LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones earned a series split with a 7-3 win at Aberdeen on Sunday afternoon...1B Mateo Gil collected 2 hits, including a go-ahead 2-run double in the 7th...DH Drake Osborn added a 2-run single in the 8th...C Kevin Parada added a pair of knocks and a 2-run home run in the 9th...CF Luis Valdez garnered 3 hits and 2 RBI for Aberdeen...2B Frederick Bencosme collected 2 base-hits and 2 stolen bases... Brooklyn used 6 different pitchers in the victory...LHP Eli Ankeney tossed 2 spotless inings for the win...RHP Paul Gervase earned a hold, stranding the tying and go-ahead runs on-base in the 7th.

NEW TO THE BOARDWALK: Brooklyn made a series of roster moves prior to Tuesday's series opener...RHP Joey Lancellotti and INF Junior Tilien joined the squad from Single-A St. Lucie...OF Abraham Almonte was added to the roster on a minor league rehab assingment...INF César Berbesi and RHP Kolby Kubichek were placed on the 7-day injured list...Lancellotti has tallied a 2.57 ERA (2 ER in 7.0) with a swe for St. Lucie in June and holds a 5.18 ERA (14 ER in 24.1 IP) with 29 strikeouts for the entire campaign...Tilien slashed .251/.339/.417 with a .756 OPS in 57 games...The 20-year-old had 22 extra-base hits, 6 home runs, and 32 RBI...Almonte has appeared in 11 Mil.B games in 2023 between St. Lucie and Triple-A Syracuse...The 33-year-old is 4-for-32 at the plate (.125) with 2 home runs and 4 RBI.

LOVE THE DRAKE!: C Drake Osborn posted a career-best performance in Saturday's win at Aberdeen...The 24-year-old tallied a professional-high-tying 3 hits and collected his 1st career multi-home run game...Osborn added a season-best 4 RBI, as well...His 1st 3-hit night came on April 30, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie vs. Daytona...The multi-home run performance was the first by a Cyclone since RF Alex Ramírez blasted two long balls on July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...Osborn is the first 'Clone to record 2+home runs, 3+ hits, and 4+ RBI in a single game since DH Brett Baty (3/4, 2 HR, 4 RBI) accomplished the feat on June 3, 2021, at Jersey Shore...3 of Osborn's 1st 4 hits have been home runs and 4 of his last 6 have left the ballpark, as well...He holds a 133 wRC+ and .382 ISO since being reinstated from the injured list on June 2...Osborn is tied for the team lead in home runs with 6...This is despite having 40 fewer plate appearances than INF Mateo Gil (6 HR/131 PA), 56 fewer than OF Stanley Consuegra (5 HR/147 PA), 151 fewer than OF Alex Ramírez (5 HR/242 PA) and C Kevin Parada (5 HR/242 PA).

MATEO MASH: INF Mateo Gil has been a key contributor on offense dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .256/.330/.524 and he has registered an impressive .854 OPS, 129 wRC+, .381 wOBA, and .268 ISO in that time...Gil is 21-for-91 at the plate (.256) with 13 runs scored, 7 doubles, 5 home runs, and 18 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for 2nd in the league lead in home runs (5) ...He is also tied for 4th in extra-base hits (12), tied for 6th in RBI (18), and 7th in slugging percentage (.524).

BLADE RUNNER: RHP Blade Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old registered a career-high 7.0 innings of shutout ball, earning the win on Saturday night at Aberdeen...Tidwell is the first Cyclone to post 7+ innings in a shutout victory since RHP Jeffrey Colón did the same in a 3-0 win at Winston-Salem on September 9, 2022...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts in his previous start last Sunday vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 6 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 3-0 with a 1.32 ERA (4 ER in 27.1 IP) with just 13 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 22 and struck out 39 (12.84 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 34.2% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .141 batting average (13-92) against him...Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (141) and 4th in ERA (1.32) since that date (min. 25.0 IP)...He is also tied for 5th in strikeouts (39).

