#### ROUGHRIDERS SINK HOOKS BEHIND MIESES 9TH-INNING HOMER:

Luis Mieses homered in the top of the ninth inning to guide the Frisco RoughRiders to a 3-2 win over the Corpus Christi Hooks on Tuesday night from Whataburger Field. Corpus Christi (4-12) drew first blood in the top of the third when Colin Barber hit a sacrifice fly to give the Hooks a 1-0 lead. Frisco (11-5) then answered with two runs in the top of the third. Alejandro Osuna scored on a wild pitch, then Abimelec Ortiz blooped an RBI single to right, putting the Riders in front 2-1. In the bottom of the sixth, Corpus Christi's Ryan Wrobleski rolled an RBI infield single to tie the game. Mieses' ninth inning smash, his third of the season, gave the Riders a 3-2 lead. Then, in the bottom of the ninth, Frisco reliever Avery Weems struck out the side and retired the Hooks in order to record his first save of the season. Skylar Hales (1-1) earned the victory by tossing a scoreless bottom of the eighth inning. Hooks reliever Michael Knorr (0-1) took the loss after allowing Mieses' home run. Frisco starter Ryan Lobus picked up the no-decision, striking out three across two hitless innings. Corpus Christi starter Joey Mancini allowed two runs on five innings of work.

#### **LITTLE SEBASTIAN? BIG SEBASTIAN:**

Top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been off to an incredible start with the RoughRiders. The 19-year-old is the second-youngest player in the Texas League and has shown incredible patience. He is eighth in pitches seen and fifth in balls seen. His 17 percent walk rate is his highest in state-side baseball while his 24 percent strikeout rate is the lowest in his state-side career. During an nine-game hitting streak, he is hitting .313 (10-for-32)/.452/.531/.983 with four doubles, one home run, eight RBIs, nine walks, eight runs scored. In that streak, he has walked nine times while striking out just eight times.

#### FLYING THE COOP:

Cooper Johnson has started out well in 2025 on both offense and defense. At the plate, he is hitting .306/.432/.639/1.071 with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, eight walks and six runs scored. He is third in the Texas League in both SLG and OPS. On defense, Johnson leads the Texas League with seven caught stealings behind the plate, throwing out seven of nine base runners against him. His 78 percent caught-stealing rate is the best in MiLB currently.

#### WINNING CLOSE

The RoughRiders have been excellent in close games this season. In games decided by three runs or fewer, they 7-1 while they are tied for the league lead with seven saves this year. Their bullpen ERA of 3.59 is sixth in the Texas League.

#### POWER BRINGS WINS:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been amazing on offense during their first 16 games. Frisco's 18 home runs through 16 games are tops in the Texas League. They are second in BA (.269), second in SLG (.430) and second in OPS (.794). **Josh Hatcher, Cooper Johnson** and **Luis Mieses** have all hit three home runs, tied for the team lead. Over this stretch where they have won nine of their last 12 games, Frisco is hitting .273/.371/.455/.826 while also ranking second in runs per game (6.4) and first in home runs (15).

#### HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 12 of 13 games he's played in, batting .393 (22-for-56)/.390/.625/1.015 with four doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, a stolen base and nine runs scored over his first 13 games. His .393 batting average is 10th in all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has seven multi-hit games and is 6-for-9 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs.

#### **VERSUS THE HOOKS**:

The Riders dominated Corpus Christi last season, going 17-7 against the Hooks. This was in large part due to their dominance on the mound, owning a 3.01 ERA (71ER/212.0IP) in their 24 head-to-head meetings a year ago. Since 2021, the Riders are 48-34 against Corpus Christi despite their losing record against the Hooks in their franchise history (271-279).

#### **ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:**

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz clubbed his first two home runs of the season last week.

#### **ABOUT KOHL**

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

- -Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.
- -In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.
- -He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins. Knapp is now at UNC, but will miss the whole season with Tommy John Surgery.

#### 2025 SEASON

-Entered 2025 as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

#### 2024 SEASON

- -Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.
- -After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.
- -Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.
- -In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.
- -In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

#### 2023 SEASON

- -Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.
- -His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R,0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.
- -Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
