LATE RALLY, SHUTDOWN 'PEN LIFT CARDS OVER AMARILLO: The

Cardinals pounded out 14 hits and broke a 4-4 tie with a 3-run top of the 9th inning as Springfield defeated Amarillo 7-4 at Hodgetown on Saturday night to even this three-game series at one game apiece. Chandler Redmond went 3-for-5 with 2 RBIs, including the eventual game-winner with a double to score RJ Yeager in the 9th to give the Birds a 5-4 lead. Nathan Church also drove in a pair and had two hits to extend his hitting streak to 8 games. Four Springfield hitters recorded multi-hit days. The Cards bullpen trio of Brandon Komar, Jack Ralston and Matt Svanson fired 3.2 scoreless innings in relief of starter Alex Cornwell.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander Dylan Ray makes his 7th start of the season for Amarillo...Last pitched on Friday, July 19 at San Antonio and made his best start of the season firing 5.2 hitless innings with 6 K...Has not allowed an earned run over his last 2 starts...Added to the Amarillo roster on June 12 after being activated off the injured list...Made one start with the ACL Diamondbacks on June 6, his season debut...Placed on the 60-day IL during Spring Training after experiencing forearm tightness... Made 3 starts at the end of the 2023 season with Amarillo going 1-2 with an 8.36 ERA...Spent most of the season with High-A Hillsboro where he went 7-6 with a 3.81 ERA in 22 starts...Made 6 starts for Low-A Visalia in 2022 after being drafted...Selected by the Diamondbacks in the 4th round of the 2022 draft out of Alabama...In 2022 with the Crimson Tide as a redshirt freshman went 1-4 with 8 saves and a 4.60 ERA and earned Freshman All-America from Collegiate Baseball News...Missed the 2021 season with Alabama due to Tommy John surgery in the fall of 2020...23 years old

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: Bouncing back from a series-opening loss with a 7-4 win on Saturday night, the Cardinals have won 12 of their last 15 to run their 2nd-half record to 13-7 after starting 1-4. Over their last 15 games, the Cardinals are 2nd in the league in batting (.296), runs scored (100, 6.7/game), and home runs trailing only Midland in all 3 categories.

ROAD WARRIORS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have felt plenty at home on the road. The Birds are 28-15 (.651) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.65 which is good for 2nd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco (3.44). The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.61. The Cardinals are also the top hitting road team in the circuit with a batting average of .258, 11 points higher than the next-best club (Midland, .247).

The Birds have also begun to turn things around at home recently. After dropping 11 of 12, the Cardinals have gone 8-2 over their last 10 games at Hammons Field, lifting their home record to 22-24 (.478) overall.

POWER SURGE: While the Cards have been on the wrong side of the home run ball during the 2024 season, Springfield has homered in 9 of its last 10 games and has outhomered its opponents 16-11 over the last 15 games. The Cardinals' 16 homers over their last 15 is 2nd-most in the Texas League during that time

CARDS LITTER LEADERBOARDS: The Cardinals have had one of the top offenses in the Texas League for the 2024 season, thanks mostly to their ability to get on base via the base hit. Entering play on Saturday, the Cardinals have the top 3 among qualified Texas League hitters in both batting average and OBP. Bryan Torres, Jimmy Crooks, and Jeremy Rivas sit 1-2-3 in the league in those two categories.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 15 games dating back to June 23. Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. The former Oklahoma Sooner is 3rd in the league among qualified hitters with a .373 average while adding 4 HR and 15 RBIs during that time with 3 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .661 and has a 1.100 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .875 OPS and .413 OBP tops in the circuit.

ANTICO NEARING MILESTONES: Cardinals OF Mike Antico is inching toward a pair of career milestones. Antico's next steal will give him 150 for his career, he is just 4 homers shy of 50 for his career sitting at 46. Over his last 10 games, Antico is batting .351 with 2 HR, 7 RBIs and is 3-for-3 in SB.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: The 2024 season has been a roller coaster ride for Cardinals OF Nathan Church. After busting out of the gates with a red-hot April that earned him Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month batting .349 with 3 HR and a .914 OPS, the former UC Irvine Anteater slowed down from the middle of May to the end of June, batting .179 with 0 HR and a .466 OPS in 31 games from May 23-June 30.

Since the calendar flipped to July, however, Church's bat has heated up again to the tune of a .308 clip with 2 HR. Over his last 11 games, Church is batting .341 with an OPS of .912. He is currently riding an 8-game hitting streak.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night. Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the alltime franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, Redmond has continued swinging a hot bat. Over his last 4 games, the Cardinals slugger is 9-for-16 with 2 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI with an 1.063 SLG and 1.651 OPS. In 9 games in July, he is batting .387 with a team-high 1.069 OPS.
