SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

AT THE HALFWAY POINT: Today marks the Shuckers' final game in the first half of the 2023 season... The Chattanooga Lookouts (CIN) and Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA) have both clinched a spot in the 2023 Southern League Playoffs by winning the North and South Division... The second half of the season begins on Wednesday as the Shuckers are set to play 12 straight prior to the All-Star Break... A win today would clinch Biloxi's seventh straight season with a .500+ record under the half-system playoff format (halves were not used during the 2021 season).

O' CANADA: Toronto native, INF Tyler Black, smashed his 10th home run of the year on Friday, tying Jackson Chourio for the Shuckers team lead... Black enters today as the Brewers' organizational leader in on-base percentage (.433), slugging percentage (.490), OPS (.923), triples (3), walks (49), runs (43) and stolen bases (39)... Black and Mariners' prospect OF Jonatan Clase are the only two players in MLB and MiLB with at least 10 home runs and at least 35 stolen

QUERO HAS IT COVERED: C Jeferson Quero threw out two more baserunners on Saturday night, increasing his Southern League-leading caught stealing percentage to 38%... He enters today with the third-highest mark out of all qualified catchers in Minor League Baseball.

IN A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: With a two-run home run and a stolen base on Friday night, OF Jackson Chourio became the third teenager since 2005 to reach 20 stolen bases and 10 home runs in a single-season in the high minors and the first since **OF Ronald Acuna Jr.** did so in 2017... **OF Delmon Young** with the Montgomery Biscuits is the only other player to achieve the feat since 2005, doing so during the '05 season.

MEEKER'S MAGIC: RHP James Meeker made his fifth career start in game two of Friday's doubleheader, tossing three scoreless innings with three strikeouts... In 2023, Meeker has struck out 47 and walked four in 371 innings... His 2.7% walk rate is the lowest out of any pitcher in Minor League Baseball (min. 30.0 IP).

ROCKETING UP THE CHARTS: INF Tyler Black tallied his 39th stolen base on Wednesday afternoon against the Lookouts. He enters today with the second-most stolen bases by a Shuckers player in a sing season, 14 away from breaking OF Johnny Davis' franchise record of 52, set during the 2017 season... Black's next stolen base will make him the second Shuckers player reach 40 in a season, and the 16th Southern League player to reach the mark single
