### NOTES AND NUGGETS

**STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE**

After an 0-4 start to the season, the Storm Chasers have won 7 of their last 9 games, with a series win last week at home against the Buffalo Bisons.

- Last season, the Storm Chasers won just 6 of 27 series played, only 2 series at home ... a win either today or tomorrow would give Omaha back-to-back series wins for the first time since
- This week, the Chasers have taken 3 of the first 4 from Iowa, with **Kameron Misner** and **John Rave** each recording 6 hits and 2 homers ... Misner has 15 total bases and 8 RBI while Rave has 14 total bases and 9 RBI.

### DOUBLE THE TROUBLE

Friday's doubleheader sweep in Des Moines marked the second time since 2005 the Storm Chasers have ever swept a doubleheader against Iowa and Omaha's first doubleheader sweep in nearly two years.

- The last instance of a doubleheader sweep in Iowa was on July 6, 2016 at Principal Park, when the Chasers won both games in extra innings ... after going 1-5 in doubleheader games last season - including being swept once by Iowa - Friday was Omaha's first doubleheader win since May 30, 2024 @ Indianapolis.
- John Rave** reached base all 5 times in Game 1 yesterday and added a double and sac fly RBI in Game 2, going 4-for-6 with 2 walks and 4 RBI across the twin bill ... the bullpen combined to throw 8.1 of the team's 16.0 innings yesterday, allowing 2 ER (2.16 ERA) with 3 walks to 11 strikeouts (3.67 K/BB & 11.88 K/9).
- Over the two games of the doubleheader, Omaha combined to go 8-for-10 (80%) in ABS challenges, while the Chasers and Cubs combined to go 14-for-17 (82%).

### CHALLENGING THE SYSTEM

The Omaha Storm Chasers have been the best team in Triple-A at converting ABS challenges in their favor in 2026.

- Omaha is tied with Indianapolis for the most ABS challenges of any Triple-A team this season (40), and has converted more of them than anyone - 27 successful challenges are the most in Triple-A, with a 68% win rate that ranks tied 3rd.
- The Storm Chasers' success is driven largely by how selective their catchers have been ... **Elias Diaz** and **Luca Tresh** have challenged at a 3.5% rate, tied for the 5th-lowest among all 30 Triple-A clubs, yet have won 17 of 25 defensive challenges (68%), combining for 6 strikeout flips and 4 walk flips.
- At the plate, Omaha hitters have challenged at a moderate 4.8% rate and converted 10 of 15 (67%), with 7 of the team's 10 challengers going a perfect 1-for-1.

### MISNER ON A MISSION

Outfielder **Kameron Misner** has been the heart of Omaha's offense to open the 2026 season.

- Misner has the longest active hitting streak in the International League, having hit safely in 11 consecutive games (March 28-April 10), going 13-for-37 (.351) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 14 runs batted in ... he has reached base safely in all 12 games he has appeared in this season and his 14 RBI rank tied for the league lead.
- Misner has driven in runs in 6 straight contests, a stretch (April 4-10) where he is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with 10 RBI ... he homered the first two games of this series.

### CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

Through 13 games, the Omaha Storm Chasers own the best fielding percentage in the International League at .989, committing just 5 errors in 13 games ... that mark is 2nd-best among all 30 Triple-A clubs, trailing only Round Rock (.991).

- The clean play extends throughout the roster - of Omaha's 13 qualified fielders at a single position in the IL this season (min. 30.0 inn), 10 have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, with just three players charged with an error ... **Kevin Newman** and **Abraham Toro** have each played 67.0 errorless innings at shortstop and first base respectively, while **Luca Tresh** (catcher), **Kameron Misner** (left/center field) and **Peyton Wilson** (second/third base) have all been flawless in the field as well.
- Toro has also been a reliable anchor in the infield, turning 8 double plays at first base - tied for 2nd-most among first basemen in the International League.

