CARDS RIDE LONGBALL, CRUISE TO VICTORY OVER SURGE: The

Cardinals hit 3 home runs and came within one of a season-high with 14 hits as Springfield defeated the Wichita Wind Surge 10-2 on Saturday evening at Hammons Field, the Cards' 10th win in their last 12 games. **Bryan Torres** led off the bottom of the 1st inning with his first home run of the season, **Chandler Redmond** added a 3-run shot in the 3rd, and **Mike Antico a** solo homer in the 7th. Torres fell a double shy of the cycle. **Torres, Antico** and **Nathan Church** each had three hits for the Birds, and **Brandon Komar** picked up the win with 6.0 scoreless innings in his first start of the season for Springfield.



DPPDSING STARTER: Right-hander **Andrew Morris** makes his 7th start (8th appearance) of the season for Wichita...Last pitched on Tuesday, July 2 at home against Tulsa and picked up the win with 6.1 scoreless innings allowing just 3 H while walking 3 and striking out 9...Made one start against the Cardinals on June 2 at Riverfront Stadium in Wichita and allowed just 1 R on 3 H over 6.0 IP with 3 K...The Cardinals won the game 6-2 with a late rally in the series finale...Began the season with High-A Cedar Rapids and went 3-1 with a 2.15 ERA over 7 starts...Racked up 73 K to just 7 BB over 37.2 IP...Split the 2023 season between Low-A Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids and went 8-2 with a 2.88 ERA over 18 appearances (17 starts)...Selected by the Twins in the 4th round of the 2022 draft out of Texas Tech...Served as the Red Raiders' Friday night starter in his only year in Lubbock going 8-2 with a 4.58 ERA...Began his college career at Division II Colorado Mesa University going 18-2 witha 3.23 ERA over 2 seasons, compiling 215 K's over 175.2 IP...22 years old

CARDS, SURGE SQUARE OFF FOR FINAL TIME AT HAMMONS FIELD: The Cardinals head into the All-Star break with a six-game series at home against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins), the final regular season meeting between the two in Springfield. The Cardinals swept a six-game series from Wichita in April at Hammons and come into the series 11-1 in the season series.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

EDMAN REHABBING IN SPRINGFIELD: St. Louis Cardinals utilityman **Tommy Edman** began his rehab assingment with Springfield on Tuesday night and is 2-for-6 with an RBI and 2 runs scored in two games. The 5-year veteran is recovering from right wrist surgery last October and has not played in a game yet this season. In 137 games with St. Louis in 2023, **Edman** batted .248 with 13 HR and 47 RBIs while going 27-for-31 in SB playing 2B, SS, CF and RF. He won a Gold Glove Award at 2B in 2021. **Edman** and the Cardinals agreed to a 2-year, \$16.5 million deal in January.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After dropping 4 of their first 5 games to start the 2nd half, the Cardinals have won 10 of their last 12 to run their 2nd-half record to 11-6. Over their last 12 games, the Cardinals are 2nd in the league in batting (.294) and 2nd in home runs with 14, trailing only Midland (21). The Cards are also 2nd in the league in runs during that stretch with 66 (6.3/game).

After dropping 11 of 12 at home, the Cardinals have gone 7-2 over their last 8 games at Hammons Field, lifting their home record to 21-24 (.455) overall. The Birds have the best road record in the Texas League at 27-14.

POWER SURGE: While the Cards have been on the wrong side of the home run ball during the 2024 season, Springfield has homered in each of their last 7 games and has outhomered their opponents 14-7 over their last 12 games. The Cardinals have slugged a season-high tying 3 homers in each of their last two games.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 14 games since June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of hte hottest bats in the Texas League. The former Oklahoma Sooner is batting .380 with 3 HR and a 14 RBIs during that time while also adding 3 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .660 and has a 1.106 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .866 OPS is tops in the circuit.

MATT LLOYD, RUN PRODUCER: With 5 RBIs in the series so far, Cardinals OF/DH Matt Lloyd has seen his name rise to the top of the league leaderboard in that category. Lloyd's 52 ribbies are 5 more than anyone else in the Texas League, leading Midland's Colby Thomas (47) who is now in Triple-A.

WELCOME BACK: After spending two and a half weeks in the injured list, **Noah Mendlinger** has picked up right where he left off in his return to Springfield. The Cards' utilityman is 6-for-14 in 3 games since his return, and going back to before his IL stint has hit safely in 6 straight games. **Mendlinger** went 3-for-13 during a 4-game rehab stint with Low-A Palm Beach.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: The 2024 season has been an up-and-down one for Cardinals OF **Nathan Church**. After busting out of the gates with a red-hot April that earned him Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month batting .349 with 3 HR and a .914 OPS, the former UC Irvine Anteater slowed down from the middle of May to the end of June, batting .179 with 0 HR and a .466 OPS in 31 games from May 23-June 30.

Since the calendar flipped to July, however, **Church's** bat has heated up again to the tune of a .316 clip with 2 HR in the month. Over his last 8 games, Church is batting .370 with an OPS of 1.082.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the all-time franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 223.


