TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, the teams will meet a total of 12 times this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona overcame a 4-2 deficit after 7 innings, but lost on a walk-off sac fly by Orelvis Martinez in the 9th. Luis Ortiz struck out 7 in 5 innings of 2-run ball in the defeat.

THAT'S ODD: With Wednesday's walk-off loss at New Hampshire, Altoona has lost 3 games in walk-off fashion this season. RHP J.C. Flowers has been on the mound in all three defeats: May 28 at Harrisburg, June 9 at Reading and June 22 at New Hampshire.

BIG LEAGUE CURVE: With 2019-21 Curve OF Bligh Madris became the 194th alumni head to the majors after their time in Curve, PA with his major league debut on Monday, June 20 against the Chicago Cubs. Madris became the 11th alumni to debut this season, joining **Diego Castillo, Beau Sulser, Jack Suwinski, Cam Aldred, Cal Mitchell, Yerry De Los Santos, Canaan Smith-Njigba, Jason Delay, Liover Peguero** and **Cam Vieaux**. In 2016 and 2018 the Curve had 14 players make their debut, a figure that could easily fall by the time the 2022 season wraps up.

Curve INF **Liover Peguero** became the third player to be recalled directly to the major league roster on Friday afternoon when INF **Tucupita Marciano** went on the COVID IL on short notice. Peguero arrived in Pittsburgh in time for first pitch and made his major league debut on Saturday against San Francisco going 1-for-3 with a walk. He became the first Pirate born in the 21st century to suit up for Pittsburgh.

SHACKDADDY: Curve INF **Aaron Shackelford** picked up his first career multi-homer game on Friday, June 17 against Erie. Shackelford's two-run homer in the fifth inning traveled approximately 462 feet. It was the second time this season that the Curve had a multi-homer game (Sabot, May 17 vs Richmond) and the 115th in franchise history. The 2021 Curve had six multi-homer games with three of them coming from **Mason Martin**.

ACE OUT, ACE IN: Prior to Thursday's game against Erie, the Curve announced the promotion of RHP Mike Burrows to Triple-A Indianapolis. Ranked as the No. 11 prospect in the Pirates Minor League System by MLB.com, Burrows was unscored upon in six of his starts this year and allowed 2 runs or fewer in 9-of-his-12 starts. At the time of his promotion he ranked: 5th in ERA (2.94), 6th in K (69), 5th in BAA (.199), 9th in WHIP (1.10), T-1st in GS (12) and was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 30.

In his place, Altoona activated RHP **Quinn Priester** from the IL, ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Pirates system by MLB.com. With Priester's activation, the Curve have the 2019 and 2021 Pirates first round selections on the active roster. Priester made his team debut on Sunday, June 19 against Erie with 3.0 scoreless innings.

HE'S BACK: Prior to Friday's game at Reading, the Curve activated C **Henry Davis** off the injured list after he missed about 3 weeks with a left wrist injury. Placed on the IL on May 18, Davis played a 2 game rehab assignment in Florida during which he caught a combined no-hitter with Bradenton on Thursday, June 9 thrown by fellow rehabber Quinn Priester (3 IP), Anthony Solometo (4 IP), Jake Sweeney (1 IP) and Junior Thibo (1 IP). Davis went 0-for-4 with a strikeout in his first game back in the lineup on Saturday, June 11.

ALVY'S BIG START: **Andres Alvarez** picked up a career-high 5 RBI in Altoona's 13-12 win over Bowie on Thursday, June 2. After an RBI single and an RBI triple in the second inning, Alvarez smashed a go-ahead 3-run homer in the 8th inning to lead the Curve to a win. Through 44 games Alvarez has set a new career-high with a team-best 10 home runs and 27 RBI. His .528 slugging percentage ranks 7th in the Eastern League.

LET'S HIT: The Curve have picked up at least 10 hits in 14-of-their-33 last games. Altoona has had 10 or more hits in a game 21 times this season, most in the Eastern League. The Curve lead the Eastern League in team batting average (.251) and total hits (525); they hold a 26-hit lead over the next highest team in the league (Bowie).

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 33 of 65 games played this season and hold a 23-10 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 12-1 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 70 home runs on the season, tied for 22nd-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and fourth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (86). The Curve have allowed a home run in 40 of 65 games.

THE FISHER KITTIES: Managed by Cesar Martin in his second season, the Fisher Cats have one member of the Blue Jays 40-man roster in RHP Hagen Danner. Top prospects in Manchester include INF Orelvis Martinez (#2), RHP Adam Kloffenstein (#11), RHP Hagen Danner (#17), RHP Trent Palmer (#23), RHP Joey Murray (#24), OF Sebastian Espino (#25), RHP Hayden Juenger (#26) and INF Spencer Horwitz (#30).

THE FIRST TOSSE: Adam Kloffenstein makes his first start of the season against Altoona tonight. Toronto's 3rd round pick in 2018 out of Magnolia, HS in Magnolia, TX, Kloffenstein is ranked as the #11 prospect in the system by MLB.com. In high school, Kloffenstein's shortstop was Jordan Groshans. He was committed to pitch at TCU before signing with the Jays for \$2.45 million.

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Started on Opening Day against Harrisburg and was charged with the loss, matched a career-high five runs allowed... Walked a career-high five batters on 4/21 vs. New Hampshire... Was placed on IL on May 12 (shoulder, retroactive to 5/11), returned on 5/19 vs. Richmond... Allowed 1 R or fewer in 5-of-8 starts (4/26 - 6/11): 0-2, 3.18 ERA (11 ER / 31.0 IP), 30 K... Made the shortest start of his career (0.2 IP) on 6/17 vs. Erie allowing 3 H and 1 BB on 36 pitches, 23 strikes...

2021: Made his professional debut with High-A Greensboro... Allowed one earned run or fewer in six of his first seven appearances... Struck out at least six batters in six straight outings from May 16 to June 26... Struck out a career-high nine batters on June 26 vs. Greenville, allowed one run on two hits and no walks in 6.0 innings pitched... Was placed on the IL on July 12 with a sore shoulder... Returned on August 14 and was held 2.1 innings or fewer in each of his final five regular season appearances for Greensboro to finish the regular season... After using a powerful sinking fastball at South Carolina, has adopted a more traditional four-seam fastball as a pro... Change has helped his fastball play better off of his cutter, slider and changeup... Was rated by MLB.com as the No. 21 prospect in the 2020 draft... Signed with the Pirates for \$2,050,000... Was ranked as the top prep player in the state of South Carolina in 2017 by Perfect Game... Grew up playing shortstop before beginning to pitch during his junior year at Hilton Head (SC) High School... Was the South Carolina 4A Player-of-the-Year in 2017 despite having his season cut short by a torn fingernail... Was a Baseball America Top 500 prospect for the 2017 MLB Draft... Plays the guitar and piano... Does not have any social media accounts and didn't have a cell phone until age 16... Brother, JJ, was named the 2020 Rookie of the Year for South Carolina's Club Baseball Team after going 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in three starts during the pandemic-shortened season... With nearby baseball fields closed during the height of the COVID-19 Pandemic in the summer of 2020, Mlodzinski told WSAV-TV in Hilton Head S.C. that he would get his throwing in at dusk on local golf courses with his brother JJ...
