Tonight: The Lugnuts play the first in a six-game series and 24 meetings overall this season against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Tonight also is the first of a stretch of 12 home games in 13 days against the Loons and the South Bend Cubs. Tonight at the ballpark its Sensory Friendly Night, assisting in the awareness of autism, with lowered stadium volume and static images on the video board. Lugnuts right-hander **Rafael Kelly** receives his third start of the year, opposed by Great Lakes right-hander **Bobby Miller**, who is also expected to start the series finale.

Sunday Afternoon: Lugnuts 8, TinCaps 3. The Nuts won their 1700th game all-time, as shortstop Max Schuemann homered on the first pitch of the game and first baseman Patrick McColl walloped a two-run homer in a four-run eighth inning, helping erase a 3-1 deficit with seven consecutive runs against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. In the process, the Nuts clinched a third consecutive six-game series split, winning for the third time on Sunday this year.

Last Transaction: The Nuts have made only one roster move this year, placing starting pitcher Jeff Criswell on the Injured List and adding relief pitcher Brandon Withers from Extended Spring Training on May 12th. In the process, Withers became the 835th player in Lugnuts team history.

Lug•Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020). The Athletics had previously partnered with Lugnuts rivals Burlington (1963-1974, 2011-2012), West Michigan (1994-1996), Kane County (1993-2010) and Beloit (2013-2020).

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

A Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff leads the High-A Central with a 3.04 earned run average and are tied for 1st with the fewest walks (53) and best GO/AO ratio (1.39).

Offensive Impact: Lansing leads the High-A Central in at-bats (608), hits (147), doubles (44) and total bases (249) and ranks second in slugging percentage (.410) and OPS (.736).

Individual Excellence: Infielder Max Schuemann is second in the league with 16 runs scored, second with 11 steals, fourth with a .431 on-base percentage and fifth with a .980 OPS. Outfielder Jake Suddleson is tied for second with nine extra-base hits and fourth with six doubles. Infielder Jordan Díaz, who homered in four of the first five games of the series at Fort Wayne, is second in the circuit with 16 RBIs and tied for fourth with five roundtrippers.

Streaking: Outfielder Michael Guldberg enters play today riding a team-high 13-game on-base streak, hitting .308 (16-for-52) with three walks and two HBPs in that span. Infielder Max Schuemann enters on an 12-game on-base streak (13-for-45, .289, with four walks and five HBPs).

A Lineup of Starters: The Lugnuts have used nine starting pitchers this year, namely: Seth Shuman (May 4, May 15); Brady Basso (May 5, May 12); Richard Guasch (May 6, May 20); Reid Birlingmair (May 7, May 14, May 21); Stevie Emanuels (May 9, May 16, May 23); Rafael Kelly (May 11, May 18); Jeff Criswell (May 8); Shohei Tomioka (May 13); and Colin Peluse (May 22).

A Breath of Relief: The bullpen has been a strength for the Lugnuts, with a 2.93 ERA and 120 strikeouts compared to only 27 walks in 89 1/3 innings. Sunday marked the latest example, with Charles Hall, Aiden McIntyre and Jack Weisenburger combining to toss 5 2/3 scoreless innings in relief of Stevie Emanuels.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

1999: Franklin German tied the Midwest League record and established a Lugnuts franchise record (since tied) with six hits in one game.

2015: Anthony Alford tied the franchise record with four walks and scored four runs, and the Lugnuts blasted Fort Wayne, 11-5, on Memorial Day at Cooley Law School Stadium. Rowdy Tellez had four RBIs and Richard Ureña also scored four runs to back Sean Reid-Foley's professional high five innings / seven strikeouts.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher Ty Tice '18 and outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and Jeff Criswell (Portage Central H.S.) and Jack Weisenburger (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following Troy Miller, Jake Fox and Rich Hill).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielders Michael Guldberg and Jake Suddleson are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder Jake Suddleson and first baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger, Michigan; Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year.

