## SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (21-13, 64-39) vs. SAN ANTONIO MISSIONS (16-18, 55-48) RHP BRANDT THOMPSON (0-0, -.-- ERA) vs. RHP VICTOR LIZARRAGA (2-8, 6.86 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** Springfield continues its time in San Antonio with the 2nd game of a 6-game series vs. the Missions (SD) and 6-game road trip ... are 0-1 in the series ... is 1st matchup between the clubs this season ... Missions will visit Hammons Field during the season's final week to wrap up the 12-game season series ... SGF is coming off a 4-2 series win vs. ARK ... sitting in 1st place in the North Division 2nd Half standings, 2.0 games ahead of ARK.

**BEAR WITH US:** RHP Brandt Thompson makes his Springfield and Double-A debut tonight ... 1st-year pro joined club from Peoria (A+) on 8/5 ... appeared in 2 games with Peoria and 16 games with Palm Beach (A) this season ... combined for 2-7 record and 3.96 ERA over 88.2 IP this season ... former Missouri St. Bear was All-MVC 1st Team in junior and senior seasons.

**FACING LIZARRAGA:** RHP Victor Lizarraga faces SGF for the 1st time ... 21-year-old is 2-8 with a 6.86 ERA in 19 games (17 GS) in his 2nd season in Texas League ... in 2 starts vs. SGF last year allowed 10 runs over 6.1 IP (14.21 ERA).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Cardinals saw their 4-0 lead evaporate late in the game and dropped the series opener, 5-4, in San Antonio ... Missions scored 4 runs to tie in the 7th ... tied for the biggest blown lead in a loss for Cards this season ... IF Trey Paige hit a 2-run HR early in the contest and C Leonardo Bernal added a RBI-double ... RHP Andrew Marrero and RHP Luis Gastelum (L, BS) combined to allow 5 runs (4 ER) over the final 2 innings.

**TEXAS PETE:** Former Texas Longhorn LHP Pete Hansen dazzled over 6.1 IP in his start in the series-opener ... allowed only 3 runners to reach base on 2 hits and 1 walk ... recorded his team-leading 9th QS and has pitched at least 5.0 IP in 13 of his last 14 outings ... ranks 6th in TXL with a 3.69 ERA and 4th with 102.2 IP.

**MAUTZ'S MONTH:** LHP Brycen Mautz was named the TXL Pitcher of the Month for July ... went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA (4ER/23.0IP) over 5 starts ... allowed 1-or-fewer ERA in all 5 outings ... struck out 28, walked 5, and allowed only 16 hits.

**WE MESS WITH TEXAS:** The Cardinals are 25-6 vs. South Division opponents this season including a 16-3 record in games played in the Lone Star State ... Tuesday's loss snapped an 11-game win streak vs. Texas clubs.

**SHUFFLING CARDS:** RHP Randel Clemente, RHP Hunter Hayes, RHP Brandt Thompson, and C Graysen Tarlow all joined the Springfield roster from Peoria (A+) on Tuesday ... Thompson will debut as a starter Wednesday while Clemente and Hayes join the bullpen ... Tarlow will join the club's catching corps joining C Leonardo Bernal and C Carlos Linarez ... LHP Nathanael Heredia and C Wade Stauss were released by St. Louis and IF RJ Yeager was put on the Developmental List.
