TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque hosts Salt Lake for the club's 22nd Home Opener in franchise history, beginning a six-game series against the Bees ... Anthony Molina is scheduled to make his lootopes debut on the hill while Brett Kerry is slated to start for Salt Lake.

HOME OPENER: All-time, the Isotopes are 14-7 in Home Openers but have dropped four of their last five (last win: 2023 against Salt Lake, 7-5) ... Albuquerque has hosted the Bees for its Home Opener three previous times, holding a 2-1 record (2017, 7-4 win; 2019, 11-4 loss; and 2023, 7-5 win).

TWO OR FEWER: The Isotopes won Sunday's game against Sacramento 2-1, the first time since September 24, 2023, vs. Oklahoma City, the 2023 season finale (2-1), the club has won a game when scoring two runs or fewer.

ONE RUN ALLOWED: Albuquerque's pitching staff held Sacramento on Sunday to one run, the first time the club has held an opponent to one run or fewer since blanking the Rainiers in Tacoma September 4, 2024, a 3-0 Isotope victory.

MR. DOLLANDER: Rockies top prospect Chase Dollander made his Triple-A debut Sunday on the bump and tossed 4.0 innings and allowed one run on six hits and two walks with five punchouts. He induced seven swings and misses.

VEEN: Outfielder Zac Veen recorded his second double of the year Sunday ... He has a hit in each of the first three games of the year (4x11) ... Over 24 games with the Isotopes, including 21 in 2024, he is slashing.237/.297/.484 with five doubles, six homers, 15 RBI and six stolen bases.

WARMING UP: Warming Bernabel registered his first Triple-A hit, homer and RBI with his go-ahead dinger in the fifth inning Sunday ... He also tallied his first multi-hit contest with his single in the ninth inning.

MILLER: Owen Miller picked up his first Isotope hit and RBI with his game-tying RBI double in the third inning Sunday against Sacramento.

RITTER: Ryan Ritter became the first Isotopes player to homer for his first Triple-A hit since Zac Veen Aug. 25, 2024, at Sugar Land with his solo blast on Saturday night.

OPENING SERIES: Albuquerque has lost the first series of the year for the second-straight season ... The lsotopes look to avoid losing the first two series of the year for the second-straight season.

PALMA: Ronaiker Palma started behind the plate Saturday for his Triple-A debut and went 1-for-3, singling to left field on the first pitch he saw as an Isotope.

TRIPLE-A DEBUT: Eight players on the Opening Day roster will be making their Triple-A debuts this year: Zach Agnos, Juan Mejia, Warming Bernabel, Adael Amador, Chase Dollander, Ryan Ritter, Sterlin Thompson and Ronaiker Palma.

PROSPECTS: Nine players on MLB.com's top 30 Rockies prospects list begin the year with Albuquerque: Chase Dollander, Yanquiel Fernandez, Adael Amador, Zac Veen, Carson Palmquist, Ryan Ritter, Sterlin Thompson, Jaden Hill, Zach Agnos.

MLB EXPERIENCE: The Opening Day roster features 13 players who have seen time in the Major Leagues. Diego Castillo has registered the most MLB service time (4 year, 169 days).

WHAT'S MY AGE AGAIN?: Catcher Austin Nola, 35, is the elder statesmen at the outset as he begins his 14th pro season.

2024 ATTENDANCE: Albuquerque led the Pacific Coast League in total attendance in 2024 (503,525) for the second time in club history (2023) while also pacing the circuit in average attendance (7,714) for the third time (2022 and 2023).

HITTING COACH: Jordan Pacheco, entering his fourth season with the club, is the longest tenured lsotopes hitting coach, surpassing Steve Phillips (2006-08).

PITCHING COACH: Chris Michalak, entering his third season in the role, is the second-longest tenured lsotopes pitching in club history (longest: Glenn Dishman, 2010-14).

2025 FIRST-HALF SCHEDULE: The Isotopes will face seven teams over the 75 games in the first half, which ends June 22 ... Sacramento is the lone club Albuquerque will play just once in the first half ... The Isotopes also won't play Round Rock or Las Vegas in the first half.

SALT LAKE TIES: Bees pitchers Michael Petersen (2023) and Dakota Hudson (2024) have each spent time in an Isotopes uniform ... Salt Lake right-hander Chase Silseth hails from Farmington and was named Gatorade New Mexico Player of the Year in 2018 after his senior year at Piedra Vista High School ... Isotopes infielder Keston Hiura played in 37 games for the Bees last season, blasting 20 home runs with 42 RBI.

BAGS ON THE YEAR: Albuquerque stole a franchise-record 186 stolen bases last year (previous mark: 178 set in 2003).

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
