LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn was shutout for the 7th time in 2023 in a 3-0 loss at Jersey Shore...

BlueClaws scored on a CF Marcus Lee Sang infield single in the 5th...Added 2 more in the 7th on a C Caleb Ricketts fielder's choice and a missed catch error on a potential inning-ending fielder's choice at 2nd...1B William Lugo and C José Mena each collected multi-hit games for Brooklyn...RHP Cameron Foster picked up a quality start with 6.1 innings of 3-run ball (1 earned)...RHP Paul Gervase hurled 1.2 innings of scoreless relief...Lee Sang, RF Leandro Pineda, and 2B Freylin Minyety all posted multi-hit nights for the 'Claws...LHP Rafael Marcano (5.0 IP), RHP Matt Russell (1.0), LHP Jordi Martínez (1.2), and LHP Wesley Moore (1.1) combined on the 5-hit shutout.

CLIFFORD THE CYCLONE: OF Ryan Clifford was added to Brooklyn's roster on Thursday...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF Drew Gilbert from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP Justin Verlander on Tuesday...Clifford smashed a 2-run home run to right in his first at-bat and closed out his organizational debut with a 2-for-3 day, adding 2 walks and 2 runs scored...Clifford was ranked as Houston's No. 3 prospect at midseason by Baseball America and is deemed the Mets' No. 6 farmhand by MLB Pipeline...The 2022 1tth-round pick enters Saturday leading the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.542)...He is also 2nd in OPS (.896) trailing only former Greenville INF Blaze Jordan (.918) and tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in home runs (17)...Among players with at least 250 plate appearances, Clifford is 1st in isolated power (.276), 4th in OPS (.896), and 6th in wOBA (.393) and wRC+ (137).

ALEX THE AMAZING: Since the start of June, OF Alex Ramírez is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (38)...Dating back to his 6-hit game on July 21 at Hudson Valley, the 20-year-old has accrued multi-hit games in 6 of his last 13 outings...In that span, Alex is slashing .400/.433/.564 with a .997 OPS...Ramírez is 22-for-55 at the plate (.400) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, and 5 stolen bases...Ramírez has 2 more hits (22) than any other player in the SAL during that span....Alex is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Sunday, the Dominican native is tied with INF Luke Ritter for 2nd in franchise history in RBI (80) and is 11 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (36) on Wednesday, is 2nd in total bases (221) and hits (150), and 3rd in runs scored (78).

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF Rhylan Thomas had his 11-game hitting streak since July 8 snapped on July 29 vs. Wilmington, but he added 2 more hits on Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursday...In 20 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is slashing .394/.429/.465 with a .893 OPS at the dish and a 147 wRC+...Thomas has added 10 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, and 5 walks to only 5 strikeouts...The left-handed swinger has composed multi-hit efforts in 7 of his last 14 games dating back to July 18 at Hudson Valley, slashing .423/.444/.519 with a .964 OPS and 166 wRC+...Thomas already has as many RBI (9) as he did in St. Lucie in 49 fewer plate appearances (139 to 90)...Among players with 80 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.378).

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP Cameron Foster took the loss but punched out a career-high 12 on July 29 vs. Wilmington...The 12 punchouts are the most by a Cyclone pitcher in 2023... Foster is the 3rd different Brooklyn arm to strike out 10+ batters in a single game this year... RHP Tyler Stuart whiffed 11 on June 22, while RHP Blade Tidwell has accomplished the feat 4 times...The Houston native is the first Cyclone pitcher to strikeout 12-plus batters in a single contest since RHP Marcos Molina collected 12 strikeouts on August 15, 2014, in a 7-0 win at Vermont...Foster is the first to accomplish the feat at home since RHP Collin McHugh collected 12 K's vs. Jamestown on August 8, 2009...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-2 record with a 3.05 ERA (15 ER in 44.1 IP) with 13 walks and 52 strikeouts over 9 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.7% from his overall numbers (28.3% from 24.6%) and his walk rate is down 1.9% (7.1% from 9.0%).

