## LAST GAME

The Baysox rallied to take down the Altoona Curve 6-5 in 10 innings. A three-run home run from John Rhodes in the first got Bowie out to an early lead, but Altoona responded with the game's next four runs, eventually taking the lead in the fifth on an Eli Wilson solo home run. Max Wagner tied the game in the bottom half with an RBI double. After the Curve took the lead in the seventh on an error, Wagner came to the plate in the ninth to deliver his second game-tying RBI of the night to send the game to extra innings. In the tenth, Jud Fabian threw out the potential go-ahead run at the plate in the top half, before Rhodes scored on a wild pitch to clinch Bowie's seventh walk-off win of the season.

## **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Altoona Curve enter tonight with an overall record of 52-58. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the Curve are just 18-24 in the second half, last place in the Southwest division and six games out of a playoff spot. Overall, this season, Bowie is 10-12 against Altoona, including a series split at Prince George's Stadium in mid-May. The Curve's 893 strikeouts as a team this season are the fewest in Double-A and the fourth fewest in Minor League Baseball. Altoona's active roster is highlighted by four of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, consisting of LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5 PIT/No. 89 OVR), LHP Jackson Wolf (No. 14 PIT), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 22 PIT), and OF Matt Gorski (No.

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Sean Sullivan is set to take the ball this afternoon for Altoona. Sullivan's 86.1 innings are second-most on the Curve roster this season, but his 12 home runs allowed are also the second-highest total on the team, with right-handers hitting 10 of the 12. Sullivan took the win in Tuesday's series opener against Bowie, tossing 5.1 innings allowing two earned runs with five strikeouts. This season, against Bowie, Sullivan has gone 2-1 through four starts with a 3.54 ERA (8 ER in 20.1 IP). An 8th round draft pick of the Pirates in 2021 from the University of California, Berkeley, the right-hander features a low-90s tailing fastball, alongside a mid-80s changeup and slider.

## WEEKEND WARRIORS

After struggling to finish series strong in the first half, Bowie has flipped the script as the summer has gone on. The Baysox posted a 16-18 record in the final three games of their series in the first half. With Saturday night's win over Altoona, Bowie has already matched that total in the second half of the season, going 16-7 in the back half of series.

## HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has had a stellar start at the Double-A level. Holliday has reached safely in 21 of 24 games at the new level. Wednesday night, he mashed his eighth triple overall on the season - the third-highest total in Minor League Baseball. This season, across three different levels, Holliday ranks top five in the Orioles' organization in batting average (3rd - .333), on-base percentage (1st - .452), slugging per centage (4th - .524), OPS (1st - .976), triples (1st - 8), and walks (1st - 76). Holliday's on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

## SWING IT LIKE SILAS!

C Silas Ardoin has made a name for himself at the plate in Double-A so far with Bowie. After hitting just .215 through 68 games with High-A Aberdeen, Ardoin is hitting .368 (14-for-38) after 11 games at the new level. Ardoin is 6-for-12 this week, including the go-ahead RBI single on Friday night, with his second three-hit game at the level on Tuesday. Ardoin already brings plenty of plate discipline and defensive versatility to the Baysox, joining Bowie with a walk rate of nearly 20% and a caught stealing rate of nearly 30% from behind the dish in his time with Aberdeen

## **ONE RUN REBOUND**

The Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. The Baysox are 13-2 in their last 15 one-run games. Dating back to June 2, the Baysox have faired incredibly well in one-run games, going 17-5. Bowie is 23-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023 - the third-most one-run victories in Minor League Baseball, while playing in the third-most one-run games. The only Eastern League foe with a higher winning percentage in one-run games is Hartford (21-7 - .750). Last season, the Baysox were just 21-29 in such games, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games. 10 of the last 15 Baysox wins this season have been by a single run.

#### PROFESSIONAL CAREER

2021: Threw the sixth no-hitter in Orioles history in a 6-0 victory on 5/5 at T-Mobile Park against the Mariners...Was the first Orioles no-hitter since a combined effort by Bob Milacki, Mike Flanagan, Mark Williamson, and Gregg Olson on 7/13/91 at OAK, and the first individual no-hitter by an Orioles pitcher since Jim Palmer on 8/13/69 vs. OAK...It was the first 9.0-inning complete game of his career, while he became the first left-handed pitcher to throw a no-hitter in Orioles history, and his 12 strikeouts were the most by an O's hurler in a no-hitter...Became the first Kansas-born pitcher to throw a no-hitter since Walter Johnson in 1920... The only base runner reached on a dropped third strike, wild pitch, and was later caught stealing by C Pedro Severino; according to the Elias Sports Bureau, Means was the first pitcher to throw a non-perfect no-hitter in which the opposing team did not record a walk, hit-by-pitch, or error...Became the second pitcher in AL history to throw a no-hitter with 12+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining Félix Hernández, who had a perfect game on 8/15/12...Threw 26-of-27 first-pitch strikes (96.3%), only missing on the 18th batter of the game with two outs in the sixth inning; the highest first-pitch strike percentage in a complete game since 1990...Became the only pitcher since 2000 to face at least 25 batters in a game and have a higher first-pitch strike percentage was MIN's Brad Radke on 6/30/04 (27-of-28, 96.4%)...Recorded 26 swinging strikes (14 via the changeup, 8 via the four-seam fastball, 3 via the slider, and 1 via the curveball), the most in a game by an Orioles pitcher since pitch tracking began in 2008...Became the first pitcher since Edinson Volquez on 6/3/17 to face the minimum in a no-hitter and have it not be a perfect game; the last to do so with no walks or hit batters was Terry Mulholland on 8/15/1990...Named the American League Player of the Week on 5/10, the first Orioles winner since Trey Mancini on 9/23/19, and the first Orioles pitcher to accomplish the feat since Arthur Rhodes in August of 1994...Made his first career Opening Day start on 4/2 at Boston, becoming the 41<sup>st</sup> Opening Day starter in Orioles history... ## COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his widily and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sheman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his caching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
