FRES-NOTES

THACH ME IF YOU CAN: Tanner Thach heads to San Jose leading the California League in hits (37) and RBI (33), while sitting tied for first in doubles (11). He also ranks second in total bases (60), second in extra-base hits (15), sixth in average (.339), eighth in slugging (.550) and sixth in OPS (.964).

RUNS IN THE FAMILY: Fresno enters the series with three of the league's top six run scorers: Cam Nelson ranks second with 26, Roldy Brito is third with 25, and Derek Bernard is tied for sixth with 22. The Grizzlies have scored 189 runs, fourth-most in the California League.

BULL-PEN PAL: Seth Clausen and Angel Jimenez have both climbed into the league's strike-out leaderboard with 27 punchouts apiece, tied for fifth in the California League. Clausen has done it out of the bullpen with a 1.32 ERA, two saves, and a .111 opponent average over 13.2 innings.

GIANT TEST AHEAD: Fresno opens the set against a San Jose club that leads the California League in runs (198), average (.292), OBP (.387), slugging (.467) and OPS (.854). The Grizzlies counter with 33 home runs, 147 walks and an .801 OPS, giving this series plenty of offensive punch on both sides.

BAY WATCHING THE COUNT: The Grizzlies bring one of the league's most disciplined approaches into San Jose, ranking second in the California League with 147 walks and posting a .367 on-base percentage (4th). Cameron Nelson (24 BB, 2nd in CAL) and Ethan Holliday (17 BB, T-8th) continue to set the tone, helping Fresno grind out at-bats against a Giants staff that has issued just 113 walks – fewest in the league – setting up a strength-on-strength battle at the plate.