ACE GERVASE: RHP Paul Gervase has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 29 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 6th in ERA (1.45) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 40.0 IP)...Fellow 2023 Cyclone and current Double-A Binghamton LHP Daniel Juárez (1.42) is 4th in MiLB...The 2022 12th-round pick is 9th in MiLB in strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.12) and opposing batting average (146)...Among SAL relievers with at least 40.0 IP, the Fuquay-Varina, N.C. native is 2nd in the circuit in strikeouts-per-9 innings (14.12), hits allowed (22), and opposing OPS (.51f), and tied for 4th in saves (6)...Gervase leads all Mets farmhands in strikeout rate at 35.2% (min. 40.0 IP).

THE BEST AROUND: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.98 ERA (199 ER in 602.0 IP) over their last 69 games, holding a 39-30 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (318) is 2nd in the minors and SAL...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts — which tied for 4th-most in MiLB — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.9% and a walk rate of 10.9%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (620), in addition to the 3rd lowest hitsper-9 innings (6.97) and batting average against (.211) in that period...RIPS Tyler Stuart (1.80), Blade Tidwell (1.87), and RHP Christian Scott (2.35) hold the 1st, 2nd, and 4th best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 65.0 IP).

**BULLPEN BOOM:** The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn holds the best bullpen ERA (3.37) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 4th-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.11) leads MiLB, while Hudson Valley ranks 2nd in the circuit (3.45).

**TOP OF THE CYCLONE:** Brooklyn has won 17-of-27 (.630) and 23-of-36 (.639) going into Sunday...The Cyclones earned a series split with Wilmington, snapping a streak of winning 5-consecutive series dating back to June 20-25 vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn has not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-f1, going 5-0-2 in 5-ests...The Cyclones are 22-f3 in the second half and hold a 4-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Hudson Valley and Jersey shORE (18-17)...Brooklyn is 2.5-games behind Hickory (24-10) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

JAWILME'S BIG BITE: RHP Jawilme Ramírez was outstanding in his High-A and Cyclones debut on Thursday night...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the 9th inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of 3-run ball...Ramírez allowed 6 hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out 4...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete 8-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP Conner Grey carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws possess 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF Gabriel Rincones Jr. (10), C Caleb Ricketts (20)...Brooklyn and Jersey Shore are meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark for the third and final time and the first time since the BlueClaws took 5-of-8 from the Cyclones from May 30-June 4...The Cyclones are 11-14 (.440) against the BlueClaws in the first 25 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2021, Brooklyn is 46-36 all-time against Jersey Shore (.561).

day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a 9-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a 1-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

AIR JORDANY: RHP Jordany Ventura set new career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (9), earning the win and tossing a quality start in Wednesday afternoon's win at Jersey Shore... The Dominican native allowed just 2 runs on 2 hits, walking only 2 on a season-high 93 pitches and 63 strikes...The 23-year-old tossed 2-full innings more than his previous high 61 frames on July 21 at Hudson Valley...His 9 K's were 2 more than his previous best of 7 vs. Lakeland on April 20...In 4 starts with Brooklyn, the Mets' No. 24 prospect per Baseball America is 2-0 with a 3.20 ERA (7 ER in 19.2 IP), 11 walks (13.9 BB%), and 17 strikeouts (21.5 K%).

TURN IT UP TO ELEVEN: The Cyclones scored a season-high 11 runs during last Thursday evening and Sunday afternoon's wins vs. Wilmington...It marked the second and third times this season Brooklyn had registered double digits in runs scored with the previous high watermark coming in a 10-6 win at Jersey Shore on June 4...The 11-run outbursts were the most for the 'Clones since they accrued 18 runs in an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022... Additionally, it is the most Brooklyn had scored at Maimonides Park since a 14-0 beatdown of Hudson Valley on May 19, 2021.

CHANGE UP: The Cyclones used a season-high 9 different pitchers en route to their 11-7 win on Sunday afternoon vs. Wilmington...That is the most arms Brooklyn used in a game of any length since moving to the full-season level before 2021...RHP Benito García tossed a scoreless inning in a spot start...RHP Joshua Cornielly (2.0 IP), RHP Manny Rodríguez (0.2), RHP Dylan Hall (0.1), RHP Luis Montas (1.0), LHP Eli Ankeney (1.0), and RHP Paul Gervase (1.0) all emerged in relief...Before Sunday, the most arms the 'Clones had used in a single game was 7...That last occurred on Tuesday, July 25 vs. Wilmington.

