### Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound today, followed by RHP **Trenton Denholm** (supposed to pitch yesterday, but **Rorik Maltrud** went 7.0IP). Iowa will counter with RHP **Connor Noland**. Columbus is 15-8 (.652) versus right handers this year. Noland has pitched against the Clippers six times in his career, going 3-3 with a 7.00ERAA (27.0IP, 32H, 26R, 21ER, 12BB, 30K).

### vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 17-17 opposing the I-Cubs (32-24 in the last 56G). Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has 5HR and 15RBI in 20G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit 9HR with 33RBI in 33G (.314, 38x121) and **Milan Tolentino** has 9HR and 20RBI in 23G (.346, 27x78). **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .320 (24x75) with 3HR and 9RBI in 20G.

### Keep 'Em Separated

Iowa became the first team in the IL to both score and give up over 200 runs with Tuesday's 9-6 contest. With one score today, the Clippers will become the 2nd team to do so (all other teams are at least 18 runs away from one column or the other, if not both). All told, Iowa and Columbus have seen a combined 819 runs in 79G (10.4 per), with 130 scored in their 11G with each other (11.8 per).

### No Early Power

The Clippers are homerless through the first 2G of the series for the third week in a row (0HR in first 3G of series twice). Prior to the trip to Buffalo, Columbus owned the 3rd most HR in the IL (32, one behind Iowa and Louisville for the lead), but the Clippers have just 9HR in 14G since (one away from the basement) and only 6HR are active (**Juan Brito**, **Nolan Jones** and **Kody Huff** all have a pair).

### Watch Out for Watson

Though he struggled in Buffalo (2x13 in 3G), **Kahlil Watson** is hitting .333/.481/.600 with 9XBH in his last 17G (1XBH in first 12G). His 4G walk streak was snapped yesterday (5BB in 9PA (4/30-5/5), but he was able to extend his hit streak to 4G (.353, 6x17 since 5/1). When posting up in centerfield, as he is today, Watson is hitting .358/.493/.547 in 14G (67PA; .182/.333/.364 in all others, 68PA).

### Since the Option

**George Valera** is hitting just .217 (5x23) this month without any extra base hits (.294, 10x34 with 3XBH in 8G rehab last month). While he has only 5K in 23PA in May (22%), he has yet to draw a walk. In fact, he has 3BB in 63PA (5%) with Columbus this season (130BB in 972PA, 13%, in 233G with Columbus from 2022-25). His season-long strikeout rate (13%) is also down (27% from 2022-25).

### Good for What Ails Ya

**Nolan Jones** went 3x21 (.143) in 6G after hitting .407 (11x27) in the 8G prior (4/16-4/26), but is 3x10 with a double in 2G on the banks of the Raccoon River, where he owns a career line of .379/.500/.758 with 5HR and 21RBI in 17G (has reached base in all, at least twice in 14G). Despite the slump, Jones is still driving in runs, as he now has 88RBI in his last 97G in Triple-A (.311/.426/.600 with 24HR).

### Eye is for Ingle

**Cooper Ingle** has drawn 21BB in his first 63PA (33%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .268 (33x123) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .465OBP and a +15 differential in the walk to strikeout department (42 to 27). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 42BB are tied for 5th most (**Travis Bazzana** leads, 47).

### POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .128/.292/.154 with 0HR and 0RBI in 11G (2x4 with a double on 4/28). Of 29 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off a LHP (102AB; 27HR in 399AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .364 (8x22) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

### Frias Figures It Out

**Dayan Frias** scored for the ninth time in his last 11G yesterday, entering as a pinch runner. Since 4/23, Frias is hitting .344 (11x32) in 11G (started the year 8x64, .125, through first 19G). Unfortunately, he has only 1RBI on his hot streak (last AB, 5/3 vs. Toledo, snapped 14G streak without). Though he has reached base safely only 33 times on the year, he already has 8SB (30G; had 7SB in 48G last year).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Thursday, May 7

## This Date in Clipper History

5/7/1979

**Bobby Brown**, a native of Norfolk, VA, went 3x5 with a home run and 3RBI to lead the Clippers to a 9-5 win over his hometown team, the Tidewater Tides. Brown went on to win the International League MVP that season, the first of nine MVPs for the Columbus Clippers. Since the Clippers began play in 1977, they have tallied the most MVPs in the league, two ahead of 2nd place Norfolk (Tidewater).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 44-48 (.478) in pitch reviews, with batters going 27-34 (.443) and pitchers/catchers going 17-14 (.548). They have run out of challenges in 20G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 12th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 19G this season (10-9, .526), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Stuart Fairchild** moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 4/26 at Buffalo and that runner came around to score in a rare loss. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-23 (.785) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-2 (.333, blew 7-run lead in on of the losses) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 404-423 (.489), 374-377 with Columbus (.498).

### Unfortunate Run:

Prior to his last 3GS (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

### 2026 Spring Training:

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.

### Last Season:

Pitched for Yakult in Japan... in the Central League (Majors) went 7-8 with a 4.04ERA in 15G (82.1IP, 70H, 41R, 37ER, 30BB, 61K)... in the Eastern League (minors) was 0-1 with a 1.33ERA in 6G (20.1IP, 12H, 3R, 1ER, 12BB, 13K).