Personal: One of five international free agents on the Lugnuts roster... one of four players (Austin Beck, Michael Danielak, Ryan Gridley) with experience at the High-A level, having pitched in Stockton in 2019... signed with the A's at age 19 on July 1, 2016... scout: Juan C. De La Cruz, who also signed teammate Richard Guasch... Guasch had taken up residence in the Dominican Republic after leaving Cuba... other notable players from Samaná: Hanley Ramirez, Yordano Ventura, Wily Peralta, Fernando Rodney.

2021: Piggybacked in the second game of the season on Wednesday, May 5th vs Lake County, relieving southpaw Brady Basso in the fifth inning with Nuts trailing, 1-0... allowed unearned run in the 5th and earned run in the 6th before finding a groove and setting down seven of the last eight batters faced... final line: 4 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 4 K in Lugnuts' 3-1 loss... received first start of the season on Tuesday, May 11th at Dayton, replacing Opening Day starter Seth Shuman (who was pushed back to May 15th)... pitched on a tightrope, allowing eight hits, one walk and one HBP in five innings, but struck out five and allowed only two runs in a no-decision... pitched around a pair of singles in the 1st inning, with Quin Cotton caught stealing second base by catcher Drew Millas... with two outs and no one on in the 2nd, allowed a single to Mariel Bautista, a walk to Miguel Hernández and an RBI double to Jacob Hurtubise that scored a run, but retired the dangerous Brian Rey on a flyout to leave runners at second and third... pitched around a two-out Eric Yang single in the 3rd inning... with one out in the 4th, plunked Bautista and gave up a single to Hernández and a sac fly to Hurtubise, but again retired Rey on a flyout to end the inning... pitched around singles by Cotton and Quincy McAfee, stranding runners at the corners to end the 5th and final inning... Lugnuts went on to win in ten innings over the Dragons, 9-4.



Winter Ball: Made one relief appearance in 2019-2020 and two appearances in 2020-2021 for Toros del Este in the Dominican Winter League, totaling one unearned run allowed... Toros won the Dominican Winter League in 2019-2020.

2019: Made first appearance of the season on May 16th for High-A Stockton... assigned to Low-A Beloit on June 13th, debuting with six scoreless innings... made one start at Short-Season A Vermont, June 18th, working five innings, before returning to Beloit... came back to Stockton for one start, on August 3rd, and posted 5 2/3 scoreless innings, but was sent back to Beloit afterward to finish the season in the MWL... struck out 20 batters in a two-start Midwest League span (8/15 at Quad Cities: 9 K in 5 2/3 scoreless innings; 8/20 vs. Burlington: 11 K in 5 innings, allowing five unearned runs)... overall ERA for the season of 3.35 ranked second in the organization... opposing base stealers were successful in all seven attempts against him.

2018: Spent the entire season with SS-A Vermont (4.59 ERA, 14 G, 10 GS, 68 2/3 IP, 7 HR, 27 BB, 59 K, .247)... worked six innings on four occasions... in seven of last eight outings, allowed one run or fewer... limited left-handers to .171/.298/.305, while right-handers hit .297/.353/.462... opposing base stealers were successful in four out of five attempts.

2017: Excelled in the Dominican Summer League (2.53 ERA, 10 G, 6 GS, 42 2/3 IP, 1 HR, 10 BB, 47 K, .184 AVG), earning ticket on August 3rd to the AZL (2.38 ERA, 6 G, 2 GS, 22 2/3 IP, 1 HR, 2 BB, 23 K, .238 AVG)... tossed six no-hit innings in DSL, 7/22/17 vs. Astros... of 16 runs allowed in the DSL, eight came in one start; in seven starts, allowed one run or fewer... in postseason interview, Gil Patterson told Melissa Lockard (who currently covers the A's for The Athletic) that Kelly was "Unorthodox. He falls way off the rubber on each pitch. You don't teach that. He throws a change-up that people keep calling a curveball because it looks like a curveball. He has a fastball, curveball, change-up and split. And you know what I'm going to do with him? Leave him alone. I'm going to leave him alone because it works. When the time comes that it doesn't work as well, then we will try to address some things with the delivery, specifically with keeping the head online a little bit and finishing straight to homeplate for extension."