NEW KIDS ON THE BOARDWALK: Brooklyn added 4 players from Single-A St. Lucie prior to Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore...RHP Jawilme Ramírez, RHP Bailey Reid, INF Jacob Reimer, and INF Jett Williams all joined the Clones from the Florida State League...Williams was ranked as the Mets' No. 3 prospect at midseason by Baseball America and Reimer comes in at No. 10...Williams was the No. 14 pick in the first round of last summer's MLB draft out of high school...In 79 games, the 19-year-old slashed .249/422/.410 with a .832 OPS, 6 home runs, 35 RBI, and 32 stolen bases...Williams was the FSL leader in on-base percentage (.422) at the time of his promotion, also ranking 3rd in walks (69), 4th in stolen bases (32), tied for 5th in triples (6), and 7th in OPS (.832)...Reimer slashed .280/.412/.392 with a .804 OPS, 6 home runs, and 37 RBI in 75 games with St. Lucie...The 19-year-old left the circuit ranked 4th in on-base percentage (.412) and 7th in batting average (.280)...Ramírez made 18 appearances (6 starts) with St. Lucie. composing a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP) and 61 strikeouts...Reid signed with the Mets in June after being released by the Cubs, punching out 13 in 6.1 innings over 8 relief outings in the FSL.

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF Alex Ramírez became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on July 21 at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B Marcos Cabrera of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023... Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF Sammy Sosa (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF Max Carey (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on July 21 at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Basebal since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in Mil.B...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (114), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (113), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (111), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (111), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (110), and Cardinals prospect OF Mike Antico (106) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 56 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 48.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Monday...9 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), INF Jett Williams (3), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Christian Scott (9), INF Jacob Reimer (10), RHP Raimon Gómez (16), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Jordany Ventura (24)... Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (20), RHP José Butto (25), RHP Luis Moreno (26), and OF Rowdey Jordan (27)...In all, 17-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not earn a decision starting in a bullpen game vs. Wilmington last Sunday afternoon...Retired the Blue Rocks in order on 8 pitches and 4 strikes (50.0%)... Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** to start the top of the 2nd inning with the games scoreless...Cyclones scored 5 runs in the bottom of the 2nd and used 9 different pitchers in an 11-7 victory over Wilmington.

BENI, VIDI, VICI: García has been as reliable as any Cyclones reliever over the last month...Dating back to June 9 vs. Greenville, the 23-year-old has tallied 10-consecutive scoreless appearances (1 start)...In 12.2 innings, García has earned a save and permitted just 10 hits and 1 walk, while striking out 11...The right-hander holds a 23.4% strikeout rate (11/47) and 2.1% walk rate (1/47) during that span...In 14 outings (1 start) with Brooklyn in 2023, García holds a 0.92 ERA (2 ER in 19.2 IP).

THE ST. LUCIE SHUFFLE: The 23-year-old has bounced between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie in 2023...García began the season in the Florida State League making 5 appearances before joining the Cyclones on May 2...Entered 2 contests and rejoined St. Lucie on May 9...Returned to Brooklyn on May 30...Holds a 1-2 record and a 5.63 ERA (10 ER in 16.0 IP) with 5 walks and 10 strikeouts in 8 relief outings with St. Lucie in 2023.

2022: Split the season between the Florida Complex League, St. Lucie and the Brooklyn...Started the year in the FCL...Composed a 1-1 mark with a 3.18 ERA (4 ER in 11.1 IP), 4 saves, 4 walks and 9 strikeouts in 9 relief appearances... Transferred to St. Lucie on July 14...Tallied a 2-3 record with a 6.10 ERA (14 ER in 20.2 IP), 1 save, 4 walks, and 28 strikeouts in 10 relief outings...Joined Brooklyn on September 1... Allowed 4 runs on 5 hits in 4.2 innings (7.71 ERA), did not allow a walk and punched out 4 in 2 relief appearances.

**STARTING TIME:** García is expected to make his 2nd start of the 2023 season on Sunday afternoon...Benito has started 22 games in his professional career dating back to 2018...Prior to last Sunday, the right-hander's most recent start came on August 22, 2019, at Greeneville with Rookie Kingsport in the Appalachian League...In 22 career starts, García is 1-6 with a 5.51 ERA (50 ER in 81.2 IP), 24 walks, and 70 strikeouts.
