#### **Looking Back**

Reading won its second-straight game over Portland 3-2 last night behind six-dominant innings from Mick Abel. Abel allowed no ruins and just one hit, with seven strikeouts. Marcus Lee Sang hit a two-run home run and Ethan Wilson knocked in the go-ahead run with a double in the eighth. Dominic Pipkin earned the win after a scoreless eighth and Tristan Garnett his first save after a scoreless ninth inning. Reading was held to just three hits last night, which matched a season low. Reading was outhit last night, and they were previously 6-41 when being outhit this season.

#### Abel's Strong Rur

Mick Abel stayed hot with six-shutout innings last night. Over his last three starts (dating back to Aug. 23) Abel is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA, with just five hits allowed and 15 strikeouts. He owns a WHIP of 0.72 and opponents are hitting just .091 against Abel. After last night, Abel qualifies for a variety of Eastern League leaderboard ranks: ERA (10th), Strikeouts (118), BAA (.190) and WHIP (1.24).

#### He Dunn Gets On Base

Oliver Dunn matched a season-high last night with three walks. He now has 80 walks on the season, which puts him in sole possesion of first place in the Eastern League in walks. Dunn also has the following Eastern League ranks is various other categories: AVG (6th), HR (T4th), RBI (T1st), OBP (2nd), SLG (2nd), OPS (2nd), Hits (T3rd), 2B (2nd), 3B (T4th), XBH (1st), TB (2nd) and Runs (6th).

#### Closer On Lock

Orion Kerkering picked up his fifth Double-A save last night, as he threw a 1-2-3 ninth inning with two strikeouts. Kerkering has now converted on his last five save oppurtunities and hasn't allowed a run in his last five outings and 12 of his last 13. Dating back to July 26 (13 apppearneces) Kerkering is 5/5 in saves, with a 1.38 ERA and 18 strikeouts.

The Phillies beat the Padres 5-1 yesterday to win the series and finish the road trip 3-3. Lehigh Valley beat Buffalo 8-5 last night as Tyler Phillips tossed a strong outing and Matthew Kroon had two hits. The IronPigs remain one game out of first place. Jersey Shore beat Hudson Valley as Christian McGowen dominated over four innings. Jersey Shore remains one game back of Brooklyn with four to play, and they hold the tiebreaker. Clearwater fell to Palm Beach 10-3 to fall to 77-49 and begin the playoffs next week after winning the first half title.

#### Welcoming the Dogs

Portland enters tonight with a 28-31 record in the second half, which is third in the Northeast Division and five-games back of Binghamton. Overall, the SeaDogs are 68-60 after narrowly missing out on the first half title. Last week, Portland won two-of-six against Somerset and close the regular season against Hartford at home next week. Portland has the following Red Sox top prospects on its team: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (4), Nick Yorke (6), Wikelman Gonzalez (9), Blaze Jordan (12), Nathan Hickey (15), Angel Bastardo (16) and Chase Meidroth (20).

#### **Cup of Coffey**

Isaac Coffey gets the start tonight for Portland. He made one prior start againt Reading on June 21 and went just two innings, allowing seven hits, four runs and three strikeouts in a no decision. Overall, Coffey is 6-3 with a 3.51 ERA over 10 starts (51.1 IP, 41 H, 20 BB, 66 SO). Coffey last pitched on Aug. 26 against Richmond and earned a win with two-earned runs allowened on five hits across seven-innings pitched. He also struck out nine Richmond hitters. Coffey began the season with High-A Greenville and was called up to Portland on June 20. With Greenville, Coffey was 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA over 11 starts. He made two appearences in the FCL last season to begin his pro career. The Red Sox selected Coffey in the 10th round of the 2022 draft out of Oral Roberts.
