- The Sky Carp fell 5-4 in a 10-inning heartbreaker on Friday night at Classic Park.
- For the third straight game, Beloit scored first, thanks to a second inning Ynmanol Marinez RBI single.
- Lake County took a 2-1 lead in the third as Chase DeLauter picked up a 2-RBI double.
- In the fifth, Beloit pushed the see-saw back their way, as Davis Bradshaw ripped a game tying solo homer and Torin Montgomery followed suit to put the Carp in front 3-2.
- Following DeLauter's double, Beloit starter Alex Williams didn't allow any more damage and finished his 5-inning outing with 6 strikeouts.
- Lake County swung the game back in their favor late, using an unearned run to tie it in the seventh and a Dayan Frias solo homer in the eighth to take the lead.
- In the ninth, Bradshaw delivered his second longball of the game to knot the contest at four with the Sky Carp down to their final two outs. With the shot, Bradshaw became the first Sky Carp hitter to have a multi-homer game this
- After a scoreless ninth from Cristian Charle, Beloit failed to score their automatic runner in the 10th. Charle returned for the 10th and retired the first two batters. Then, Nate Furman flared a liner to left that narrowly escaped the grasp of Bradshaw to end the game.

BASHING BRADSHAW

With his two home run performance last night, Davis Bradshaw became the first Sky Carp to have a multi-homer game this season. With the two longballs, Bradshaw boosted his league-leading batting average to .328. Interestingly, Beloit's last multi-homer game also came at Classic Park, when Cody Morissette belted three on June 17, 2022.

SECOND HALF SWINGING

Beloit's .273 batting average in the second half is tops in the Midwest League. Their .770 OPS ranks 2nd, behind Fort Wayne's .791 mark. Through 28 games, the team is averaging 5.6 runs per game and 10 hits per game. In the first half, the Sky Carp averaged 4 runs and 7.4 hits per game.

OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS...

In the Sky Carp's three losses this week, the team has gone a combined 2-21 with runners in scoring position, including a 1-10 mark last night. Beloit stranded its automatic runner on second base in the 10th and left six runners in scoring position throughout the game.

FLY AWAY. BALL!

With the team's three homers last night, the Sky Carp tied a season high for homers in a game, and have now homered in five straight contests. Beloit has homered 28 times in the second half through 28 games. In the first half, the Sky Carp went yard 38 times in 65 games.

NICE AND CLOSE

18 of Beloit's first 28 games in the second half have been decided by 3 or fewer. The Sky Carp have gone 10-8 in those contests. The Sky Carp's record in games decided by three or fewer is 27-25.

STAYING UP LATE

In each of Beloit's last 13 wins, the team has scored at least one run in the seventh inning or later. Tanner Allen's 2-run double in the seventh inning Wednesday gave Beloit insurance in a 3-run win.

HE'S GOT THE JUICE

Osiris Johnson extended his hit streak to 8 games last night - marking Beloit's longest active streak and third longest active streak in the Midwest League. Johnson (nicknamed OJ, or Juice) is in the midst of his best month as a pro, hitting .310 in July

THE BIG (FIRST) THREE

The Sky Carp have allowed at least one run in the first three innings in 12 of their last 14 games. Of Beloit's 511 runs allowed this season, 39% (201) have come in the first three innings. When the Sky Carp keep the opponent scoreless through 3, they are 20-6.

Beloit will spend their entire 12 game road trip in the state of Ohio, marking the team's only two-week road trip of the 2023 season. The Sky Carp's 460 mile trip to Eastlake from ABC Supply Stadium marks their longest road trip by distance of the season.