- STARTER'S ORDERS:** Ramsey made just two spot starts last year for Omaha, but cracked the Storm Chasers' Opening Day roster ... when he opened last year in Double-A, his first appearance came as a "piggyback" pitcher behind starter Hunter Owen ... in 2024, his first 4 outings of the year came in relief.
- Y2K ROTATION:** Ramsey is one of five players on the Chasers' active roster, and one of three starting pitchers that were born in 2001, however he is the oldest of the five ... he's approximately 7 months older than Luinder Avila (born 8/21/01).

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, APRIL 5 VS. BUFFALO

- After starting Omaha's home opener in the series opener with Buffalo, entered the series finale as the "piggyback" pitcher behind starter Ben Kudrna ... earned the win while working 5.0 innings of 1-run relief, one out shy of tying his longest career relief outing ... entered in the top of the 3rd inning, working a 1-2-3 inning in the 4th ... allowed an RBI single in the 5th, but worked scoreless 6th and 7th innings.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 1 Cactus League game with the Royals while up from Minor League camp, working 1.0 scoreless inning ... opened the 2026 season on the Storm Chasers' roster.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025**
- Began the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and spent most of the year in Double-A, although he made a pair of spot starts for Omaha throughout the year ... posted a 5.54 ERA (65 ER in 105.2 IP) in 25 appearances (18 starts) at Double-A ... his 114 strikeouts between NWA and Omaha tied with Shane Panzini for the Royals organization lead.
  - Pitched to a 3.73 ERA (17 ER in 41.0 IP) over his first 9 appearances (7 starts) from April 9 to May 31 which included a 5.2-inning, 5-strikeout, scoreless performance May 18 @ Tulsa (LAD).
  - Made his first Double-A start on April 15 @ San Antonio (SD), throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit ball to start what became the fourth no-hitter in Nationals history ... relievers Chazz Martinez, Ryan Brady & Brandon Johnson finished it off ... was NWA's third combined no-no, the first no-hitter since Brooks Pounders threw one in 2013.
  - Was transferred to Omaha on April 30 and made his Triple-A debut on May 1 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) ... returned to the Nationals on May 2, then transferred back to Omaha after the Double-A season ended for a start on September 19 @ Columbus (CLE).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+), splitting time between the bullpen and as a starter ... appeared in 22 games (11 starts) with a 2.43 ERA (24 ER in 89.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts to 30 walks (3.23 K/BB) at High-A ... had a career-high 25.2-inning scoreless streak from July 25 to August 27, the River Bandits' longest scoreless streak in their Royals-affiliate era (since 2021).
- Largely split 2023 between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), but also made 2 rehab appearances (1 start) with the ACL Royals (R) ... pitched to a 0.54 ERA (2 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts across 7 starts with Columbia before earning a promotion to Quad Cities ... made 5 appearances (2 starts) at High-A with 22 strikeouts in 14.1 innings (13.8 K/9) ... set a fireflies record with a 24.0-inning scoreless streak from April 21 to July 29, spanning 5 outings and stints on the Development List and Injured List.
- Made his professional debut in 2022 with the ACL Royals (Rk) after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the 2022 MLB Draft ... pitched in 1 game in the ACL that season, a scoreless, 2.0-inning relief appearance with 3 strikeouts against the ACL Diamondbacks Red (AZ).

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (2020-22) for the University of Maryland (Big Ten), working a career 17-2 record with a 3.13 ERA (47 ER in 135.0 IP) and 140 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.41 K/BB) for the Terrapins ... named 2022 First Team All-Big Ten and 2021 Second Team All-Big Ten ... in 2022, went 11-1 with a 3.22 ERA (33 ER in 92.1 IP) and 90 strikeouts to 41 walks (2.20 K/BB) across 16 appearances (15 starts).
- Threw a 9.0-inning perfect game for the University of Maryland on April 29, 2022 against Northwestern.
- Was drafted by Cleveland in the 36th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Pascack Hills High School but elected not to sign and instead attend the University of Maryland.
