### LAST GAME

The Baysox rallied to take down the Altoona Curve 6-5 in 10 innings. A three-run home run from John Rhodes in the first got Bowie out to an early lead, but Altoona responded with the game's next four runs, eventually taking the lead in the fifth on an Eli Wilson solo home run. Max Wagner tied the game in the bottom half with an RBI double. After the Curve took the lead in the seventh on an error, Wagner came to the plate in the ninth to deliver his second game-tying RBI of the night to send the game to extra innings. In the tenth, Jud Fabian threw out the potential go-ahead run at the plate in the top half, before Rhodes scored on a wild pitch to clinch Bowie's seventh walk-off win of the season.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter tonight with an overall record of 52-58. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the Curve are just 18-24 in the second half, last place in the Southwest division and six games out of a playoff spot. Overall, this season, Bowie is 10-12 against Altoona, including a series split at Prince George's Stadium in mid-May. The Curve's 893 strikeouts as a team this season are the fewest in Double-A and the fourth fewest in Minor League Baseball. Altoona's active roster is highlighted by four of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, consisting of LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5 PIT/No. 89 OVR), LHP Jackson Wolf (No. 14 PIT), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 22 PIT), and OF Matt Gorski (No. 25 PIT).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Sean Sullivan is set to take the ball this afternoon for Altoona. Sullivan's 86.1 innings are second-most on the Curve roster this season, but his 12 home runs allowed are also the second-highest total on the team, with right-handers hitting 10 of the 12. Sullivan took the win in Tuesday's series opener against Bowie, tossing 5.1 innings allowing two earned runs with five strikeouts. This season, against Bowie, Sullivan has gone 2-1 through four starts with a 3.54 ERA (8 ER in 20.1 IP). An 8th round draft pick of the Pirates in 2021 from the University of California, Berkeley, the right-hander features a low-90s tailing fastball, alongside a mid-80s changeup and slider.

### WEEKEND WARRIORS

After struggling to finish series strong in the first half, Bowie has flipped the script as the summer has gone on. The Baysox posted a 16-18 record in the final three games of their series in the first half. With Saturday night's win over Altoona, Bowie has already matched that total in the second half of the season, going 16-7 in the back half of series.

### HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has had a stellar start at the Double-A level. Holliday has reached safely in 21 of 24 games at the new level. Wednesday night, he mashed his eighth triple overall on the season - the third-highest total in Minor League Baseball. This season, across three different levels, Holliday ranks top five in the Orioles' organization in batting average (3rd - .333), on-base percentage (1st - .452), slugging percentage (4th - .524), OPS (1st - .976), triples (1st - 8), and walks (1st - 76). Holliday's on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

### SWING IT LIKE SILAS!

C Silas Ardoyn has made a name for himself at the plate in Double-A so far with Bowie. After hitting just .215 through 68 games with High-A Aberdeen, Ardoyn is hitting .368 (14-for-38) after 11 games at the new level. Ardoyn is 6-for-12 this week, including the go-ahead RBI single on Friday night, with his second three-hit game at the level on Tuesday. Ardoyn already brings plenty of plate discipline and defensive versatility to the Baysox, joining Bowie with a walk rate of nearly 20% and a caught stealing rate of nearly 30% from behind the dish in his time with Aberdeen.

### ONE RUN REBOUND

The Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. The Baysox are 13-2 in their last 15 one-run games. Dating back to June 2, the Baysox have fared incredibly well in one-run games, going 17-5. Bowie is 23-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023 - the third-most one-run victories in Minor League Baseball, while playing in the third-most one-run games. The only Eastern League foe with a higher winning percentage in one-run games is Hartford (21-7 - .750). Last season, the Baysox were just 21-29 in such games, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games. 10 of the last 15 Baysox wins this season have been by a single run.

