**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn began the new season with an impressive 8-4 victory over Wilmington on Friday night...RHP **Noah Hall** earned his first win of the 2025 season - and first win of his pro career - courtesy of 5.0 innings of 1-run ball...3B **Jacob Reimer** put together a multi-hit performance, logging a 2-for-5 night with a triple, 3 RBI and a run scored, while C **Chris Suero** launched the first Cyclones home run of 2025, a solo shot in the 7th...Additionally, DH **Carson Benge** reached four times in his Cyclones debut, walking thrice and belting a double to left field in the sixth...RHPs **Eduardo Herrera** and **Ryan Lambert** closed out the evening with scoreless frames in the 8th and 9th.

**OPENING DAY SUCCESS:** After Friday's victory over Wilmington, Brooklyn improved its all time record in season openers to 16-8 all-time in the first game of the season, while improving to 18-5 all-time in home openers...The Cyclones have now won their last 4 home openers dating back to the 2022 season...Brooklyn began the campaign at Maimonides Park for the first time since 2023, which saw the Cyclones beat the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings on a 3B **Chase Estep** bases-loaded walk...The 'Clones opened up 2024 at Wilmington, and dropped the contest, 4-1, before being swept in the 3-game set...his season marked the 12th time Brooklyn played its first game of the season at home...Sure enough, the Cyclones have followed the model set by their parent club, the Mets, who also have an outstanding track record on Opening Day...Even with a loss at Houston to open this season, New York is still 41-24 all-time in season openers, which checks in as the best winning percentage in all of the big leagues.

**THE LONG HALL:** RHP **Noah Hall** spun his best career pro outing on Opening Day for Brooklyn...The 2023 draftee picked up the win, thanks to 5.0 innings of 1-run ball...Hall surrendered only three hits, and gave up just one run...The right-hander also punched out 3 batters and walked 4...The University of South Carolina product became not only the first player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days...Last year, Hall was placed on the IL on April 26th and did not pitch again until September 7th with Single-A St. Lucie.

**REIM TIME:** After being limited to just 25 games in 2024 due to injury, INF **Jacob Reimer** started 2025 in a massive way...The 21-year-old provided a 2-run single in the 4th and an RBI triple in the 8th...Reimer's 3 RBI night marked the most runs batted in by a Cyclone on Opening Day since SS **César Berbesi** brought home 3 runs in a 9-8 win vs. Jersey Shore on April 7, 2023...Since 2005, Reimer, Berbesi, and 4 others are tied for franchise record for RBI on Opening Day.

**SUPER SUERO:** C **Chris Suero** picked up where he left off in the 2024 season on Opening Day...The 21-year-old collected a run-scoring single in the 4th and a solo home run in the 7th...Suero's blast on Opening Day was just the 8th home run by Brooklyn in the season opener since 2005...The Bronx native was the first Cyclone to go deep on Opening Day since C **Hayden Senger** hit a solo shot on May 4, 2021, at Asheville...Suero is the first Brooklyn player to homer on Opening Day in Coney Island since 1B **Joe Genord** cracked a solo blast on June 14, 2019, vs. Staten Island.

**BOARDWALK BENGEE:** OF **Carson Benge** started his 2025 on the right foot thanks to a keen eye at the plate in the season opener...The 2024 first-round draftee by the Mets made Wilmington pitchers work, drawing 3 free passes and clanging a double off the left-field fence...5 of Benge's 15 hits with Single-A St. Lucie went for extra base hits at the tail end of last year...The Yukon, Okla. native clubbed 2 home runs and 3 doubles in the Florida State League.

**2024 IN REVIEW:** Although the Cyclones did not qualify for the postseason last year, 2024 saw a bevy of achievements on the boardwalk...Numerous franchise records were set, including the all time games played, hits and stolen base records, in addition to the single season hits and stolen base records being set...The 2024 'Clones tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history thanks to a combined effort, and six players appeared in Brooklyn on big league rehab assignments.

**BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS:** After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March

**vs. WILMINGTON:** The Cyclones kick start the 2025 season against the Blue Rocks...Wilmington is coming off a 57-75 finish in 2024, good for last place in the North Division of the SAL...The Blue Rocks boast six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Nationals prospects, including SS **Seaver King** (4), LHP **Alex Clemmey** (5), C **Caleb Lomavita** (8), LHP **Jackson Kent** (20), OF **Elijah Green** (24) and OF **Brenner Cox** (30)...2025 marks the second straight year Brooklyn and Wilmington open up against one another...The Blue Rocks swept the 3-game set last year in Delaware.

27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

**GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK:** Cyclones manager **Gilbert Gómez** embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33 year old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls... Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** 21 players on the Cyclones break camp roster have previous playing experience in Brooklyn...Notables include: INF **Boston Baro** who played in 11 games with Brooklyn towards the end of last season...INF **Jacob Reimer** suited up in 39 games for the 'Clones over the last 2 years...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had a hand in the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last year...RHP **Ben Simon** logged 22 appearances, the most amongst any returning pitcher outside of Hawkins.

**NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK:** Seven members of the Mets' 2024 draft class will begin the 2025 campaign with the Cyclones...RHP **Ryan Lambert** is the lone '24 draftee that returns to the Brooklyn roster, while 1st round selection OF **Carson Benge**, 2nd round pick LHP **Jonathan Santucci** and 4th rounder OF **Eli Serrano III** all will make their High-A debuts...RHP **Brendan Girton**, RHP **R.J. Gordon** & INF **Nick Roselli** round out the class.

**ROSELLI RAKES:** INF **Nick Roselli** is slated to make his Cyclones debut this weekend...The 2024 Mets draftee grew up 34 miles northeast of Maimonides Park in Long Island's Levittown...The 11th round pick played his college ball at Binghamton University, where he was a career .349 hitter for the Bearcats...The Division HS product grew up a huge Mets fan, and was considered to have the "Best Pro Debut" of any member of the 2024 Mets draft class by *Baseball America*...Roselli hit the ground running last year in the Florida State League, notching an .869 OPS across 18 games with Single-A St. Lucie.

**KEEP IT IN THE BALLPARK!:** With so much of Brooklyn's pitching staff returning from last year, it's worth noting that Cyclones pitchers led the South Atlantic League by a wide margin in home runs allowed (59)...Hudson Valley was the next closest (78)...Of the 59 long balls permitted, only 20 of them came at Maimonides Park...Over the last two seasons, Brooklyn arms have surrendered just 55 home runs in 132 home games.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On April 5, 2024 - this date, last year - the Cyclones opened the 2024 season with a 4-1 loss at Wilmington...The contest marked the earliest game by date in franchise history at the time, until yesterday's 2025 season opener on April 4.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** Brooklyn's Opening Day Roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 7 of the Mets Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernandez** (27)...Of those seven, four have previous experience playing in Brooklyn.

**OKLAHOMA! ON BROADWAY:** Girton is one of three Oklahoma natives on the Cyclones' Opening Day roster...Girton (Gage, Okla.) joins RHP **Jace Beck** (Tuttle, Okla.) and OF **Carson Bengue** (Yukon, Okla.) as Sooner State natives with Brooklyn.

**BOOMER SOONER:** Girton spent the 2024 collegiate season at the University of Oklahoma...Girton grew up about 177 miles northwest of the university in Gage, Okla... Corralled an 0-1 record with a 7.32 ERA (29 ER in 35.2 IP), 1 save, 44 hits, 31 walks, and 47 strikeouts in 16 appearances (10 starts) for the Sooners...In first outing as a Sooner, went 4.0 innings and surrendered 1 run on 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in a win vs. No. 9 Tennessee on 2/17...Tossed 4.0 innings of 1-hit ball with 2 strikeouts in a win at TCU on 3/16...Started and struck out a pair in 2 postseason appearances vs. Kansas (5/24) and vs. UConn (6/2).

**RED RAIDER NATION:** The 23-year-old started his college career at Texas Tech University...During his 3 years with the Red Raiders, Girton compiled a 7-2 record with a 5.21 ERA (54 ER in 93.1 IP), 1 save, 77 hits, 57 walks, and 77 strikeouts in 42 outings (9 starts)...Named to the All-Big 12 Academic Second Team in 2023...Named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on 2/20/23 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen on Opening Day vs. Gonzaga...Had his 2022 season cut short due to injury.
