SUNDAY: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (27-29) fell to the Tulsa Drillers (37-20), 7-6, in the completion of the suspended game from Saturday night, and 7-1 in seven innings on Sunday afternoon at HODGETOWN. Saturday night's contest was suspending in the bottom of the second with the Soddies down by two. They resumed Sunday afternoon and found themselves down 4-1, but rallied back with a five-run fifth inning that featured home runs from Ben McLaughlin and Manuel Pena to take a two-run lead. Down to their last strike in the ninth however, Mike Sirota belted a go-ahead three-run homer the opposite way for Tulsa, tagging Amarillo with the 7-6 loss. In game two, Amarillo scored first on a Jansel Luis double in the first inning. It would be the only tally of the game for the Soddies however as the Drillers posted seven unanswered runs in the seven-inning contest. With the pair of losses on Sunday, Tulsa took five-of-six games from Amarillo over the homestand.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES: Drew Jones' 12-game on-base streak came to an end Sunday...in those games (5/21-6/6), he batted .310 (13x42) with 7 runs, 5 stolen bases and a .408 OBP.

RISP AND REWARD: With runners in scoring position, the Soddies are batting .339 with a .947 OPS since May 22...from Opening Day through May 21, the Soddies were posting a .240 AVG and .741 OPS.

NEW BLOOD: Making his first career start as a Sod Poodle tomorrow morning (6/10) will be Arizona's 26th ranked prospect, Junior Sanchez.

SUMMARY

- Selected in the D-backs in the 12th round (362nd overall) of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Southport High School in Indianapolis, IN...agreed to a \$922,500 signing bonus.
- Signed a one-year contract with Arizona in the 2025-26 offseason after fulfilling six years of minor league service.

LAST TIME OUT

- Although he allowed a season-high eight hits and Tulsa was able to reach base in all five innings with Short on the mound, the southpaw bent but rarely broke as he held the high-powered Drillers offense to just one run.
- Lowered his ERA for the season to 3.46 (16 ER/41.2 IP)...Although Short hasn't logged quite enough innings to be considered a qualified player, his ERA ranks fifth among Texas League pitchers who have tossed at least 41 innings in 2026 as of June 6.

SHORT END OF THE STICK

- Was charged with nine unearned runs between his two starts on May 9 and May 16...he had 11 total in 21 outings with the Sod Poodles in 2025.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- Short has enjoyed his time away from the hitter-friendly confines of HODGETOWN in 2026...his 1.88 ERA in five road starts is the best mark in the TL (min. 5 GS).

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Began 2025 in Amarillo and had a strong month of May, going 2-1 in five starts with a 1.17 WHIP, tallying three quality starts.
- Put together two more quality starts to begin June before his promotion to Triple-A Reno on June 15.
- Made one start with the Aces before being sent down to Amarillo and would be placed on the injured list shortly after.
- Threw a gem on July 18, shutting out the San Antonio Missions over seven frames on one hit, walking and hitting one batter each in his longest outing of the season.
- Eight of his 22 starts were quality starts.
- In 21 starts with the Soddies in 2025, he allowed one run or fewer in nine of them.

A-VERY NICE 2024

- Had a breakout campaign where he got off to a hot start at the beginning of the season with High-A Hillsboro...through his first nine appearances (eight starts), he went 2-3 with a 1.69 ERA (9 ER/48.0 IP), 1.15 WHIP and 31 strikeouts.
- Three of his final four starts in this stretch saw him tally seven or more innings pitched.
- Tossed 7.2 innings of one-hit shutout ball on May 23 against Vancouver (Toronto Blue Jays), fanning eight batters in the contest.
- Threw eight shutout innings in is next start on May 30 against Eugene (San Francisco Giants), setting a new career-long start that he has yet to
