TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Dodgers) host the Fresno Grizzlies (Rockies) in the last game of a six-game series. Today is IEHP Kids Eat Free Sunday and kids can "Run the Bases" after the game thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Tickets are available by visiting requakes.com. VS THE GRIZZLIES: Today's game is the last of 12 against the Grizzlies in 2024 and the sixth of six at home. Back in June, the Quakes split a six-game set with the Grizzlies at Chukchansi Park in Fresno. After last night's win, the Quakes are now 7-4 against Fresno in 2024. Last season, the Quakes went 5-7 against the Grizzlies, 4-2 here at home. LAST GAME: The Quakes slugged three home runs and Cam Day went six solid innings as the Quakes defeated the Fresno Grizzlies on Saturday night, 8-2 at LoanMart Field for their second straight win. Jose Meza had two homers (5,6) and a three-run triple, giving him six RBIs on the night. Victor Rodrigues also ripped his first homer of the year, helping Rancho build an early lead on Fresno starter Jeff Mena (0-1). After three innings of one-run baseball from Samuel Sanchez, Day (4-3) entered and allowed one run on five hits over the final six innings, picking up the win. **DOWN IN A GOOD WAY:** Rancho's team ERA entering the home stand last week was at 5.63, last in the league. They've made some good progress over the first 11 games in this home stand though, lowering it to 5.38, now sixth in the league. Sean Paul Linan's seven scoreless innings on Friday night matched a season-best for any Rancho starting

WHERE THERE'S A WILMAN, THERE'S A WAY: Rancho infielder Wilman Diaz has had a great second half, but his August is off the charts. Diaz enters tonight's game with a .309 batting average in the second half with three homers and 31 RBIs over 37 games, but he's hitting .462 in August, going 18-for-39 with 11 RBIs in nine games. Diaz currently leads the team in RBIs with 51 and has raised his average to .259 on the year. His current 13-game hit streak is the longest for any Quake this year.

ANOTHER SERIES WIN: The Quakes are in the midst of their best stretch of the second half, having won seven of their last eight overall and 13 of their last 17. Last night's win over Fresno gives them their third straight series win (at Inland Empire, vs San Jose, vs Fresno) and they currently own the best second-half record in the league, two games up in the South over the Visalia Rawhide and three over the Lake Elsinore Storm. In order to make the playoffs, Rancho must finish the second half ahead of both Visalia and Inland Empire (six games back).

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: Right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his seventh start and 10th appearance for the Quakes, his second against the Grizzlies. In his last outing overall, he carried a perfect game into the fifth inning, finishing five innings with one run and one hit allowed, while striking out eight in a win over San Jose on August 4. Zazueta 's lone outing against Fresno was on June 14, when he scattered three hits over 3.2 scoreless innings in a no-decision. Zazueta was acquired by the Dodgers in a trade with the Yankees this past February for former Quake Caleb Ferguson. Zazueta was originally signed by the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico.

ALBERT PACHECO: Lefty Albert Pacheco makes his 19th appearance, 18th start and third start against Rancho. In his first start against the Quakes, he allowed three runs on four hits over 5.2 innings in a no-decision at home on June 11. His last start was on Tuesday in the first game of this series, where he allowed two runs on three hits over five innings in a no-decision. Pacheco was signed by the Rockies in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic.
