LAST GAME

The Baysox lost their second-straight contest to the Richmond Flying Squirrels, and their fifth-straight game overall, by a 9-3 final on Wednesday night. It was a game of "what could have been" early on for the Bowie offense, as the Baysox loaded the bases in the first innings with nobody out, but the next three batters were all retired in order without pushing a run across the plate. Richmond immediatley capitalized with three runs in the top of the second, including a Carter Williams two-run home run, to take a 3-0 lead. Richmond would continue to keep the Baysox at arm's length throughout the evening, adding on one run in the third and fifth inning each, before the Flying Squirrels pulled away in the seventh, when they sent all nine men to the plate in the frame and scored four runs. In addition to Williams, Andy Thomas, Hayden Cantrelle, and Carter Aldrete all had 2 RBI on the night for Richmond. The nine runs and 13 hits surrendered by the Baysox staff were both season highs. Offensively, Heston Kjerstad produced a pair of RBI via a triple in the second and his Eastern League-leading sixth home run on a solo shot in the fifth. Jacob Teter also notched his first Double-A RBI on a single in the sixth, but it would not be enough for Bowie to snap its losing skid.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter this week's series atop the Eastern League Southwest division with a 9-6 record - a game ahead of jointsecond-place Akron and Harrisburg and 3.5 games ahead of the Baysox. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, Richmond is coming off a first-half division title and postseason berth in 2022. The Flying Squirrels are led by second-year manager Dennis Pelfry, who returns most of his staff from last season. Through 15 games, Richmond is on a tear at the plate, leading the league in team average (.252), on-base percentage (.354), OPS (.732), hits (122) and runs (86). The Flying Squirrels also have the fewest errors in the league (10) and most strikeouts as a pitching staff (170). They are led by Patrick Bailey, who sits third in the Eastern League with 17 hits, and leads the team with a 340 average - sitting second on the team with 9 RBI. Riley Mahan leads all Flying Squirrels with three home runs and a .514 slugging percentage. Bailey (No. 11 SF) is one of seven Giants Top 30 prospects currently on the Richmond roster, per MLB Pipeline. Others include OF Luis Matos (No. 7 SF), along with RHPs Mason Black (No. 10 SF), Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), Randy Rodriguez (No. 26 SF), and Ryan Murphy (No.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Mason Black looks to get the ball tonight for the Flying Squirrels. The No. 10 prospect in the Giants' system, Black is still settling into Double-A in just his second professional season. Through three starts, he has given up eight runs (6 earned) off 12 hits in 10.1 innings. Despite the high contact numbers, Black has shown no lack of consistency in the strike zone, with only one walk compared to 14 strikeouts on the season. In his most recent start, last Friday against Erie, Black went a season-low 2.1 innings, allowing four runs (two earned) on five hits. Black was not aided by two errors made in the field by Richmond, but did total 65 pitches through those 2.1 frames. Last season, Black progressed through Single-A and High-A at a fairly brisk rate, earning Giants' Organizational All-Star honors with a combined ERA of 3.21 - best in the Giants' system among qualifiers. Black also ranked fourth in the system in strikeouts (136) and innings (112), while standing second in opposing average (.227) and WHIP (1.17). A third round pick for the Giants in 2021 out of Lehigh University, in his home state of Pennsylvania, Black features a fastball that sits mid-90è, but can touch 98. He also uses a mid-80s slider with sweep and depth, in addition to a low-80s fading changeup.

HAIL CÉSAR

Cesar Prieto has been on a tear at the plate to start the season. The Bowie infielder leads the Eastern League, and is second in Double-A, with 26 hits. Prieto also leads the Eastern Leauge in batting average, and is fifth in on-base percentage, among qualified players. He has hits in 14 of his 16 games, including mutliple hits in four of the last six contests. Among Baysox, Prieto leads the way in hits, average, and on-base percentage. He's also second on the team in slugging percentage and OPS. Prieto's 26 hits are also the most in the Orioles' system in 2023, despite Triple-A Norfolk playing six additional games

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kierstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kierstad's solo shot in last night's fifth inning was his sixth long ball of the season through just 15 games - the most at the Double-A level this season. Beyond the home runs, Kjerstad also demonstrated consistency across the Eastern League leaderboards - ranking fourth in OPS (1.021), second in extra-base hits (9), while also being tied for first in slugging percentage (.644), total bases (38), and runs scored (14). Kjerstad's home runs and slugging percentage also rank second throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS sits at third.

DOUBLE (PLAY) TROUBLE

The Baysox bats have struggled to capitalize on their chances early on this season. The Baysox have lost seven of their last eight games, dating back to Sunday, April 16 against Akron. In this eight-game stretch, Bowie has hit into 15 double plays, while only stringing together consecutive hits seven times. By comparison, Bowie has hit into nine double plays immediately following a base-runner in the last eight games. The Baysox are also hitting just .202 with runners in scoring position - the lowest total in the Eastern League.

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-26 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Fitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.
