THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 1979, the Sounds won their first league championship, taking the Southern League crown after defeating the Columbus Astros 6-2 and the series 3-1. To date, it is one of three league championships the Sounds have won (SL in 1982, PCL in 2005).

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds play the Memphis Redbirds in game five of the six-game series. The Redbirds prevented a sweep with an 8-4 triumph last night. Left-hander Eric Lauer gets the ball for the Sounds. He'll face fellow southpaw Connor Thomas this evening.

Eric Lauer: 28-year-old Eric Lauer makes his 10th appearance and eighth start for the Sounds in 2023. The left-hander is 1-4 with a 5.52 ERA (29.1 IP/18 ER) with Nashville. He's also made nine appearances (8 starts) for Milwaukee, going 4-5 with a 5.48 ERA (42.2 IP/26 ER). Lauer took his third loss in four starts on September 2 at Durham. He gave up three runs (all earned) on five hits and three walks in 4.2 innings. Despite the poor result, Lauer struck out eight batters on 101 pitches (61 strikes). He was initially optioned from Milwaukee on June 14 and spent June 21-July 28 on the temporary inactive list before making a rehab start with the ACL Brewers. Lauer was acquired by Milwaukee on November 27, 2019 along with 2B Luis Urias in exchange for RF Trent Grisham and RHP Zach Davies from San Diego. He was originally drafted with the 25th pick by the Padres out of Kent State University in the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

Connor Thomas: 25-year-old Connor Thomas makes his 19th appearance and 15th start for the Redbirds tonight. In the midst of his second full season with Memphis, the left-hander is 4-4 with a 5.72 ERA (78.2 IP/50 ER) in 2023. Thomas took a no decision in his last start on September 1 vs. Gwinnett. He went just 3.2 innings, allowing six hits and four runs (all earned) with six strikeouts. Thomas totaled 74 pitches (45 strikes) in what eventually became an extra inning 6-4 loss for the Redbirds. He spent June 6-August 10 on the injured list, missing a couple of months while on the mend. After pitching in 2022 with Memphis, Thomas pitched in the Arizona Fall League where he was named the AFL Pitcher of the Year after leading the league with 34 strikeouts in 25.2 innings. A Georgia Tech product, Thomas was taken in the fifth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by St. Louis.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 6 (Tied), Second: 22, Third: 19, Fourth: 10, Fifth: 4, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Bringing the Rain: Josh Donaldson crushed his first home run as a Sound in last night's loss, taking a 3-1 slider and hitting it over the left field wall off Sem Robberse in the third inning. It was Donaldson's first home run since hitting a solo shot against the Chicago Cubs on July 8 while still with the Yankees. In four games with the Sounds, the former American League MVP is batting .143 (2-for-14) with three walks.

Bull on Base: Abraham Toro extended his on-base streak to 27 games with a double and walk last night. Dating back to the streak's commencement on July 9, Toro is batting .374 (40-for-107) with 22 runs, 15 doubles, a triple, three home runs, 21 RBI, 12 walks and a 1.063 OPS. He is the first Sounds player since at least 2010 to have multiple 20+ game on-base streaks in the same season (31 & 25) and joins Buffalo's Spencer Horwitz (31 & 26) as the only two players in the International League to have two on-base streaks of 25+ games this season. His current on-base streak is tied the third longest active on-base streak in the league with his teammate Keston Hiura.

Welcome to the Black Parade: Tyler Black recorded his first three-hit game at the Triple-A level in last night's loss, clubbing a couple of singles and a double. The Brewers' No. 4 prospect has reached in all but three of his first 27 games with the Sounds. In the past six games, he is batting .333 (6-for-18) with two runs, six RBI, six walks and three stolen bases.

Mistakes Were Made: The Sounds made three errors in last night's loss, bringing their September total to nine in 241 total chances. Their current .963 fielding percentage in September is the second to worst in the league, slightly better than Worcester's .962 fielding percentage. This is after the Sounds boasted the best fielding percentage in the league last month, making just eight miscues over 27 August games. The Sounds have also made 15 errors with Janson Junk on the mound this season, the most for any pitcher at the Triple-A level this season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's recently updated Top-30 Milwaukee prospects list. Infielder Tyler Black is the No. 4 prospect and No. 52 in baseball, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 5 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the organization's No. 28 prospect.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet picked up his 310th win at the helm of the Nashville club on Thursday, passing Rick Renick (1993-96) for second place on the all-time Sounds manager wins list. Sweet has a 310-245 record in four seasons (2014, 2021-present) with Nashville and is 2,264-2,100 across 33 years as a minor league manager. In order for Sweet to pass Trent Jewett (1998-00, 2003-04) for the most wins in Sounds history, Nashville would need to win 11 of their last 14 games.

LAST OUTING: Lauer had a rough go his last time out, allowing three home runs in 4.2 innings of work at Durham and taking the loss. He struck out eight, but also surrendered five hits and three walks. Lauer tossed a season-high 101 pitches in the 10-2 defeat.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Lauer's first career appearance against Memphis.

- Got his first win of the season on April 2 at Chicago-NL...5.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 6 K
- Made first relief appearance since July 28, 2021 at Pittsburgh on May 14 vs. Kansas City and got the win...5.1 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 6 K
- Placed on the 15-day injured list on May 21 with right shoulder impingement... started rehab assignment with Nashville on June 6
- Made two starts before officially optioned to Nashville on June 14, posting 13.50 ERA (4.2 IP/7 ER) in two rehab appearances
- Placed on Nashville's temporarily inactive list on June 21...assigned to ACL Brewers on July 28, making one appearance before returning to Nashville on August 1
- Since returning from ACL Brewers rehab assignment on August 1, has fanned 40 of 107 (37.4%) hitters faced over 24.2 innings

- In his 8th professional season; 4th with Milwaukee
- Posted a career-high in starts, wins, innings pitched, strikeouts and quality starts (13) in the Majors in 2022
- Drafted by San Diego in the first round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft
- Was San Diego's Opening Day starter on March 28, 2018 vs. San Francisco and earned a win after he tossed 6.0 shutout innings...became the 2nd-youngest pitcher in Padres history to start an opener, behind only Clay Kirby (1972)

- Tossed a no-hitter for Kent State on May 13, 2016 at Bowling Green

- Was a consensus First-Team All-American - only the second in program history
- Posted a 0.69 ERA his junior season - the nation's lowest mark in more than 30 years
