games three and four of a six-game series vs. the Charlotte Knights (Chicago White Sox). It is the ninth and 10th of 18 meetings between the clubs this season, and the ninth and 10th of 12 games to be played in Georgia. Tonight is **Salute** to First Responders and Fireworks Friday. Gwinnett is 2-0 in one doubleheader this year (5/26 at NOR).

VS. CHARLOTTE: Gwinnett is 73-62 (.541) in 135 games vs. Charlotte all-time at Coolray Field, including 5-3 (.625) in eight games in 2022. The Stripers are 7-5 in season home series vs. the Knights dating back to 2009, including 3-1 over the last four seasons (2017-21).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 813 in 80 games (10.16 SO per game). That's 15 behind Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (828 in 81G) for the most in Triple-A. Gwinnett has not led Triple-A in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Kyle Muller (1st, 102), Tucker Davidson (5th, 78), Huascar Ynoa (T-8th, 72), and Bryce Elder (T-21st, 62) all rank among IL leaders in strikeouts.

MULLDOZING: Tonight's scheduled game one starting pitcher Kyle Muller enters play leading the IL in strikeouts (102, 8th in MiLB) and ranking among the league's top 10 in ERA (2nd, 2.99), WHIP (2nd, 1.09), BAA (4th, .216), innings (T-4th, 81.1), and starts (T-6th, 14).

- · Pitcher of the Month: Muller was named on 7/7 as the IL Pitcher of the Month for June. All five of his starts during the month were quaity outings, and he went 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-9 with a 3.19 ERA (57 ER in 161.0 IP), .219 BAA, and 195 strikeouts (10.90 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 31 starts.

KILLER D's DOING DAMAGE: Alex Dickerson and Joe **Dunand** have combined to bat .333 (25-for-75, 4 2B, 2 3B, 4 HR, 12 R, 12 RBI) since 6/22. In that span, Dickerson is batting .351 (13-for-37, 1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 R, 7 RBI, .985 OPS), while Dunand is batting .316 (12-for-42, 3 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 5 R, 5 RBI, .986 OPS).

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel hit a game-tying RBI double in the fourth inning on Wednesday (1-for-2, RBI, 2 BB). Of his 19 hits this season, 13 have gone for extra bases (68.4%), including five doubles, one triple, and seven homers. For his Gwinnett career, exactly 50.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (27 of 54), including 11 doubles, one triple, and 15 homers.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake has hit safely in 13 of 15 games since 6/7, batting .305 (18-for-59, 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 R, 9 RBI, 2 SB, .802 OPS) in that span. He homered twice on the last road trip, 6/22 at Nashville (2-run, off RHP Luke Barker) and 7/2 at Norfolk (2-run, off RHP Marcos Diplan). In 56 games overall on his Triple-A debut, Shewmake is batting .271 (59-for-218, 11 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 29 R, 17 RBI, 6 SB, .723 OPS).

DELINO DE-STEALS: Delino DeShields Jr. ranks tied for 12h in the IL in stolen bases with 16 (16-for-23, 69.6%). He has three multi-steal games this year (2 SB on 4/19 at JAX, 5/10 at DUR, and 5/28 at NOR). Between MiLB and MLB, DeShields has 421 career steals in 1,322 games.

TODAY: The Stripers play a doubleheader at Coolray Field, **TUI TO THE FUTURES GAME:** Yesterday, MLB announced the rosters and coaching staffs for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game on 7/16 at Dodger Stadium. Stripers manager Matt Tuiasosopo has been selected as the third base coach for the National League Team, led by former MLB manager Mike Scioscia. Tuiasosopo will be the first active Gwinnett coach to particiate in a Futures Game.

> TARNOK TO TRIPLE-A: Today, RHP Freddy Tarnok was promoted to Gwinnett from Double-A Mississippi. Atlanta's No. 7 prospect according to MLB.com, Tarnok went 2-2 with a 4.31 ERA (30 ER in 62.2 IP), .228 BAA, and 10.77 SO/9.0 IP ratio (75 SO) in 15 starts for the M-Braves. Over his final four Double-A starts from 6/18-7/7, he went 1-0 with a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP), .184 BAA, and 31 strikeouts.

> CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin locked down his team-leading sixth save (T-11th in IL) on Monday, working 1.0 IP (0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 SO). The outing extended his team-best scoreless innings streak to 11.0 spanning his last 11 appearances. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.45 WHIP (4 H, 1 BB), .108 BAA, 14.73 SO/9.0 IP ratio (18 SO), and three saves (3-for-3). In 25 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.10 ERA (6 ER in 25.2 IP), .179 BAA, 14.73 SO/9.0 IP ratio (42 SO), and six saves (6-for-7).

> RISING WATERS: Atlanta Braves' No. 1 prospect Drew Waters walked twice in a game for just the second time all season on Monday (0-for-3, 2 BB, 2 R, 1 SB). After posting a .664 OPS over his first 29 games from 5/3-6/15, he owns an .753 OPS (.246, 16-for-65, 12B, 23B, 2 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI, 3 SB, 9 BB) over his last 16 games since 6/17.

- 2022 Season: In 45 total games, Waters is batting .244 (43-for-176, 6 2B, 3 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 16 RBI, 4 SB, .699 OPS), including .389 (4 2B, 1 HR, .960 OPS) vs. LHP and .180 (2 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, .583 OPS) vs. RHP.
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .246 (169-for-687, 33 2B, 4 3B, 18 HR, 112 R, 64 RBI, 35 SB, .707 OPS) in 174 games.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .167 (7for-42, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 11 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 170 of 200 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (192-for-693, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .914 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) . In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/7/22, was selected as the third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game (7/16 at Dodger Stadium) ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.