## 2022 NOTES

- Made his second straight Opening Day start on 4/8 at TB; became the first Orioles pitcher to start back-to-back Opening Days since RHP Chris Tillman started three straight from 2014-16, the second lefty to do so since Dave McNally started three consecutive from 1969-71, and the fourth O's left-hander to start multiple Opening Days in team history (since 1954) along with McNally, Steve Barber (1963, 65-66), and Mike Flanagan (1978, 86)
- Left his second start of the season on 4/13 vs. MIL with left forearm tightness; placed on the 10-day Injured List with a left elbow sprain on 4/14 and transferred to the 60-day Injured List with a left elbow strain on 4/17
- Underwent UCL reconstruction surgery (Tommy John) on 4/27, performed by Dr. Keith Meister, and missed the rest of the season

## PROFESSIONAL CAREER

**2021:** Threw the sixth no-hitter in Orioles history in a 6-0 victory on 5/5 at T-Mobile Park against the Mariners...Was the first Orioles no-hitter since a combined effort by Bob Milacki, Mike Flanagan, Mark Williamson, and Gregg Olson on 7/13/91 at OAK, and the first individual no-hitter by an Orioles pitcher since Jim Palmer on 8/13/69 vs. OAK...It was the first 9.0-inning complete game of his career, while he became the first left-handed pitcher to throw a no-hitter in Orioles history, and his 12 strikeouts were the most by an O's hurler in a no-hitter...Became the first Kansas-born pitcher to throw a no-hitter since Walter Johnson in 1920...The only base runner reached on a dropped third strike, wild pitch, and was later caught stealing by C Pedro Severino; according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Means was the first pitcher to throw a non-perfect no-hitter in which the opposing team did not record a walk, hit-by-pitch, or error...Became the second pitcher in AL history to throw a no-hitter with 12+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining Félix Hernández, who had a perfect game on 8/15/12...Threw 26-of-27 first-pitch strikes (96.3%), only missing on the 18<sup>th</sup> batter of the game with two outs in the sixth inning; the highest first-pitch strike percentage in a complete game since 1990...Became the only pitcher since Edinson Vázquez on 6/3/17 to face the minimum in a no-hitter and have it not be a perfect game; the last to do so with no walks or hit batters was Terry Mulholland on 8/15/1990...Named the American League Player of the Week on 5/10, the first Orioles winner since Trey Mancini on 9/23/19, and the first Orioles pitcher to accomplish the feat since Arthur Rhodes in August of 1994...Made his first career Opening Day start on 4/2 at Boston, becoming the 41<sup>st</sup> Opening Day starter in Orioles history...Became the first pitcher in Orioles history to work at least 7.0 innings while giving up one hit-or-less and not allowing a run in a start at Fenway Park...Became the 17<sup>th</sup> pitcher in Major League history, and first Oriole, to go at least 7.0 innings while allowing one hit-or-less in a start on Opening Day; he is the third pitcher in Major League history to do so without issuing a walk, joining Irv Young (1906) and Jordan Zimmermann (2019)...Joined Mike Mussina (5/30/97) and Jim Palmer (5/12/67) as one of three Orioles to throw at least 7.0 innings, allowing one hit-or-less, no runs, and no walks in a start...Tallied a career-high 12 quality starts, surpassing the 11 he made in 2019...According to *Baseball Reference*, his 1.6 WPA led the O's, 1.0 higher than the next closest pitcher on the club...Registered a career-long 19.0 scoreless innings streak from 5/5-19...Became the 12<sup>th</sup> pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 200 batters in the first 48 games of their career when he struck out Mark Canha on a foul tip in the fifth frame on 4/30 at OAK...Gave up a career-high 30 home runs, surpassing his total of 23 allowed in 2019; homers accounted for 45 of his 64 total runs allowed (70.3%)...Tallied the first extra-base hit of his career (2B) on 9/20 at PHI...It registered an exit velocity of 102.7 mph, tied for the second-hardest-hit ball by an O's pitcher in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) with Mike Wright, Jr. (1B) on 5/23/15, behind only a Yovani Gallardo 106.5 mph single on 6/29/16; first extra-base hit by an Orioles pitcher since Zack Britton (HR) on 7/31/11...Spent time on the 10-day Injured List with a left shoulder strain from 6/6-7/20 after being removed from his start on 6/5 vs. CLE in the first inning.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization.