DINKY DONUTS: RHP Blade Tidwell (7.0 IP) and RHP Dylan Tebrake (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 5-0 win at Aberdeen on Saturday night...That marked the Cyclones' 1st donut of an opponent since an 8-0 victory at Jersey Shore on May 30...Tidwell (3.2 IP) also started that night...RHP Jace Beck (2.1), RHP Brendan Hardy (1.2), RHP Michael Krauza (0.1), and RHP Joshua Cornielly (1.0) also united on a 5-hit blanking of the BlueClaws...The 'Clones have accumulated 5 shutouts through the first 62 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 9 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 1.23 ERA (2 ER in 14.2 IP) on 5 hits and 6 walks, registering 24 strikeouts (14.73 K/9)...That equates to a 42.9 K% (24/56).

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023... Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.27) in the entire South Atlantic League and 2nd-best among all High-A teams...The Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids leads (3.16) lead the classification...Hudson Valley (3.32) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 3rd best in all of Mil.B...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads Mil.B (3.03).

TY-NAMIC: RHP Tyler Stuart tossed 6.0 innings of 1-run ball on Friday night and is as imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in 46.1.47)... The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (88.2%) and FIP (2.89), 5th in xFIP (3.36), 8th in batting average against (.218) and strikeout rate (30.0%), 9th in strikeouts per 9 innings (10.96), and 10th in WHIP (1.15) and innings pitched (55.0).

OH YEAH, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has picked up steam at the plate in June... The 23-year-old tallied a season-high-tying 3 hits in Wednesday's win over the Iron-Birds and added 2 more knocks on Thursday...Omar was 7-for-20 (.350) in the series with 2 extra-base hits and 3 RBI...Since the beginning of the month, De Los Santos is batting .295 (18-61) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 9 RBI, and 7 stolen bases...The right-handed swinger is tied for 4th in the SAL in stolen bases (7) and tied for 7th in hits (18) during June...Additionally, De Los Santos has added 25 stolen bases in 2022 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 12-game homestand, starting with 6 contests against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF Spencer Jones (7), RHP Drew Thorpe (8), and C Antonio Gómez (29)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21...The Cyclones went 4-2 in the set, taking 4-straight games from May 17 until Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...The Cyclones are 130-136 (.489) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 95 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (103), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (99), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (98), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (97), and Mariners prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (96), and have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 55 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 40...Omar is already 7 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

D'ANDRE DELIVERS: 2B **D'Andre Smith** set a career-high with 4 hits in Brooklyn's victory over Aberdeen on Wednesday...The 22-year-old also added 2 RBI and 2 stolen bases in the win...Since being reinstated from the injured list before the last homestand vs. Greenville, Smith is 12-for-33 (.364) at the plate in 9 games...The former USC Trojan has added 2 doubles, 3 RBI, 2 walks, and 3 stolen bases...Smith has also registered at least 1 hit in 8-of-his-9 games played.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26..1B Chase Estep delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramírez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year... Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...In addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after Friday's loss at Aberdeen...22.6% (14-of-62) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 25.7% (9-of-35) of all defeats...38.7% (24-of-62) have been determined by just 1 run, including 6 of the team's last 8 affairs.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief last Friday evening vs. Greenville and added another 2 more scoreless frames out of the bullpen at Aberdeen on Tuesday and Thursday...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase has the league's lowest ERA (1.26)...Gervase averages 13.81 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 341% strikeout rate.

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP Wilkin Ramos has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023... The 22-year-old tossed 3.2 innings of spotless work on Thursday night at Aberdeen... Over his last 2 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 6.2 innings, allowing only 3 hits and 1 walk, striking out 7...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.58 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 29.2% strikeout rate with a 10.0% walk rate.

CROWN PRINCE OF CONEY ISLAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Tuesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (196), at-bats (642), plate appearances (769), runs scored (99), walks (106), and stolen bases (47)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio (21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (67) on May 23 and is 2 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (197), 4th in home runs (16), and tied for 4th in hits (116).

JEFF JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón did not receive a decision after permitting 1 earned run (2 total) over 4.1 innings on Thursday at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 5 appearances (4 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 1.96 ERA (5 ER in 23.0 IP), allowing 17 hits and 10 walks, striking out 24...In his last 3 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 18.2 innings, allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 13 hits... The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 1.93 ERA and permitted only 6 walks and punched out 20 in that span.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: After dropping Saturday's twinbill to Greenville, Brooklyn dropped to 1-9 in doubleheader games in 2023...4-of-5 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...This year, the 'Clones are 25-26 in regularly scheduled 9-in-ning games.
