### SIX-RUN FIRST SPURS SHRIMP BY KNIGHTS

Jonathan Davis, Victor Mesa Jr. and Griffin Conine all belted home runs and the Jumbo Shrimp scored six runs in the first inning on Friday to roll by the Knights 10-4. A two-run double from **Troy Johnston** opened up the scoring, and later in the first, Davis popped a three-run shot. Charlotte cut the lead to 6-2 with a run in both the first and third, but Mesa Jr. cracked a two-run shot in the fourth. Conine added his two-run bomb in the fifth to make it 10-2. The score remained that way until **Wynton Bernard's** two-run homer in the ninth.

### MAY SHOWERS BRING JUNE FLOWERS?

Jacksonville finished 8-19 during the month of May, marking the club's worst record in any month since at least 2005. The Jumbo Shrimp actually lost the final game of April to begin a stretch of 17 losses in 20 games. After a season-high five-game winning streak from May 23-28, Jacksonville has now lost seven of their last nine games, meaning the club is just 10-24 (.294) in the last 34 games. Unsurprisingly, the Shrimp rank near the bottom in Triple-A in many categories since April 30: runs scored (155, T-28th), batting average (.247, 22nd), OBP (.338, 24th), slugging percentage (.382, 28th), OPS (.720, 28th) and home runs (30, T-27th).

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 39 of Jacksonville's 61 games (63.9 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 21 of the club's last 30 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 20 of its last 24 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 16-23 (.410) in these affairs.

### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder **Griffin Conine** suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 27 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 26-for-his-last-85, slashing .306/.423/.659/1.082 with six doubles, eight home runs, 23 RBIs, 18 walks and 17 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 16 of those 27 games, with multiple RBIs in six contests.

### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 11-22 (.333) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 15-13 (.536) road record is one of only six winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 146 runs in 28 games (5.2 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (134 runs in 33 games, 4.1 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 181 runs (T-ninth-most) in 33 home games (5.5 per game) compared to 129 (fourth-fewest) on the road (4.6 per game).

### ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 52-for-180 (.289/.433/.533/.966) with 12 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 32 RBIs, 43 walks and 27 runs scored in 52 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks fifth in the International League in both on-base percentage and walks, 12th in OPS, tied for 17th in extra-base hits (23) and 23rd in slugging percentage. Among the 129 qualified hitters in the IL, Bride ranks fourth in swinging-strike rate (5.0 percent) and 20th in line drive rate (28.6 percent).

### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, **Javier Sanoja** was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 25 of his last 28 games, notching 13 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 41-for-112 (.366/.421/.536/.957) with nine doubles, two triples, two home runs, 20 RBIs, 12 walks and 17 runs scored. Among the 195 IL hitters with at least 110 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (51.1 percent) and the fourth-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent).

### SHRIMP BITES

Of its four road series so far this season, Jacksonville has won three of them. They have split the first four games of this set at Charlotte... The Jumbo Shrimp have hit home runs in four straight games, one off a season-high... Jacksonville's bullpen pitched 6.0 innings of two-run ball on Friday.

### ABOUT SHAUN

-A native of Coral Springs, Fla., Anderson was originally selected by the Washington Nationals in the 40th round of the 2013 draft out of American Heritage High School (Plantation, Fla.). After a three-year career at the University of Florida in which he garnered All-America honors, Anderson was picked by the Boston Red Sox in the third round of the 2016 draft.

-Anderson made his major league debut for the San Francisco Giants on May 15, 2019 against the Toronto Blue Jays at Oracle Park. He went 5.0 innings and yielded three runs, two earned, on two hits with five strikeouts against three walks. His first MLB win came three starts later when he tossed 7.0 innings of two-run ball in an 8-2 Giants victory over the Baltimore Orioles on June 1, 2019 at Camden Yards. Anderson struck out four, walked one and ceded five hits.

-Anderson began the 2023 season by pitching for KIA in the KBO. In Anderson's words, it was an opportunity to become a starting pitcher again. He told *The Morning Call*, "I thought it was perfect timing to go over there. I wanted to get back to solidifying myself as a starter, get back into a rotation somewhere."

### 2024 SEASON

-After one start with Olmecas de Tabasco in the Mexican League, Anderson signed a minor league deal with the Texas Rangers on April 18. His contract was selected by the Rangers on May 15, and after two outings with Texas, he was designated for assignment on May 26. Texas dealt him to Miami on May 30 in exchange for cash considerations. The Marlins optioned him to Jacksonville that day.

### 2023 SEASON

-Anderson began the year by pitching in the Korean Baseball Organization with the KIA Tigers. He went 4-7 with a 3.76 ERA in 14 starts (79.0 IP, 76 H, 42 R, 33 ER, 26 BB, 64 K) before signing a minor league deal with the Philadelphia Phillies on July 20. He pitched the remainder of the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley, and actually pitched against Jacksonville on August 18 with 5.0 innings of three-run ball at Coca-Cola Park.
