Sox today are expected to recall RHP **Nick Pivetta** from his injury rehab assignment with Worcester with Pivetta the Red Sox probable tonight in Atlanta. There are also reports that the Red Sox will soon recall INF **Romy Gonzalez** from his injury rehab assignment with the WooSox although nothing official as of 3:40 pm today.

Pablo Reyes, 30, began this season with Boston before being designated for assignment on April 29 when the Red Sox acquired Garrett Cooper. Pablo played in 21 games for the Red Sox this season, making nine starts at third base, four at second base, one at shortstop, and one at first base while batting .183 (11-for-60) with two doubles and five RBI. Originally signed as an international free agent by the Pittsburgh Pirates in May 2012, the Dominican Republic native has hit .248 (129-for-521) with eight home runs in 233 career games with the Pirates (2018-19), Milwaukee Brewers (2021-22), and Red Sox (2023-24). Reyes was acquired by Boston on May 11, 2023 in a Minor League trade with the Oakland A's (he had been playing for Triple-A Las Vegas at the time). Pablo belted a walk-off grand slam for the Red Sox on August 7, 2023 to beat Kansas City, 6-2.

Vladimir Gutierrez, 28, was acquired from the Milwaukee Brewers on April 18 and pitched in three games with Worcester, allowing four runs in 6.0 innings. The right-hander has pitched in 33 career Major League games (30 starts) with the Cincinnati Reds (2021-22) and Miami Marlins (2024), going 10-12 with a 5.47 ERA (94 ER/154.2 IP) and 121 strikeouts.

The WooSox have already sent 10 players to Boston in the 5½ weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, and RHP Nick Pivetta who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Dalbec is back with the WooSox, Heineman is currently on Boston's injured list, and Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
