DAILY SPECIALS

SIX GAME SKID: The Spartanburgers are trying to snap their longest losing streak of the season. Hub City dropped its final four to Greensboro to lose the series and have started 0-2 at Greenville. Hub City had a spot in first place in the South Division prior to the losing streak.

TRENTADUE'S EARLY SEASON SUCCESS: Josh Trentadue is expected out of the bullpen on Thursday. So far this year, the 14th Round pick from 2023 has been dominant. Trentadue has given up just one run in five appearances. His most recent bullpen outing featured four scoreless innings where Trentadue faced just 12 batters.

SLOW STARTS: Greenville has capitalized on early leads in each of the first two games of the series. The Drive used three Hub City errors in the first inning of game one to score three of their four runs needed for victory. In game two, Greenville put up seven runs across the first two innings of play.

FLYIN' OUT OF FIFTH THIRD PARK: Hub City has managed to turn its ballpark into a hitter-friendly park, at least for the home team. So far this season, the Spartanburgers have a batting average almost 50 points higher at home compared to on the road. Hub City hit its first four home runs on the road at Greenville. Meanwhile, the Spartanburgers have launched 16 home runs at home in just 18 games played in the brand new ballpark.

LATE GAME LEADERS: The Spartanburgers are outscoring opponents 41-29 in the final three innings. The most damage for Hub City has come with 18 runs in the seventh. The Spartanburgers have scored just eight in the eighth, and then 15 in the ninth. Hub City is undefeated in games with a lead after six innings.

2025 v. GVL: The Spartanburgers and Drive meet for the second time and first time at Fluor Field. In the first series this season, the Spartanburgers took 4 of 6 at home. Hub City highlighted the series win with a 16-8 victory on Saturday afternoon that included a pair of grand slams from Dylan Dreiling and Keith Jones II.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Spartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.

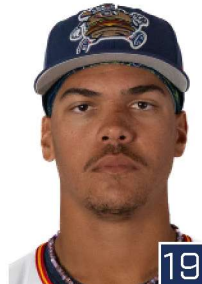
