LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox won their eighth game in their last 10 with a 8-2 victory on Friday night. Bowie used two four-run innings in the first and ninth to secure its third win of the series. Samuel Basallo collected a game-high three hits while John Rhodes tallied a game-high three RBI. Dylan Beavers, Enrique Bradfield Jr., and Reed Trimble also collected two hits each. Trace Bright struck out seven over 4.2 innings of work and **Houston Roth** delivered two perfect innings to earn the save.

START ME UP

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the lowest ERA in Double-A and the second lowest in MiLB at 1.86. Over the last five games, the starters have combined to throw 22.2 innings with just one earned run allowed.

BASALLO BASHES

 $\mbox{C/1B}\mbox{\sc Basallo},$ the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, leads the Eastern League in total bases (170) and is second in hits (106). Last night, Basallo recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season. The No. 3 O's/No. 11 MLB prospect leads the league this month in batting with a .392 average and 20 hits.

BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. made his Double-A debut on Tuesday and recorded his first Double-A hit and RBI on a single to right in the 4th. Last night, he stole his first base at Double-A and his 60th overall on the season, which is second-most in all of MiLB. Bradfield was drafted by the Orioles with the 17th overall pick in 2023.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF Jud Fabian retook the Eastern League lead in home runs with his 18th on the season on Tuesday. Amongst all Double-A hitters, he is tied for 4th in home runs. The O's No. 13 prospect has 33 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

After his third consecutive multi-hit game, OF **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in his last 11 games and in 79 of 97 played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is second in the Eastern League in walks (57) and tied for third in stolen bases (26). In the series, Beavers is 6-for-14 with a double, triple, three RBI and five walks.

WELCOME TO DOUBLE-A

IF/OF Tavian Josenberger and OF Reed Trimble have recorded their first Double-A hits since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on Tuesday. Josenberger collected a pair of hits in his debut while Trimble cleared the bases with a double down the line on Wednesday. At the time of their promotions, Josenberger stole 45 bases, second most in the South Atlantic League, while Trimble went 23-for-23 in stolen base attempts.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST

Bowie has scored in the first inning in seven of the last 10 games. When the Baysox score first, they are 37-17 this season compared to 16-41 when they do not. The Baysox have scored the second-most first inning runs in the Eastern League (66) along with Somerset.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve are tied for fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 16-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Pirates has won 10 of the last 11 games against the Baysox. Three of the Pirates top 30 prospects are on the Curve active roster - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 7), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 8), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 18).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Dominic Perachi makes his fourth start of the season for Altoona. Perachi started the season in High-A Greensboro before earning promotion to Double-A Altoona on May 2. Perachi was sent back to Greensboro on May 14 before returning to the Curve on August 6. The 23-year-old could not get out of the fourth inning in his two starts last week in Portland. He was drafted in the 11th round of the 2022 Draft out of Salve Regina University (DIII).

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organizations. All Ribens, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
