RIDERS TAKE OPENER IN AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders outslug the Amarillo Sod Poodles 7-5 on Tuesday night from HODGETOWN. After Amarillo (20-26) scored on an RBI single by Lujames Groover in the bottom of the first, Frisco (27-18) muscled four runs on three extra-base hits in the top of the second. **Aaron Zavala** roped a two-run double, **Sebastian Walcott** drilled an RBI double and **Abimelec Ortiz** served an RBI single to put the Riders up 4-1. In the bottom of the second, Amarillo's Tommy Troy drew a bases loaded walk to cut the Frisco lead to 4-2. **Luis Mieses** then crashed a solo home run in the top of the third, extending the Riders lead to 5-2. The Sod Poodles crawled within a run in the bottom of the third when Ivan Melendez powered a two-run homer to trail the RoughRiders 5-4. Frisco then tallied two unanswared runs when Mieses rifled an RBI double in the top of the fifth and Ortiz pounded a solo home run in the top of the seventh, giving the Riders a 7-4 ledger. In the top of the ninth, Amarillo's Gavin Conticello hit a lead-off triple before Groover plated him on a sacrifice fly, cutting the deficit to 7-5. With the tying run at the plate and two outs, Riders reliever **Gavin Collyer** then fanned Melendez to secure his fourth save of the campaign. Frisco reliever **Ryan Lobus** (1-0) secured the victory with two scoreless frames. **Travis MacGregor** and **Skylar Hales** both nabbed holds. Amarillo starter Jose Cabrera (2-2) picked up the loss, allowing six runs across five innings.

OFFENSE COMES ALIVE IN AMARILLO:

Since HODGETOWN opened in 2019, the RoughRiders have played 10 more games there than any other Texas League visiting team, and they have enjoyed their time offensively. In 72 games in the Yellow City, the Riders are averaging 6.4 runs per game and 1.75 home runs per game. For comparison, the Riders are averaging 5.0 runs per game and 0.95 homers per game overall since 2019. Since 2005, the RoughRiders have had 11 single games in which they have hit six or more home runs and seven of them have come in Amarillo.

SAVE TONIGHT:

Last Friday night, **Travis MacGregor** became the 10th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Gavin Collyer** are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and **Skylar Hales** has recorded two saves. Frisco is tied for the MiLB lead with 17 saves.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 11 games, he has blasted four home runs while slashing .255/.314/.596/.910 with four doubles, nine RBIs and nine runs scored. His six home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are tied for the sixth-most since 2005 through 45 team games, trailing Oscar Taveras (10), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (9), Fernando Tatis Jr. (9), Delmon Young (8), Jackson Churio (7) and Samuel Basallo (7).

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .237 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 28 games. In that stretch, the Riders are 15-13, batting .195 (45-for-231)/.269/.312/.581 with RISP. Their .195 batting average is ninth in the Texas League and 27th among 30 Double-A teams.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 16 games, Ortiz is hitting .323 (20-for-62)/.417/.581/.998 with four doubles, four home runs and 16 RBIs. Over the last two seasons, Ortiz's five home runs in HODGETOWN are the most by a visiting player in the Texas League. He is hitting .381/.447/.786/1.233 with two doubles, five home runs, 11 RBIs and 11 runs scored in his career in Amarillo.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 20 this month, which is seventh in the league and have allowed 27, which is tied for the most. Frisco's 4.60 ERA is sixth in the league during the month while they are 13-9 in May.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .308 (28-for-91)/.443/.484/.927 over his last 27 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (36) and OBP (.427) while leading the league in walk rate (22.9 percent), a mark which also ranks 3rd in Minor League Baseball (min. 145 PA). In May, he is hitting .324/.455/.465/.920, ranking sixth in average, first in OBP and seventh in OPS in the Texas League.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first eight starts, his 1.94 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through eight starts in recorded franchise history by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 8.5 K/BB and 91.9 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 51 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 41.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

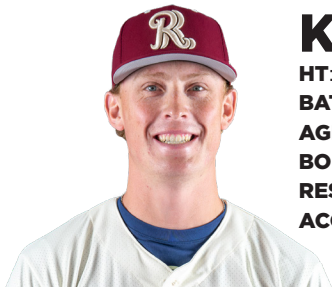

ABOUT KOHL

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins.

2025 SEASON

-Entered 2025 as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

-Tied a career high with 10 strikeouts in third start against Corpus Christi on April 23rd.

-He is 1st in the Texas League (min. 30 IP) in K-rate (36.4%) and second in batting average against (.165) while he is third in swinging strike rate (14.8%) and first in WHIP (0.92).

-On May 7th at San Antonio, threw 6.0 innings of no-hit baseball, at one point retiring 16 batters in a row. **Ryan Lobus** and **Skylar Hales** then finished out the sixth no-hitter in RoughRiders franchise history.

2024 SEASON

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

-In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

2023 SEASON

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
