#### **NORFOLK WINS SHOOTOUT 13-10**

Both Jerar Encarnacion and C.J. Hinojosa homered, but the Norfolk Tides bested the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 13-10 on Saturday. The Tides jumped out to a 10-2 lead through two-and-a-half innings. The Jumbo Shrimp got within 10-7 with three runs in the third and two in the fourth. However, Norfolk added two in the fifth and one in the eighth, helping them hold off Jacksonville plating a run in the seventh, eighth and ninth innings, respectively. The Tides clinched the series with the victory

#### DOCTOR, DOCTOR GIVE ME THE NEWS

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing over their previous 20 games. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a 3.19 ERA. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled in the seven games since. They've allowed 33 runs, 32 earned on 37 hits (15.1 H/9) in 22.0 innings for a 13.09 ERA with 17 walks (7.0 BB/9) and 18 strikeouts (7.4 K/9).

#### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 146 free passes over the last 28 games since April 11, a figure that ranks fourth in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.1 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games, Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

#### "DOUBLE AA" BAT-TERY

Austin "Double AA" Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 10 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 12-for-32 (.375/.459/.719/1.178) at the plate with two doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, five walks and seven runs scored. Allen has raised his season line to .177/.286/.392/.678 with

#### KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last 14 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 15-for-44 (.341/.525/.500/1.025) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 17 walks. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (29) nearly as much he has struck out (30). Leblanc ranks third in the International League in walk percentage (22.7 percent) and tied for fourth in total walks (29). His swinging-strike rate of 7.3 percent ranks 17th-lowest out of the circuit's 132 qualified hitters.

#### **'PEN PALS**

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 15 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 27 runs, 21 earned, on 54 hits (6.3 H/9) in 77.0 innings for a 2.45 ERA. The Shrimp bullpen has combined for 85 strikeouts (9.9 K/9) against 50 walks (5.8 BB/9) during this recent run.

#### WAVE RUNNERS

Last year, Jacksonville struggled against their International League East foes, going 39-45. However, against Norfolk, Jacksonville went 11-10, winning the Navy Town Showdown. Although the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .250/.327/.403/.730 with 21 home runs and 93 RBIs, the pitching staff struggled. The Jumbo Shrimp hurlers compiled a 5.03 ERA, which was the third-worst ERA among 2022 opponents. Norfolk hit .233 against Jacksonville pitchers, plating 102 ER in 182.1 innings. The Tides' 21 home runs against Jumbo Shrimp pitchers was the third-most hit against the pitching staff out of the 10 teams Jacksonville faced in 2022.

The Jumbo Shrimp have walked at least five opposing hitters in six of the last seven games... Jacksonville is in jeopardy of dropping their fourth game in a row, which would mark a season high. They suffered through that skid just once (May 14-18) in 2022.

#### **ABOUT JEFF**

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

#### 2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

#### 2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
