CARDINALS TOPPLED BY AMARILLO IN OPENER: The Cardinals managed just 4 hits and the Sod Poodles hit two home runs as Springfield came out of the All-Star Break with a 7-1 loss to Amarillo at Hodgetown on Friday night. **RJ Yeager** hit a solo homer with two outs in the 4th inning for the Cards' only tally. **Bryan Torres** saw a 20-game on-base streak come to an end with an 0-for-4 outing and **Noah Mendlinger's** 7-game hitting streak also came to an end going 0-for-3. Outside of **Yeager's** solo shot, the Cardinals got only ione baserunner past second base.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Billy Corcoran** makes his 11th start of the season for Amarillo, and 16th of the season...Last pitched on Thursday, July 11 at San Antonio and got the win allowing just 2 ER on 6 H over 6.1 IP with 5 K...Bounced back from his roughest outing of the season on the 4th of July when he surrendered 8 ER on 10 H over just 2.2 IP at Midland in taking the loss...Pitched well in June, going 2-1 with a 1.74 ERA in 5 starts during the month...Began the season with the High-A Hillsboro Hops where he went 2-0 with a 2.22 ERA in 5 Northwest League starts...Promoted to Amarillo in mid-May and made his Sod Poodles debut May 16...Pitched in a hybrid role (starting & relief) in 2023, splitting the campaign between Low-A Visalia and Hillsboro going 3-5 with a 4.30 ERA in 30 appearances (7 starts), racking up 75 K in 69.0 IP...Signed by the Diamondbacks as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Pittsburgh in 2022...Went 7-5 witha 4.43 ERA in 14 starts as a junior at Pitt and was named 3rd team all-ACC...11-13 in 42 appearances (33 starts) and a 4.24 ERA in his collegiate career...Drafted by the Rangers in the 36th round of the 2018 draft out of Malvern Prep HS in Pennsylvania but did not sign...24 years old

CARDINALS PAY VISIT TO PANHANDLE FOR QUICK SET WITH SOD POODLES: Coming out of the All-Star Break, the Cardinals head to Texas for a quick three-game set against the Amarillo Sod Poodles (Double-A, Arizona Diamondbacks). It is the final regular season matchup between the two clubs; the Cards split a six-game series at Hodgetown in April.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: Despite a 7-1 loss in the series opener in Amarillo, the Cardinals have still won 11 of their last 14 to run their 2nd-half record to 12-7 after starting 1-4. Over their last 14 games, the Cardinals are 2nd in the league in batting (.292), runs scored (93, 6.6/game), and home runs trailing only Midland in all 3 category.

RDAD WARRIORS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have felt plenty at home on the road. The Birds are 27-15 (.642) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.55 which is good for 2nd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco (3.45). The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.61. The Cardinals are also the top hitting road team in the circuit with a batting average of .255, 8 points higher than the next-best club (Midland, .247).

The Birds have also begun to turn things around at home recently. After dropping 11 of 12, the Cardinals have gone 8-2 over their last 10 games at Hammons Field, lifting their home record to 22-24 (.478) overall.

POWER SURGE: While the Cards have been on the wrong side of the home run ball during the 2024 season, Springfield has homered in each of its last 9 games and has outhomered their opponents 16-11 over its last 14 games. The Cardinals have slugged 8 homers in their last 4 games, including a season-high tying 3 homers on both Friday and Saturday last week against Wichita.

CARDS LITTER LEADERBOARDS: The Cardinals have had one of the top offenses in the Texas League for the 2024 season, thanks mostly to their ability to get on base via the base hit. Entering play on Saturday, the Cardinals have the top 3 among qualified Texas League hitters in both batting average and OBP. **Bryan Torres, Jimmy Crooks,** and **Jeremy Rivas** sit 1-2-3 in the league in those two categories.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 15 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. The former Oklahoma Sooner is 3rd in the league among qualified hitters with a .373 average while adding 4 HR and 15 RBIs during that time with 3 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .661 and has a 1.100 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .875 OPS and .413 OBP tops in the circuit.

MATT LLOYD, RUN PRODUCER: With 6 RBIs last week against the Wind Surge at Hammons Field, Cardinals OF/DH Matt Lloyd has seen his name rise to the top of the league leaderboard in that category. Lloyd's 53 ribbies counts for four more than anyone else in the Texas League, leading Josh Hatcher of Frisco who has 49.

ANTICO NEARING MILESTONES: Cardinals OF **Mike Antico** is inching toward a pair of career milestones. **Antico's** next steal will give him 150 for his career, he is just 4 homers shy of 50 for his career sitting at 46.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: The 2024 season has been a roller coaster ride for Cardinals OF **Nathan Church**. After busting out of the gates with a red-hot April that earned him Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month batting .349 with 3 HR and a .914 OPS, the former UC Irvine Anteater slowed down from the middle of May to the end of June, batting .179 with 0 HR and a .466 OPS in 31 games from May 23-June 30.

Since the calendar flipped to July, however, **Church's** bat has heated up again to the tune of a .298 clip with 2 HR. Over his last 10 games, Church is batting .333 with an OPS of .928.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the all-time franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 223.


